We are proud to announce a joint meeting between our Council and the Staten Island Jewish Issues Committee that will deal with the recent historic meeting of over 400 American Jews in Washington D.C. that called for a just and lasting peace in the Mideast.

The event was the First National Membership Conference of Breira (Hebrew for "alternative"). Breira is a young organization whose stated goals are "democracy within the Jewish community" and a Middle East settlement based on the idea of the Palestinians setting up a separate Palestinian state on the West Bank and the Gaza Strip, which is presently under Israeli occupation. In return, the Palestinians would recognize the state of Israel.

On March 8, Tuesday evening at 8:00, three participants of the conference will give an informal REPORT BACK at the home of Angelo D'Angelo, 172 Coventry Road (off Todt Hill Road).
