

EDITORIAL

79TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE OCTOBER REVOLUTION IN RUSSIA

In October 1917, the revolution in Petrograd (later re-named Leningrad) brought down the Alexander Kerensky provisional government, replacing it with a truly revolutionary government. These were the historic events described by John Reed in his book, Ten Days that Shook The World. The capitalist nations were terrified because what was taking place in Russia was unprecedented, but could also happen in other countries, especially in the more industrialized ones. Winston Churchill, who was minister of munitions, urged immediate intervention, asking that the revolution be put down as soon as possible and stating that the best thing to do was to strangle the "socialist baby" in the cradle and not give it a chance to achieve maturity.

However, Lloyd George, the prime minister, disapproved of doing this – not out of humanitarian considerations, nor because he had any sympathy for the workers and poor peasants, but because he felt that such intervention would prove too costly for Britain which was waging war against the Kaiser's Germany. However, fourteen countries did send contingents to Russia – but try as they might, they were unable to break the will of the heroic Russian people who had suffered too long

and too much under the oppressive regime of Tzar Nicholas II and his wealthy corrupt nobles, and the clergy who were expert in lulling largely illiterate masses of people into a state of indifference.

Lenin had correctly said that religion is the opium of the people. But even the opium habit can be broken when there is the will to do it, and the will was there. This will was provided by the Bolshevik Party which instructed and led the people, pointing out to the workers and peasants, and the soldiers who consisted mainly of peasants dressed in military uniforms, that they were nothing but expendable cannon fodder. The majority of the people

agreed with the Bolsheviks because they were already becoming aware of the callousness of the authorities and that the government of Tzar Nicholas II was thoroughly incompetent as well as dishonest.

When the First World War broke out in 1914, the Russian armies suffered one defeat after another, the first of which was the battle of Tannenberg and the Masurian Lakes in East Prussia. In this, and the

battles that followed soon after, Russia lost some two million soldiers, wounded and taken prisoner. More heavy losses were to follow during the course of the war. This is not at all surprising since Tzar Nicholas, in his ineptitude and indifference, drove millions of poorly trained and poorly armed peasant conscripts into battle, many of whom hadn't even been issued rifles. There were insurmountable transportation problems. Added to these problems, there were also serious food shortages both in the army and on the civilian home front.

Some indication of just how corrupt the Russian government and the tzar, and his noble officials were can be seen in the kind of life that was led in the royal court in Petrograd. While millions were starving at home, and other millions being killed at the front, tzarina Alexandra was holding her gala soirées in the palace. These night parties would be better described as orgies because that is what they were in reality.

The tzarina was of German origin and looked upon the Russian people with contempt, considering them inferior beings. It was rumoured that she passed on information to the German authorities. At the same time, the tzarina was carrying on with the evil monk, Rasputin, who practically controlled the royal court. No government appointment could be made without his approval. He exercised very considerable influence over the tzarina and the noble ladies in the palace. Claiming that he was inspired by God, he insisted that the way to salvation was through union with him - body and soul. There was much gossip that he and the tzarina, and the noble ladies of the court, did practice such union, especially union of bodies. It was generally believed – and was likely true – that the wildest acts of debauchery took place in the palace. In fact, all this was well known in the court circles, and at least rumoured by the public in the city. Foreign diplomats knew this and talked about it when they returned to their own countries.

Needless to say, the high ranking nobles – that is to say, the husbands of the ladies seduced by the "saintly" Rasputin – took a rather dim view of such "spiritual" goings on. They were not impressed by Rasputin's claim that he was divinely inspired, and that the way to their wives' salvation was through union with his "holy" body in the bedroom. One night, they invited Rasputin to a banquet and shot him.

It is against this sleazy background that the October Revolution took place.



LABOUR STRIFE GROWING IN ONTARIO

Since the fall of 1995, the labour movement, with its natural allies in the social justice coalitions, have embarked on an economic and political city to city protest and strike, here in Ontario, Canada.

The working class here in Ontario, Canada, has rested far too long. The concessions granted by capital, in the face of a tangible socialist bloc, here and now are being recalled. The impact of the dissolution of the former U.S.S.R. undoubtedly has led to the intensifying capitalist aggression against the Canadian people in the

main. There are those within the Canadian Social Democratic faith that do not see this relationship. Now with globalization, the sheer mobility of capital to cart itself anywhere on "Mother Earth" for the sake of profit rate enhancement and little more shifts the ground under the once comparably steady feet of labour and Social Democrats alike.



on those that hope to substantially improve the life of the working class. For the creative progressive minds, the room to manouver is stunted by these forces of market economy.

The city to city strike protest and parades are gaining scope, size and acceptance of the working class. (100,000 plus – Feb. 26, 1996 Hamilton, Ontario; 250,000 – October 26, 1996, Toronto, Ontario.) Still, there is a large contingent within the working class that still holds to a job at Union Scale Wage rates and through insecurity, essentially 'hide' from the struggle they are part of, yet, are not victimized personally by it. This experience and education now is fundamental here. The

protests then serve a lasting impact on the political consciousness of those attending. The ills of the corporate governments and their business backers is attacked in speech after speech from labour and community activists alike. The missing ingredient here is a socialist program that would fortify the people with an alternative to the misery of the liquidation of the 'welfare state'; expropriation of the means of production, nationalizing the banks and abrogating the debt with no compensation. These aims must be presented by labour and the people's movements in Canada.

As mentioned before, the Canadian economy allowed room



for the producers of wealth, the workers to obtain a modest portion of that wealth they produced. Now, the capitalists work doubly hard to broadcast through all major media sources a corporatist perspective. This day-in-day-out underscoring of the necessity of the social order dulls the minds of many in the working class. The vested interest of private profit and "business sense" is justified, by media here, as akin to the working classes' dimming hope of a decent lifestyle. Play by the 'dog-eat-dog' rules and you have a chance, and by the way, it is as natural as Mother Nature. This is the most poisonous infection today that mends social fears in our country by confusing many workers local news people have admitted as much to me over the last two years. Northstar Compass is as useful here in Canada as it is for comrades in the former socialist countries. Our country is rapidly drawing lines on class motivations and actions through the perverted behaviour of capitalist greed. This economy here serves well less than 2% of the population - the rest serve that less than 2%. Nothing to admire or emulate but seek to overthrow.

NEWS DIGEST COMMENT

THE COUNCIL OF CANADIANS 11TH A.G.M.

If not now, when? If not us, who? Were the concluding remarks of

Maud Barlow to the 11th Annual General Meeting of the Council of Canadians held in Vancouver from October 18 to 20. She was summarizing what had been a very busy three days filled with deliberations by a group of Canadians trying to win back their country from the control of foreign (predominantly U.S.A.) corporations. The tone of those deliberations was established by three keynote speakers on Friday evening; the first of which was Maud Barlow.

Maud, an author and volunteer National Chairperson of the Council, told the gathering that the membership of the organization had increased by close to 30 thousand in the last two years to a total of 61 thousand members. That there were close to 300 delegates registered for the conference which was 100 more than what had been expected. These included farmers from Saskatchewan who had taken time from their harvest to be at the conference as well as people from virtually every other province in Canada. She pointed out that there is a growing concern among Canadians about the future of this country. The capitalism we are dealing with today is not the same as what we were dealing with at the end of the second world war. We are now faced with corporate rule by huge transnational corporations, 200 of which control 1/4 of the world's business activity. Governments have surrendered completely to these conglomerates and are totally controlled by them through their lobby groups such as the Business Council on national issues here in For example, while Canada. corporate profits are at a 20 year high, child poverty has increased by 49% in Canada since 1989. There is no collectivity, no leadership and no freedom of the press.

The speaker informed the gathering that the council is challenging in court the take-over of Southam Inc. by Hollinger which will result in Conrad Black having 60% control of all printed news media in this country. Corporations are now telling governments that if they are forced to pay taxes, they will move and take all their jobs with them. In short, national governments have been reduced to little more than apologists for the transnationals.

Bob White, president of the Canadian Labour Congress, pointed out that the Free Trade Agreement with U.S.A. has resulted in the entrenchment of corporate rights rather than free trade. Mexico is a prime example of what happens to a national economy as a result of free trade. He went on to say that while the economy grows, black markets are at record highs and the dollar is strong - the food banks in Metro are running out of food. The unemployment rate has been above 9% for the last 72 months. Outsourcing a policy practiced by large industrial corporations whereby jobs are taken out of unionized enterprises performed by non-union shops is being used to downsize and marginalize labour unions.

James Laxer, author of "In Search of the New Left" and a university professor, gave the meeting an intellectual interpretation of the present situation in our country. He pointed out that there is no one willing to challenge corporate power in the leadership of our society. He pointed out that Canadians are being told that individualism rather than social responsibility are the wave of the future and that this is being used as a means through which to

sell Canadians the demise of their social welfare programmes. While the right and its media (i.e., the bourgeois press) talk about noninterference in the market place, the U.S.A. did not hesitate to put together a financial aid package in conjunction with its G-7 partners to intervene in the Mexican economy to stop the devaluation of the peso and the subsequent financial losses of U.S corporations. Laxer concluded by saying that the present generation of young people has no right to squander the social programmes and quality of life that we all worked so hard to build.

The workshops and various other speakers all seemed to confirm a commonality that seemed to permeate this gathering. Canadians in growing numbers, are becoming alarmed at what capitalism is doing to their country. They are, for the first time in recent history, starting to have doubts about the free market and the last stage of capitalism manifested in its policy of globalization. The fact that this entire affair has been boycotted by the media both written and electronic attests to this fact.


THE ECONOMICS OF FUNDAMENTALISM

LETTER TO ALL NATO PERSONNEL ON VISIT TO ICELAND

We, a group of Icelandic citizens who love our country and wish it to remain a haven of peace, would have preferred to have you in our country as ordinary tourists who come of their own will.

We are fully aware that you did not personally decide to come to Iceland. Nor do we attribute to you any responsibility for NATO policies and decisions.

Nevertheless, we wish to make it clear that as military personnel, you are not welcome to our country. We are a peaceful people and expect our guests to visit Iceland without weapons and military equipment. When we visit your country, we don't bring weapons with us either. Therefore, we cannot consider your visit as a friendly act. No one in Iceland will be deceived by your posing as ordinary tourists, even if you dress in civilian clothes. Are you ashamed to appear in uniforms?

Don't be deceived by the smiles you'll get from salespeople in shops. They like your money but they don't like you. The Icelandic people have always been opposed to militarism and you should know that.

Let us be frank. NATO is no charity club. It is a military organization. It is an undemocratic organization. It is an organization based on the assumption that nations should suspect each other. It is an organization that threatens non-member countries with nuclear weapons. It is an organization serving the arms industry and those who wish to rule the world. People who respect others and have no enemies, such as the Icelandic people, do not need military organizations and are justified in considering such organizations as a threat to world peace. Farewell.

LOOK OUT, SADDAM

EAST EUROPE: NEW HUNTING GROUNDS

Child prostitution has experienced a considerable development in East Europe. In the case of An and Eefje, the Czech Republic and Slovakia are regularly cited. In Romania, Hungary, Bulgaria, Poland, Russia, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, the export of prostitutes pornographic material including children has seen an important increase. This trade, which is flourishing and is extremely lucrative, is destined for Western Europe and the United States.1

It is easy to imagine the direct link with the social and economic ravages which have struck large sections of the population following the introduction of savage and mafia capitalism. Geert Cappelaere, of the Centre for the Rights of Children at the University of Ghent, confirms this suspicion. "The links is manifest," explains Geert Cappelaere. "Although the studies on this subject are still quite few, it is enough to walk, for example, down the streets of Sofia, Bulgaria, to realize that the catastrophic social and economic situation favors child prostitution. On several occasions, I have gone back to East Europe for missions of the United Nations and I have observed the same thing everywhere. East Europe has been forced to abandon socialism and nothing is being done for the outcasts."2

100,000 CHILD PROSTITUTES IN EAST EUROPE

The restoration of capitalism in East Europe has brought with it poverty, increasing social inequality, a high level of stress for many families, an increase in drug use. All these factors favor child prostitution. The number of child prostitutes in East Europe is estimated to be 100,000.1 Estonia has at least 4,000 prostitutes, of whom one fourth are minors. In the capital Tallin, one can see girls of 10 or 11 years walking the streets near the railway station. In Latvia and Lithuania, 10,000 children are wandering the streets instead of sitting at school benches. One can buy them for next to nothing. In Romania, the street children sell their bodies for a night's lodging. In Russia, sexual exploitation of children is directly linked with organized crime, where gangs of children are involved in

selling themselves and even sometimes selling their own younger brothers and sisters.

US TROOPS INTRODUCED THE SEX INDUSTRY

The Philippines and Thailand are number 1 and 2 in the sex industry. This is not an accident.

The explosion of the sex industry in Thailand began during the war in Vietnam. The US troops were deployed in seven bases in Thailand, where they took their leaves. The number of Thai prostitutes rose from 20,000 in 1957 to 400,000 in 1964. The World Bank stimulated this growth by encouraging tourism. A spokesperson for South Vietnam, at that time occupied by the US, stated this in a direct way: "The Americans need girls and we need dollars. Why can't we exchange?"

Until 1991, the largest US overseas bases were situated in the

Philippines: Subic Naval base and Clark Air Base. An enormous sex industry flourished around these bases, with entire streets filled with bordellos. The complaints against the soldiers continued until the bases were closed. The troops of the United Nations Organization, sent to bring "peace", are also a scourge for the population. At the beginning of 1990, the UNO troops in Mozambique and Cambodia have often been accused of sexual exploitation.²



ITEMS FROM ABROAD

GENOCIDE

Dark forces, usurping the state in my country, are celebrating. As if on baker's yeast, there is growing criminal capitalism. The ruling mafia, through the hands of the president and present the administration, is devastating our economy and culture. Genocide, the scale of which is impossible for our overseas friends to understand, is becoming more and more clear-cut - all inclusive and, I fear of unstoppable character. example, in 1995, the population of Ukraine became less by 400,000 people. Before, such a serious drop in the population only happened during a world war. From the middle of 1950s to the beginning of 1990s, the growth of the population of Ukraine grew from 40 to 52 million people. But already in 1991, when there was announced the so-called "Independent Ukraine", it went hell-bent onto the road of capitalism, the number of deaths far surpassed the number of newly born by 39,100 people. In the last few years, this number grew alarmingly with each passing month. Because of this, the present population of Ukraine numbers only 51 million people. But

according to demographics, the population of Ukraine should now have reached 53 million people! Who is it that liquidated 2,000,000 people?! The present pseudodemocrats are trying desperately to come up with facts that this is the consequences of "Bolsheviks", "bloody terror of Stalin", etc. Why all these worries? Here, we have actual facts for all to see! The 1990s are a classical example of the total genocide of the present regime against their own people. Who is to blame for this genocide of Ukrainian people? Why is it that in the course of the last five years, the lifespan of men has fallen by 10 years while that of women by 3-4 years? Today, the average life of men is 62.5 years of age while women are 73.4 years of age. What is this - is it not the result of the "democratization" of the so-called "legal" state?

The real fact is this – that the present regime's policy is to rob the workers. Soviet people today cannot afford normal medical care or medicines. Today, this is absolutely impossible for a working man. In the hospitals, each worker must bring his or her bedding, pillows and covers. Not everyone can afford the astronomical priced medicines. Just a few years, they cost only pennies, while the majority of patients did not have to pay anything at all.

Deaths in the country are growing alarmingly. As an example, even in my own, not-too-big city of Lutsk (200,000 people) in the first half of 1996, more than 1,000 people died; of them, over 27% in the prime of their lives. A large number committed suicide. Only in the Volyn district of Ukraine for the past 6 months there were 160 suicides. But did they commit suicide voluntarily? What can a person do if his life becomes unbearable and there is no help

from anyone? Unfortunately, not everyone has the strength to struggle against the mighty mafia, governing our country. Here is just one example. Novovolynsk, one of the coal mining centres of the Volyn district of Ukraine, from the 9 coal mines, they were operating only two shafts. The 10th shaft will not be built. Where will the workers go to find a job?

With everyday, the food intake of the population becomes more meagre and not nourishing. The falling away of productive capacity is also a factor in the countryside. With no technology, machines, mineral fertilizer, herbicides, the growth of farm products is falling sharply. If, let us say in the Volyn district during Soviet times, they gathered even on poor soil up to 35-40 percent of grain per hectare, in 1996, this amount fell to 18.6 percent per hectare. If Ukraine before every year gathered over 50 million tons of grain, now in 1996, only 21.3 million tons.

The production of consumer goods for the population in January – June 1996 fell by 16.5%. During that time (imagine) only 65 automatic cranes were built, 4 bulldozers, and the average for each person of Ukraine received in production only 1/10 of a shoe. Lutsk Automobile plant has reduced its work force by 89%, and in 8 months, it manufactured only 85 cars!

This is how the Ukraine (not only Ukrainian) market economy works! It stifles and throws on dump heap workers. This trauma is not only economical, but a moral-psychological trauma. Workers feel that they are no longer needed by society. Everyday, the libraries, theatres, preschool nurseries and kindergartens are closing. In the last 5 years in Ukraine, there were eliminated more than 2,000

preschool and kindergarten centres. Well known in Ukraine and across its borders, the Film Theatre "Kiev" is planned to be turned into a cafe, hair dresser salon, sauna, body rub – everything but showing cultural films. But in those theatres that are still operating, the films that are shown are American – propagandizing sex, robbery, rape, traitorous acts, and other harmful variations that are foreign to our population. Genocide of the morals, as also physical, is the norm ...

But nevertheless, more and more Soviet people are beginning to see and realize the character, the traitorous actions of the present Kuchma regime.

"People of Ukraine, wake up!" – writes the newspaper 'Tovarish' (Kiev) from a letter in the city of Boyarka – P. Fursov. "Your factories, enterprises are already in the hands of foreign owners, but this is not enough for them. Now they want to take away our land – the land of your forefathers – which belongs to you. The adoption of the new Constitution illegally, is like a thorny branch hanging over your back."

Let us unite, people, in our struggles for the rights of the working man. In the name of our children and grandchildren, we must win this deadly struggle!

POLISH YOUTH

Poverty and starvation are the causes that many of those kids become criminals. In Poland, we have more and more banditry, murders, etc. Recently, Polish police had captured a 6 year old child (!) that had broken into a grocery store.

AMERICAN COLONIZATION OF UKRAINE

By tearing away of Ukraine from Russia, these vultures at the same time are proceeding to make Ukraine a colony of USA. At a secret meeting with his staff, heads of General Staff on October 24, 1995, Bill Clinton, president of USA, who has no qualms bombing Arabs and Serbs, stated: "Liquidating the ideological bases of USSR, we were capable of liquidating without a war a state which was mighty and world effective, which was the only competitor for America ... in the next ten years, we must do the following: we must break up Russia into small states through the medium of inter-regional wars; set up in these small regions (states) that broke away from Russia, regimes that we need." (Kirov Pravda, July 23, 1996)

In Ukraine, the Americans need a regime that is subservient to colonization, regime of neobanderovites and party turn-coats which is already complete and in The flow of constant place. propaganda over the airways, American sadistic "heroes" and sexfilms are looked upon by the neobanderovites as "rebirth" and thus, they try to cover up the process of colonization. Mr. Kuchma (president of Ukraine - Editors) follows these neo-banderovites' examples and against the will of the people, now

is pleading to have Ukraine become a member of NATO. They make themselves happy in this, that in future, they will not be held accountable by the people!

The systematic course of "dollarization of our financial system which itself causes great inflation and at the same time, helps the export of our colonized resources at very low prices across the borders. The constant falling in the standard of living for the population saw the startling fact that in the last 5 years, over 2,000,000 people died from the effects of this colonization.

Neo-banderovites leaders of the "Independent Ukraine" are making it very easy for American firms to buy everything and anything that Ukrainian people built, even the buying of our enterprises of the Defense Complex Industries. The Yankees already got their hands on such enterprises of world renown as "Motor Sich", where helicopters were manufactured – the best in the world, which worried the USA brass, the Russian Helicopters called "Black Shark".

Organizing with their Ukrainian helpers a system of "non-payment", the colonialists in this way got their hands on Ukraine's machinebuilding enterprises, which were world renowned. (In a colony, machine building is not needed!) This then made hundreds of thousands of Ukrainian workers unemployed, thus the Yankees are forcing Ukraine to buy American machines from "John DEER" and other American machines and tools, while shutting down the Ukraine's machine-building industry, since competition is not what market economy is all about.

Because of the systematically proposed and a carried-out deficit, the Americans now have assigned their "Controllers" into every section

of manufacturing in the Poltava and Crimean oil and gas production enterprises and exploration.

From 1996, there is taking place the Americanization of our Goskomat of Ukraine. Therefore, the Kiev Institute of "Energyproekt" is now officially controlled by the American multinational corporation "Westinghouse Electric". Also, in the near future, the deal was signed for American nuclear waste to be stored on the territory of Ukraine – besides the waste from other G-7 countries ... also the storage of defective reactors and rockets.

The Yanks have invested over two billion dollars into the business of Ukraine for profit. By hiding the facts that Ukraine now owes USA, Transnational Corporations and the World Monetary Fund such amounts that these facts are hidden and more borrowing is concluded by present Ukrainian regime. In 1996, Ukraine owes 275.6 billions of dollars in back payments and interest on loans.

In order to get this colonization proceedings to go even faster, the Americans have made certain that every enterprise has American controllers on staff, thus controlling the whole economic life of Ukraine.

And all this is being overseen, controlled and also promoted by Mr. Kuchma, who, at any given opportunity, shows his hate of anything Russian or Soviet. This has gone so far that in Sevastopol where the Russian Navy is stationed, the authorities shut off electricity and power to Russian vessels.

Mr. Kuchma was not ashamed to have started the issuing of a new Ukrainian Currency, "Grivna" with his beloved hero, the traitor Mazepa.

NOTE:

MAZEPA - in 1709, he became a traitor to Peter I, and deserted with

troops to the side of Karl XII of Sweden – thus, selling out his country and people. Therefore, there is no difference between Mazepa or Judas.

STRIKES, CONFLICTS ON UPSWING IN RUSSIA

According to the latest information reaching our desk, the following labour unrest has taken or is taking place:

- At the industrial enterprise "Dalxenergo", the workers went on strike, besides some sectors went on hunger protest, demanding that over 18 billions of rubles be paid for back wages to the workers.
- Federation of workers in the Premprije Province of Russia in the Kamchatka territory of Russia took strike action against non payment of back wages and against privatization.
- In the energy sector of the whole of Russia, there are constant labour conflicts, hunger strikes and the workers are tying the economic demands to political demands. This movement is gaining strength.
- In the coal mining industry, the strikes are spreading like wild fire. But the Yeltsin regime is desperately trying to disunite the workers, by paying off some sections and not paying other sections of the workers.
- In Moscow, there took place the 3rd Plenum of the Coal Industry Unions where there were reports of hunger strikes by miners all across Russia, political demands ... more than a million miners are ready for action that override strikes or hunger protests. More and more, the workers in the oil and coal industries are demanding political action to change the situation.
- Protests, actions, picketing by workers in the school and cultural fields are taking place. In Moscow, the Director of Physics at the University went on a hunger strike

at the offices of the Russian-American Press Centre.

- Musicians of the Moscow Symphony Orchestra went to the picket lines, plus workers in the well known Moscow Museums went into the streets in protests.
- Workers in the health care, ambulance, high school teachers and medical faculty went on strike and were picketing their respective places of work.
- Hunger strikers in many enterprises are common and unfortunately, many hunger strikers died in these protests without the authorities even meeting with them for discussions.
- On October 5th, the Presidium of the trade unions declared a one-day General Strike, protesting the lack of payment of back wages.
- At the Muromsky enterprise manufacturing armaments, over 1,000 workers took over the whole enterprise, defeating the regime's police cordon and demanded the payment of back wages to the workers. The workers decided that there is a need of more militant forms of struggle, not only strikes or hunger actions. Workers are starting to be politicized and more and more take-overs of enterprises by the workers is needed.

The above summary is just an inkling of what is transpiring in Russia and former Soviet Union. Information gathered from the newspaper "Voice of a Communist" and from "Bumbarash".

RUTSKOI RETURNS TO THE POLITICAL STAGE

Despite the fact he was only able to register as a candidate three days before the poll, Aleksandr Rutskoi, the leader of the opposition movement Derzhava and the former Russian Vice President, won the gubernatorial elections in Kursk Oblast on October 20. According to preliminary results, he received 79% of the vote, while the incumbent governor Vasilii Shuteev finished second with 18%.

As governor of Kursk, Rutskoi will take up a seat in the Federation Council, the parliament's upper house, which is composed of regional leaders. This represents the triumphal return of a politician who left the parliament in less auspicious circumstances on October 4, 1993. Rutskoi, together with the other defenders of the "White House" who

had defied Yeltsin's order disbanding the parliament, was arrested after troops stormed the building and taken to Lefortovo prison. He was released under an amnesty granted by the newly-elected State Duma in February 1994.

Rutskoi, born in Kursk in 1947, had made a name for himself as a pilot in Afghanistan. He flew 428 missions, was shot down twice and spent a period as a prisoner of the mujahedin. In 1989, he became active in nationalist politics, winning a seat to the Russian Congress of People's Deputies in 1990. He backed Yeltsin in his conflict with Gorbachev, and was chosen as Yeltsin's vicepresidential running mate in the June 1991 election. Rutskoi was one of the defenders of the White House in August 1993, but fell out with Yeltsin over the question of radical economic reform (which Rutskoi strongly opposed). He was gradually stripped off of his powers as vice president, and was the target of corruption accusations. Rutskoi in turn claimed to have "eleven suitcases" of evidence of corruption in the Yeltsin administration.

After Yeltsin's order in September 1993 disbanding the parliament Rutskoi again became a defender of the White House, at one point swearing himself in as president of Russia. After his release from prison, in April 1994, he formed the Derzhava movement, which spent most of the next two years in endless internal bickering and feuding with other "social patriotic" movements. Derzhava backed the candidacy of Gennady Zyuganov in the June 1996 presidential election.

Until last week, Rutskoi's participation in the Kursk governor's race was uncertain. In late September, he was refused registration as a candidate by the regional electoral commission on the grounds that he

had not been resident in the Oblast for a year prior to the election, as required by the Oblast electoral law. However, on October 16, the Russian Supreme Court's Presidium overruled the commission's decision on the grounds that such residence requirements violate federal legislation, and instructed the commission to register Rutskoi for the gubernatorial poll.

Though Rutskoi only had 36 hours for his campaign, his victory could be expected. Although he has not lived in Kursk for the past ten years, he remains a popular figure. In the 1995 Duma elections, Rutskoi's Derzhava movement failed to clear the 5% barrier at national level, but the party finished in first place in Kursk Oblast, leading Communist Party (KPRF) 31% to 29%. The Oblast has traditionally been a communist stronghold and there was little doubt that the incumbent Shuteev, supported by presidential administration, would be defeated by a nominee of the opposition.

Rutskoi is one of five co-chairmen of the coalition of opposition parties which united to back Zyuganov's candidacy, the Popular Patriotic Union of Russia (NPSR), the NPSR initially promised to back Rutskoi for the Kursk gubernatorial election. When it became obvious that Rutskoi could well be prevented from running, the NPSR nominated another candidate. Aleksandr Mikhailov, Duma deputy and leader of the regional KPRF organization.

Moreover, the Agrarian Party, which had joined the united opposition, endorsed their own candidate.

The reversal of the regional election commission decision left Rutskoi little time to persuade his fellow oppositionist, now contestant, Mikhailov to withdraw. At first,

Mikhailov, with the support of the regional KPRF, refused to step down, saying he worked too hard during the campaign to quit at the last movement. However, under pressure from NPSR's central leadership, he withdrew the day before voting. Agrarian candidate Vitalii Gukov had already left the race before Rutskoi's registration in favor of the "sole opposition candidate".

Rutskoi's victory is somewhat soured by the uncooperative stance of local communists. On October 18, the Oblast legislative assembly, mostly controlled by the communists, announced that it would file an appeal against Rutskoi's "illegal registration" as a candidate. Rutskoi, immediately after being registered for the race, asked the legislature to postpone voting for a week to give him an "equal chance" to conduct his campaign. Despite the support of the electoral commission, his appeal was ignored by the assembly.

Rutskoi told NTV the day after his election that in his new post, he is going to concentrate on economic problems and ignore politics, especially at the federal level. He added that he will invite prominent economists, who have helped him write a plan for the Oblast's recovery, to join the Oblast administration. The Oblast communist leader Mikhailov will become Rutskoi's first deputy.

Rutskoi said that the two regional leaders that he most admires are Moscow Mayor Yurii Luzhkov and Nizhnii Novgorod Governor Boris Nemisov – in other words, figures known as competent economic managers rather than ideologues.

Although his new job in Kursk will give him a seat in the federal parliament, Rutskoi apparently wants to avoid repeating the bitter confrontation with Yeltsin that derailed his earlier career. Rutskoi may have more luck as a regional

leader than he did as a national politician.

OUR COMMENT:

True colours usually show themselves after a period of time, AND, the true colours of Alexander Rutskoi, former Vice President of Russia, are now known – YELLOW!

From a communist, from an enemy of Yeltsin when he helped defend the "White House" in 1993, although he refused to call upon the Army to help the legally elected Parliament – now he is to take up his post as a "Governor" of Kursk Province?

Anything is for sale (including one's soul) if the ultimate prize is a nice cushy job in the DUMA!

Oh yes, and his statement that he is not interested in "politics", only in "economics" ... who does he think that he's fooling!

Yes, unfortunately, these were the kind of "heroes" that wormed themselves into the Communist Party of Soviet Union. NO wonder that most of these leaders turned and ran, with a big yellow streak down their backs!

Our best comradely greetings on the fourth anniversary of the Northstar Compass and on the 79th anniversary of the Great October Socialist Revolution of 1917.

The Great October of 1917 has opened up a new historic epoch of

transition from capitalism to socialism. The temporary victory of the bourgeois-bureaucratic counterrevolution in the USSR and Eastern Europe cannot tarnish this historic event (as well as, say, the restoration of monarchy in France of 1815 did not belittle the significance of the Great French bourgeois revolution of 1789-1794). This 79 years after the Great October demonstrated, that the transition is far harder and complicated, than first expected. It is sure to be passed only through several subsequent revolutions (as well as the capitalist socio-economic formation had asserted, for instance, in Germany and Austria through at least two bourgeois revolutions of 1848 and 1918). The October Revolution is, thus, a pledge of a new socialist revolution in Russia and other countries, that will complete the cause of the Great October as well as the abolition of slavery in the 19th century USA and a set of revolutions in France had completed the cause of the 18th century American and French bourgeois revolution (that was the War For Independence and that of 1789-1794). And the forthcoming new socialist revolution is to happen under substantially new far more favourable conditions with working class as the dominant force and with quite a different world situation. With all our respect to the achievements of the elder generations, we are sure that the true socialism is not behind, it is in front of us. And in this new revolution, we shall rely on the shoulders of our revolutionary fathers and grandfathers as they did in respect of the Paris Commune and the workers' movement.

The bourgeois counterrevolution has brutally distorted and dismantled many of the revolutionary achievements of the Soviet people as well as that in other socialist countries, but it still cannot smash them out and with every failure of the bourgeois Yeltsin regime underline their true historic significance. Even after more than five years of an open bourgeois dictatorship, these achievements still exist and they will greatly differ from the new socialist revolution from that in other imperialist countries.

And the main revolutionary achievement is the World Communist movement with its internationalist traditions. Your magazine is one of the contributors to it. You have opened to the world the young Russian Communist press, discriminated by reformists and opportunists. You have opened the window to the really Communist current in Russia, and we wish you most of success in this activity.

As you might have heard, this October was noted by the formation of the new Union of the Communist and Socialist Forces of Russia, designed to become a revolutionary alternative to the reformist movement headed by Zyuganov. This union was constituted by the RPC, the Russian Communist Workers' party, the Russian Organization of the CPSU, the Union of Officers and the Movement in defence of Childhood.

The defeat of Zyuganov in the presidential elections has nothing to do with the Communist movement. It was the defeat of reformists and nationalists, who failed to offer a coherent and radical program of socialist transformation. Our hopes are associated with the renewal of the Russian Communist movement and its link-up with the growing workers' movement and the rise of social activity of other exploited people. This is the force capble of changing the situation by nonparliamentary and mostly peaceful means. This is the main aim of the new union.

The previous election campaign in Russia, plus business with editing newspapers and my book, did not give me an opportunity to write to you, my dear friends. In newspapers that you receive, there is enough material to give you a very good picture as to why Zyuganov lost the elections, and I'm certain that you always draw the correct conclusion.

You could analyze it more, but there is one subjective factor – the leadership of CPRF (Communist Party of Russian Federation) did not WANT to win this election! Another objective factor is that the working class is not yet fully organized, and without the working class, no party calling itself Communist can hope to win the struggle.

There are many strikes taking place in Russia now, but their numbers and quantity is not enough that it would become strong opposition to the present regime, but the CPRF is not a party of the working class — it's a party of pensioners and bureaucrats.

Other Communist parties in Russia are weak, the most numerous in numbers is the Russian Communist Workers Party (RCWP), but it also is suffering from internal squabbles, and it might even split apart. In October (this month -Editors) there shall take place a Congress of ROSKOMSOYUZ (Russian Communist Party's Union), but will this Congress be able to unite the fractured parties? We do not know, since the position lately of All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks (AUCPB) is going further apart from other Communist parties and not getting closer together, while the Russian Party of Communists (RPC), although willing to cooperate with different parties, is not willing to unite into a SINGLE COMMUNIST PARTY. The problem is the same: weakness of the working class and the separation of the leaders themselves from the working class.

We utilize materials of Northstar Compass in our publications. We are interested in the situation of the Canadian-American working class movements, their knowledge, their experiences, their theoretical outlook, those that call themselves Marxists, or those that call themselves

Letter From Editor T. Bogisvoj: "ALL POWER TO SOVIETS"

Dear Comrade Lucas!

I again ask for your forgiveness. We received your two packages of newspapers and other materials for which we thank you, but they were coming to us for 3 months (while your NSC comes to us very quickly), and unfortunately, they came to us while I was not in Kiev, thus no one

was there to answer your letter.

When I finally returned, we were expecting the appearance of our newspaper, but the private printers asked us for such an astronomical sum of money that we were forced to hunt for another printer. We then started to organize our movement "Communist Movement of Ukraine" on an organizational basis.

The fact is that the situation in the left movement in Ukraine is in a catastrophic situation, worse than in Russia – fully impregnated with opportunism. The face of communist movement in Ukraine at the present time is full of revisionism and opportunism, leading opportunistic movement is the Socialist Party of Ukraine, and with all the weaknesses of the Communist Party of Ukraine also (but on this, we must write an indepth analysis and detailed answers to questions, which we are going to do in our forthcoming issues).

We of course have with us real dedicated Bolsheviks in the Communist movement, in this regard in the membership of parties that are now existing. But these Communists are splintered in all other parties, divided in loyalties and understanding and there is no serious effective force or unity to be seen at the present moment.

Therefore, today, we began a serious attempt to find these dedicated Communists wherever they are dispersed in other parties and movements and unite them "Movement around the Communists of Ukraine" ... and although our movement is small, but it is the most dedicated to Bolshevism and Bolshevik ideals in Ukraine. But we also have our organizational weaknesses with which we are not yet at the moment analyzing or trying to correct this weakness.

Looking at the present situation in the USSR, we are at the crossroads and have put ourselves into a corner, therefore there is an absolute necessity to take a step forward, to start enlarging the membership of people devoted to socialism.

The cleansing of membership is being done by the "Russian Communist Workers Party" (RCWP). This party now is in a serious crisis, but this is the most perspective party-movement of Communists in the country. It is a tragedy of course, that Victor Anpilov has found himself not in its ranks any more, but his theoretical weakness, from which followed serious practical mistakes were not noticed at first, but the last events of Anpilov coming on strongly to support Zyuganov in his bid for presidency, plus the advisors that are circling around Anpilov now, is tantamount to diversion from Marxism.

To our way of thinking, the defeat of Zyuganov was also not a victory for the bourgeois; in actual fact, the bourgeois lost much – but we also do not support the boycott of the elections by AUCPB (Nina Andreeva) – this, we shall write about later for NSC.

But, maybe Anpilov will find the courage to return back to the ranks of Bolsheviks.

The "All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks" (Nina Andreeva) is going through very difficult period now. Their time on the scene has already gone. The AUCPB did not, in actual fact, become a bona fide party and could not have become. I, in my time, was very much against the formation of this movement, although at the very start, I was a member of the movement "UNITY" on which base the AUCPB was formed. The future of this movement is also very difficult and needs a further complete analysis which we shall do for NSC.

Troubles, problems, splits are also the lot of all other communist parties and movements that are existing in Russia and other former Soviet Republics.

Meanwhile, in this complicated situation, the movement is growing. Parties that must disappear will go out while movements and parties that remain will become much stronger. With difficulty, the parties that remain are groping for the Marxist road and they will combine

RUSSIAN ELECTIONS - HINDSIGHT THOUGHT

Excellent articles with pretty clear graphics were run in the July '96 NSC regarding the elections in the (temporarily former) Soviet Union. They vividly showed the sneaky trickery of the expensively bought experts – American and British experts – in screwing up elections.

We must emphasize several statements gloatingly made by these experts: "The president, Yeltsin, was favored by only 6% of the electorate ..." when these political slickers began their dirty work to make sure that Yeltsin gets elected – by hook-or-crook. "They (the voters) are scared to death! ... We gaged the average fear of the Russians ... it gave us the clue to systematically utilize the Civil War scare ... on T.V., radio, public speeches ...". And this is what they did.

Of course, the Soviet people are rightfully a proud people. But, to say that they did not fear a new bloodbath is an unnecessary illusion. All fathers, mothers and children have a natural right to fear war; especially the Soviet people. With fear, but brave angry hearts, they bravely fought the invading German Fascist hordes and chased those bloody, blood-thirsty inhuman butchers out of their dear-to-them homeland. A brave person, a man or a woman - especially a mother will fight, even to death, the enemy of their people - fight with fear or suppressed fear. The October '93 murderous massacre was also aimed at putting fear into the hearts of the toilers of the (temporarily

former) USSR.

The policy of instilling fear into the victims of the World Imperialist Corporate greedy thugs has been amply demonstrated in Vietnam, Panama, Nicaragua, Iraq, and now in Chechniya. These brutalities are a big problem for the people of the whole world. This is what the Yeltsin clique is pursuing there. The spreading of such fear was a large part of Yeltsin's victory in the elections. What made this policy stick is also the fact that the toilers of the Soviet Union are as yet not properly unified, nor ready to overcome the Yeltsin liars, traitors traitors of the people of the Soviet Union and the world proletariat and the people of the world who cautiously and steadily marching towards the establishment of a new, just world, world of Socialism. Yes, these uncivilized, selfish, uncorrectable, greedy lunatics will march into the garbage dumps of history. YOU HAVE AN OPINION ABOUT NSC? WRITE!

The August-September issue of Northstar Compass featured a very fine article on Chechnia in the Open Forum. As a life-long Atheist (capitalization intentional), I was pleased to discover another admitted Atheist, who could put religion in proper perspective regarding the international scene.

There was, however, one misconception the writer has about the U.S.A. As a foreigner Popovich is not alone in this belief, perhaps because our press has given a false picture of the way our rights operate in reality. NO, Atheists cannot "speak FREELY on TV and in the press". True, a few of them have managed to get some time on TV, but not FREELY - this represents a difficult struggle, and when Madeline O'Hara finally did air her views on radio and TV talk shows. she endured every type of vile insult and abuse. Eventually, American Atheists did get a program of their own on a few select stations with a limited audience. Other Atheist organizations have managed to get on cable, but again, they have had to put up a tough battle.

The press offers no improvement. "Letters to the Editor" are always defensive letters and I will wager that it took several calls to the editorial staff before the letter was published. Religionists can publish FREELY their offensive letters, but when an Atheist is able to get a reply published, one can expect a spate of anonymous mail which is largely composed of scatological and pornographic language (our files contain a few).

Try to make a statement with an automobile sticker such as "Tax the Church". One doesn't dare leave one's car in a supermarket parking lot or a department store ramp. The sign would be ripped off and one would be lucky if one's vehicle had not been harmed. Even the reminder "Keep state and church separate," a so-called constitutional guarantee, is not safe from religious zealots. In our travels, this sticker has been displayed on our car. Enraged fanatics have attempted to break into our motel room, have tried to ram our car, and directed epithets at us from passing automobiles.

After the Oklahoma bombing, one of your journalists was prompted to write in the Toronto Star about a pernicious form of Christianity practiced in the U.S.A. Did any of our spineless journalists in the "land of liberty" assess the issue from a religious perspective? NO, they chose not to rock the boat by challenging the UNWRITTEN LAW which only recognizes "freedom of religion" but not "FREEDOM FROM RELIGION".

While the founding fathers accepted the 1st Amendment, they couched the part referring to religion in such obscure language that future lawyers have had to philosophize and carefully use jurisprudences to convince the bench of the dual purpose of the law. Even the original sponsors of the amendment were cautious. They called themselves Deists although a perusal of their writings reveals Atheism. Today, others hide behind the words Agnostic, Humanist, or Free-thinker and still, others find Unitarian convenient. If it weren't for a handful of militant Atheists in the U.S.A., this liberty, which has never been publicly debated with equal protection nor tested for popular acceptance, would soon vanish.

Lawyers of the American Civil Liberties Union take on a few outstanding cases of religious violations of the 1st Amendment, but they can't take them all. In our country, litigation is VERY, VERY COSTLY. Few people can afford to go through a court system where many of the judicial politicians are often not conversant with the Constitution of their own nation. A minority of cases of this nature are decided in the lower courts, the majority end up in the Supreme Court. The price is prohibitive for the average citizen.

The "establishment clause" is currently under attack by this Congress, which has been bought by corporate America. Their argument is that the 1st Amendment ban on government participation in religion is outmoded. If this should pass, it would strengthen the leash corporate America has on the people. Religion dulls the mind, which creates a withdrawing from controversy. If people are willing to surrender their right to FREELY air their doubts and voice their questions about religion, they will soon surrender other rights. And this is the game the fascist, corporate American establishment is playing. At the rate we are going, we could soon have a theocratic plutocracy wherein the plutocrats, who regard religion as so much rubbish, will control, but will find the theocrats useful.

NO, Atheists in the U.S.A. cannot "speak FREELY on TV and in the press". There was a place where the protection of Atheists was clearly spelled out, but we shall not see that again until (as Popovich says) the "resurrection of the Soviet Union".



Cuba embargo trouble for U.S.

The U.S. embargo of Cuba reminds me of the story about how a mighty Russian marathon runner lost an international race. She said that it wasn't the competition, the heat, the distance or for lack of training. "I lost it," she said, "because of a tiny grain of sand in one shoe."

Cuba is our tiny grain of sand and, because of our heavy-footedness, we will lose our one-nation race for the minds and hearts of the

America's embrace of Vietnam, China, oil-rich Mideastern countries and other big-time offenders of freedom and human rights suggests that Cuba's crime is not Fidel Castro or human rights offenses. Cuba's crime is that Cuba has no strategic mineral, no oil, no rich lobby to walk the halls of Congress passing out largess.

Miami Cubans and their richly endowed coffers, much of which are filled from federal grants, simply have more muscle on Capitol

As we add bells and whistles such as the Helms-Burton Act Bill Clinton signed in March — to the embargo that has failed since 1961, we go from bad foreign policy to bad law, from bad law to bad international relations. Our excesses with Cuban sovereignty have appalled the world's leaders.

Caribbean and Latin countries already see us as a bully: Indeed, in early June, the Organization of American States - from which Cuba was excluded in 1962 because of United States pressure - denounced Helms-Burton as probably violating international law. And, in late June, the leaders of the 15 nations of the European Union, none of which observe the Cuba boycott, voiced their "deep concern" about Helms-Burton and threatened to retaliate if the act was used.

Our government's recent threat to bar from the United States executives of Sherritt International Corp., a respected Canadian mining company, chills freedom-loving people everywhere. It was the first brandishing of Helms-Burton, which aims to penalize foreign companies that do business with Cuba involving, in any way however remote or obscure, former U.S. property there. The fact is that we have no right to interfere with the laws and businesses of Canada or any other country.

Maybe that was on Clinton's mind July 16 when he suspended for six months — until after the election — the key part of Helms-Burton, Title III. This provision allows suits in U.S. courts against any person or entity whose business dealings meet the act's hazy but broad definition of benefiting, directly or tangentially, from properties of U.S. nationals that were expropriated by the Cuban government.

So the reign of "The Ugly American' is back to haunt us all. Helms-Burton is mucking up our relations with Canada. But we are also creating gross breaches with other allies that will take years to heal, for the bill aims at a full-blown de facto commercial blockade of Cuba that nobody but a very few members of the U.S. Congress wants.

Remember that the United States is the only nation on Earth that boycotts Cuba. Is every other country out of step? Why are we back to gunboat diplomacy?

Is Cuba a threat to our safety? Is Canada? Italy? Britain? France? Germany? Sweden? Companies from these and other nations have invested several hundred million dollars in Cuba and can invest more every day. They also can send hundreds of thousands of their citizens to bask on Cuba's pristine beaches and stay in four- and five-star properties built and run by foreign investors.

Although Clinton or his successor will, sooner or later, end the embargo, what he might do right now is to waive Title III for yet another six months and so on.


Political wisdom tells our political leaders that, on the Cuban question, we must wait until after the election as a control of cide's electoral votes.

The great malaise of our time is that our leaders won't take risks on what their gut tells them to do, however small the risk. Political wisdom says that it is safer to do nothing. So our leaders do nothing.

If Clinton makes the Cuba issue a political and moral imperative and waives Title III again and then mitigates the embargo through diplomacy and principled reason, he will demonstrate uncommon moral strength, vision and leadership.

Cash-starved Russians strike

Workers protest unpaid wages, poor conditions

MOSCOW - Thousands of angry and desperate workers turned out across Russia's 11 time zones yesterday to protest unpaid wages and unstable

working conditions.

"This has nothing to do with politics — it's coming right from our difficult lives," said Natasha Mihiskhina, a defence plant worker who joined hundreds of her colleagues in front of the government headquarters.

"We don't know if we have a job from one day to the next. When we do, we don't get any

money."

The nationwide protest, announced two weeks ago by the Independent Federation Trade Unions, fell well short of the millions of workers hurting from lack of pay, and less than 10,000 people milled around Moscow's Red Square under threatening skies late yesterday afternoon.

But the federation said many who stayed away were skeptical of the chance to change anything while Russia is in its worst

cash crisis.

Forty-one of the federation's member organizations ranging from health-care workers to coal miners and machinists planned strikes lasting from an hour to all day.

"Our slogan is 'for labor, wages and social guarantees,' said Vladimir Korneyev, an expert at the federation's Moscow

headquarters.

In the impoverished far eastern port city of Vladivostok, more than 20,000 turned out to blast the government for broken promises of payment, and 160,000 more protested in the surrounding region.

While campaigning for reelection last spring, President Boris Yeltsin promised prompt payment of wages. Now many workers who voted for him are bitter because the money trickled in, then stopped.

"Is anybody listening to us?" Victor Sidelnikov, a defence worker in his 40s who grinned as Prime Minister Victor Chernomyrdin arrived surrounded by bodyguards. "It's nice that somebody turns up. But it doesn't mean much.'

Last weekend, Chernomyrdin asked union leaders to call off the strike and vowed to pay state employees within two weeks.

OUR COMMENT:


We do not know for certain (until we get verification from our friends in Moscow) whether it was thousands or millions of workers that struck in Russia. But, whatever the numbers, the general strike as a means of forcing the government to take notice is gaining momentum.

The weakness to our way of thinking is the supposedly made statement in the Toronto Star story by Olivia Ward is this: "This has nothing to do with politics ..."!!!

Whoever made that statement (a defense plant worker) - she has a lot to learn about labour strikes and conflicts to be sure. ONLY when the workers combine economic demands with political demands is there a real possibility of getting rid of the present capitalist, mafia-infested regime.


