EDITORIAL CLINTON URGES LINKS WITH RUSSIA!


All news dispatches and media reported on this Moscow meeting with glee and showed the amicable discussions between the two presidents - Putin and Clinton.

We know what the public relations promote to the general public during these meetings, but we also know about the behind-the-scenes discussions and manipulations that also go on. President Clinton was not in Moscow to see the Kremlin or the sights...he was there in earnest to make certain that the government of Putin follows the USA's written scenario for the complete domination of Russia and its rich natural resources.

Yes, President Clinton mentioned "our differences" and "we must be partners" and of course he touched on "freedom for Chechniya" and "USA and Russia have interests that coincide".

What really to us is unbelievable is that Clinton, while speaking to the Duma members for 45 minutes, received from Duma members a thunderous applause...even from all the communist members of the CPRF! Only member stood up to shout and chastise the Duma members for the applause was Vladimir Zhirinovsky...of course as an opportunist hound for publicity, nevertheless he told Clinton to "lift the blockade of Iraq and withdraw troops from Yugoslavia and do not interfere in Russian affairs!"

Meanwhile, Gennady Zyuganov, leader of CPRF and a member of the Duma had only this to say: "Clinton could have been more honest" about the situation in Russia! What a missed opportuniuty to let Clinton know the opposi-



tion of Soviet people to the policy of USA and its criminal actions all over the world!

After visiting Moscow, Clinton went to Kiev, Ukraine in order to hobnob with the Ukrainian nationalist president Kuchma and he promised \$100 million in order for Ukraine to shut down reactors in Chernobyl and for USA to invest in other nuclear power stations. Why only now, after years of inactivity? And, who was REALLY responsible for that Chernobyl disaster? In whose interest did this accident really happen?

To add fuel to the fire and to complete the sell-out of Russia, Putin shall also visit Italy and meet Pope John Paul to beg him to use his influence in order to: "help Russia gain political and also military inbtegration with Europe".

With all of this intrigue going on in Russia and in other former republics, why on earth is it so difficult for the left forces to unite against this danger? How many Trojan Horses are there in the communist movement in Russia and other republics?



The conference adopted by a majority of votes a Declaration and an Appeal to all people of Russia. There was elected a Coordinating Committee of 24 people who were then instructed to take steps to organize and promote the absolute necessity of forming a one united Communist Party of the Soviet Union and to call another conference to finalize the details and adopt the CPSU statutes. 


FROM MOSCOW

KLA-LINKED GANGS COMMIT 2000 ROBBERIES IN SPAIN

"The group's organization, like its tactical operations, is military, and they are financing the Kosovo Liberation Army."

Two thousand holdups are a lot of attacks; too many crimes to be just a coincidence, according to the accounting of the Spanish Security Forces who seem to be helplessly observing the seemingly unstoppable activity of these KLA gangs who spearhead the robberies of Spanish companies.

According to Spanish security forces it seems that none of the members of these gangs spent anymore than a couple of days in jail. These gangs are now centrally commanded and are not your typical criminal organization, according the police and the Civil Guard. The nucleus of all of these gangs are made up of Kosovo Albanians coming from the former province of Kosovo. The group's organization as well as its tactical operations is very military and they finance the Kosovo Liberation Army.

"They act with effectiveness of trained commandos", acknowledges the spokesman for the Civil Guard and the private security company. They strike at night, they take all the money from the safes and they never ever use the same tools again, leaving them at the place of robbery so that no detection is possible. While there were only 10 hold ups in Spain in 1995 and 25 in 1996, there were 160 in 1997, 626 in 1998 and no less than 918 in 1999. So far this year they have surpassed over 2000 robberies.

All robberies share the same characteristics as when it started in Valencia, then spread to Alicante and Madrid plus other localities across all of Spain... Tarragona, Validolid, Galicia and Levante. They live in luxury besides financing the KLA. Photos of some 300 members of this KLA is in the police files. There were some arrests but this did not stop the epidemic of robberies. They use sophisticated military phonelinks, never using the same cell phones twice and seem to have great contacts in Germany where a large number of Albanians live.

It seems that there is a Central Command in all of these operations and so far these KLA gangs have robbed and amassed over 4,000 million pesatas. Most of it is sent then to bank accounts in Germany and Switzerland from where it is then funneled to Kosovo Liberation Army (even though it's not called that now -Editor) They have many money transfer accounts. They now are heavily investing their loot in order to gain more finances in prostitution brothels in order to give them cover for their activities.

Lately they have contacted Spanish right-wing groups in order to help them in these robberies.

This newspaper is the official organ of the CC Russian Communist Party-CPSU. In an article about the past March 26th presidential election, here's what the Editorial said:




Yes, the election choir has ended its concert. What is waiting for Russia? What does the State want from the people and what do the people want from the State?

It's obvious that the State (Putin) wants perseverance and obedience. The State shall receive this but only for a short period of time. The people shall receive from the State 100 days of hopefulness and 100 days of disappointments. This is the guaranteed position of Putin--- the person who wants to immediately sit on all the chairs.

"We must fight not with the Communists, but for a better life for the people"- said Putin. We also state that "We must fight not against Putin but for a better life for all the people, which means struggles against the present regime and against those who are defending it!"

Putin immediately stated that he must make the State stronger and continue much faster the market reforms. But at this conjuncture this is impossible in Russia. The manipulation of counted votes is obvious to all even by this one fact alone...On March 27 the



counted ballots overnight gave Putin votes quite different from those that were officially tabulated on March 26th...they rose from 45% the night before to 52% the morning after!?

(Other articles in NSC dealt more in detail with this manipulation and falsification of votes. Editor)

Even in spite of this manipulation Putin and his administration did not get a majority of 70% of votes as they predicted.

The political situation is understood, since Putin has not yet formed his own party to support his every effort. His main support is from the "New Russians" and their capital and also from the national-patriots and from the flow of former left-wing voters who voted for Putin. Thus Putin's tactics will be to try and please the right and the left...very tactfully exploiting each side against the other and thus "governing".

What about the "official" opposition. We would like to be wrong here, but the CPRF (Zyuganov) shall do everything necessary to go on a compromising road with Putin. Now, the tactic of the CPRF leadership faction in the Russian Duma is not to vote as a "block" but to have each CPRF Deputy vote as he likes...and thus guarantee acceptance of any plans as put forward by Putin.

It is predictable that Putin shall get full agreement from the CPRF on privatization of the land and the new Labor Code which the Russian working class is fighting against. All this will bring into play the complete disorientation and fragmentation inside the CPRF ranks in the Duma and also amongst its membership.

Therefore, the role of all the left Communist parties now is to unite its ranks, come up with a fighting program and tactics to meet the present situation."

For those that saw the Inauguration of Putin on TV should have no doubt that he has pretensions to be the Czar of Greater Russia. Even the honor guards during the lavish and costly ceremony were dressed in the uniforms of the Czar Guards of old. The participation and the role of the Russian Orthodox Church leaders is deplorable and to be condemned!

The subject of patriotism is as old as the human race, for historically elements of patriotism as a kind of attachment to national land, language, traditions were formed already in ancient times. But at the same time as society evolutionally developed, social and economic structures changed. new elements entered into the concept of patriotism. The subject of patriotism is urgent up to now when peace is unstable and the people are under the pressure of hunger, cold, illness and other misfortunes caused by the dismemberment of the Soviet Union and the elimination of socialism.

Political life now in Georgia as well as in other former republics of the USSR is characterized through its diversity. More than 125 political parties are engaged in it. The palette of political views is multi-colored. At first sign the question may seem difficult to answer. But, on the second thought, the answer can be found as easy as ABC, considering that in a class society the

content of patriotism also becomes a class one, for each class expresses its attitude towards the Motherland through specific interests characteristic of it. As bourgeoisie becomes a ruling class its patriotism stops to reflect national features and limits itself to exploiter interests, for according to V.I.Lenin (the complete works; Edition 5, B.36, pages 322-339)"...capital puts the protection of its union of capitalists of all the countries against the working people above the interests of the Motherland, people and whatever else..."

Adhering to the lately preferred of differentiating political parties as the Right and the Left, it is appropriate to mention here that Leftism is pursued in Georgia only by the Union of People's Patriotic Forces (a social and political movement) which comprises the United Communist Party of Georgia and several other organizations. All other political parties are in fact bourgeois.

It is only the Rights among which the Parliamentary seats were distributed after the October 1999 election. Working out the policies of the country, both the party in power, which has a majority of seats, and the opposition minority are sure that they are going the right way. But members of the Union of People's Patriotic Forces have an opposite view, which were openly expressed by the speakers at the 3rd Congress of the UPFG held on February 10 of this year in Tbilisi (First stage) and February 25th in Kutaisi** (Second stage). The participants unanimously denounced the present ruling regime as undemocratic and antipopular. The Statement adopted by the Congress says: (printed in the Georgian newspaper Kommunist, No.3 page I, 2000) "...Mr.Shevernadze and his regime have brought the country to the edge of catastrophe; the

only way for Georgia and the Georgian nation to survive is to change the present regime..."

The word "patriot" is defined as a person who loves and is ready to defend his country. As far as I understand it, love of a person for his Motherland is expressed to his attitude toward the people living in it, especially if a person is one of those in power, one of those, who are trying to prove the necessity of carrying out the reforms in all spheres of life, which in fact have ruined all the remnants of socialism in Georgia...repeatedly claim that the world is changing. Of course, it is. And it would be a political blunder to deny that, But, their statements inevitably entails two rhetorical questions: "Is the world changing for the better or for the worst? Is it changing for the advantage of all the working people or only for the advantage of a comparatively small group of world bosses?"

Asserting that Georgia is on the way to progress and social stability, the representatives of the ruling regime, using all of the propaganda means within their grasp, enumerate first of all the latest achievements of the country on the international level...such as joining the United Nations Organization, the European Union and the World Trade Organization, as well as laying of the oil pipeline Baku-Supsa and putting it into operation. (The value of this oil pipeline is \$6009 million American and its length through the territory of Georgia is 370 kilometers.)

But when the Left opposition produced well-grounded claims that these achievements haven't settled urgent internal problems of the country, which are not confined only to ones present day problems to the large section of the population, the people in power responded right away, "None so blind as those who will not see." My reply to that would be, "The rich and the poor see differently."

Though under pressure of all the dismal facts of the daily life, the leaders of the country had to admit openly that little attention has been attached both by the former membership of the Georgian Parliament and the present government to the mounting urgent social problems. It should be noted however that in the preelection appeals October 1999 the party in power asserted that the next 4-5 years would be the beginning of the golden years for all citizens. My reply to that would be, "Of course, while there is life there is hope, but yet a bird in hand is worth two in the bush!"

Dear readers:

I cannot tell you how many compatriots would share my reply, but according to the reports of the progressive Georgian press, 80% of the population of the country are starving and are deprived of common living conditions. Some newspapers sight data of 90% or even 95%. Whichever figure is true, no doubt, it is regrettably striking and provest ... " that ... the Georgian model of market economy and the construction of a democratic state have totally collapsed, and as more time passes the more the country sinks into an economic crisis. The leaders of Georgia failed to pay off the pensions, salaries and wages for the previous few years." (Newspaper Zarya Vostoka, No.18, page 2, 2000).

Mass poverty of the majority of the Georgian people is an indisputable present-day reality. I would like to draw the NSC readers attention to another grim fact. Old age pensions were not paid up for 6-7 months on end at the best makes up 12 lari (1=\$ 6Am) or 14 lari (=\$7 Am). The cheapest loaf of bread costs 35 tetri (1 lari=100 tetri). Average monthly salary of an employee is 40-50 lari. According to the data of Statistical Department of Georgia (printed in the newspaper Zarya Vostoka, No. 22. 2000) "living

wage of a Georgian family consisting of 4 persons accounted for 184.5 - 196.6 lari per month. Do many people have a living wage if 3-4 persons in a family are unemployed? The data of the late 1999 are even less consolatory the living wage accounted for about 200 lari per person per month. But the present regime keeps mum on these figures and supplies their own inflation figures, although its Statistical Board give the lie to their figures. All pensions and salaries are now firmly frozen. Doesn't it look like an undercurrent policy of genocide?

"Ten years have passed since the coup d'etat in Georgia. The Soviet power was thrown down with the "national liberators" i.e. violent nationalists rose in applause, - says the article in the newspaper Zarya Vostoka, #8, 2000 - "The new powers rejected all the socialist values and quickly turned to the path of market economy - meaning capitalism. Under the slogans of sovereignty and independence, the newly baked "patriots-fathers of the nation", disregarding everything solemnly stopped Georgia's membership in the Soviet Union."

Well, as you make your bed, so you must lie on it. The truth of the proverb can be easily revealed by referring to some statistical data produced by the article under the headline "Ten years that shook Georgia" (printed in Zarya Vostoka,#8,2000,page 1) which in my opinion deserves some specific attention.

Truly there is no difference if you are killed by the government or by an individual - you are just as dead either way. To make the picture even more vivid, several compatible data of the output of some kinds of products of the staple goods and food processing industries should be illustrated here, which will unfold before the readers the unbelievable production decrease in Georgia.

I think that there is no need for enumerating the rest of the 25 basic data printed in the Table of Data as the same gloomy picture will unfold. Even a comparatively small number of the above illustrated figures tend to the conclusion that the consequences of the dismemberment of the Soviet Union are horrible.

It is not only the politicians who are worried about the economic crisis in the country. Some Georgian scientists state that the economic reforms have proved to be very destructive. They make their views known via newspaper articles producing well-researched and convincing arguments. From their viewpoint it is impossible to recover the economy and settle social matters under the present power system, which logically leads to the conclusion that it has to be changed. But the representatives of the present regime have staked too much on the present process to allow it to be shattered as easily as ripe summer watermelon.

President Shevernadze in his pre-election promises was full of resolute aim to establish paradise in the next 4-5 years in Georgia! Well, as the proverb says: "The proof of the pudding is in the eating". I personally dare to express very much doubt as to whether paradise can be established by leaps and bounds. It is a long-term task. I think, moreover, under the present regime and system of power it looks like building a sand castle!

Here a question arises as to how to go on and what to do about the people's suffering and bring it to an end. The people are already fed up with broken promises and do not believe the leaders any longer. It is their democratic right. All lies come unmasked sooner or later. The people are sick and tired of the ruling regime with its waste and destruction of moral values, when everything that is opposed to socialism is hailed as positive. The people condemn the hypocrisy of the bourgeois morality. Though they protests against it and the rotten

order of things passionately, their indignation turns into a blind alley, for many of them are still blind supporters of the alleged "independence" of the country. Yet, more and more people express their disagreement with the policy of the party in power and are ready to uphold the ideas, which can lead the country out of this crisis. More and more people begin to understand that the United Communist Party of Georgia is the only political party advocating the interests of the working class, and more and more people center their hopes on the Union of People's Patriotic Forces of Georgia. More and more people are joining its ranks.


I tend to think that comprising the non-parliamentary parties together and acting strictly under the present law, the tactics and strategy of the UPPFG should be looked at again and some other essential matters should be fully considered. FROM NEWSPAPER VOICE OF A COMMUNIST RUSSIA ONE STEP BACK, TWO STEPS FORWARD

A Conference took place on April 22, 2000 of the Russian Communist Parties Union, in which there took part the Russian Communist Workers Party, All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks, Russian Party of Communists and the Russian Communist Party-CPSU. At the start of the Conference, all the participants of this gathering laid wreaths and flowers at the Lenin Mausoleum.

Each party leader or delegate spoke on the conference theme at hand - namely the unity of the parties against the present bourgeois regime of Putin.

The AUCPB let it be known that it has decided to rejoin the Russian Communist Parties Union.

All parties agreed that without a second socialist revolution there is no way that socialism or the Soviet Union shall be resurrected. A decision was made then to call an extraordinary Congress of all Communist and all left-wing parties-movements in the fall of this year and to approach those organizations that have not as yet joined the ROSSKOMSOYUZ.

The participants of this Conference unanimously agreed that the biggest revisionist danger in the Communist movement are the policies of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation (CPRF) and they all agreed that this party (CPRF) cannot be considered a communist party at all, since it carries on the work of Gorbachev and it supports the present bourgeois regime.



On May 7th of this year in Moscow, Russia there was held an "Inauguration of the President". Putin, who was elected by 30% of the population if you take into account the millions that didn't even bother to vote, took his oath of office. This arranged spectacle reminded one of "Wedding in Heaven". Part of the ritual were enacting scenes from film maker Mikhalko called "Civil Barber". based as an analogue of Alexander III going to heaven, all of this plus the blessing and Church mass by the Patriarch. In place of the crown and scepter-Yeltsin gave Putin the highest Medal of Russia "For Service to the Fatherland"...which Yeltsin wore, we do not know for what he received such a "deserved" Medal! Blessing his personally hand-picked candidate, Yeltsin stated: "Take care of Russia!" In his acceptance speech Putin pledged that he will honor and defend the constitution and independence of Russia and serve the people.

This grandiose ceremony, watched by millions of people was two -faced and hypocritical. There was not one word of truth spoken there! Hypocrisy was concluded by stating one thing in words, while doing something else in deeds.

Yeltsin appealed to "Defend Russia"? Was he not the one who dismembered the USSR and Russia in the first place, and then signed the final act in the Belovezh Agreement? Because of this over 25,000,000 Russians found themselves behind the borders of Russia as second-class citizens and forced to have no rights at all. Russia practicality has no ocean touching its borders in the West as was accomplished by Peter the Great. Putin is trying

to douse the flames with the fires started by Gorbachev and Yeltsin in the Caucasus. Is this not so? Bombed into oblivion, the city of Grozny and tens of other cities and towns. He is bragging about his "victories", throwing in tanks, airplanes, artillery against the Chechen "terrorists". Utilizing all of the mass media, Putin not once has told the truth to the people: the tragedy of Chechniya, where the Russian population is dying, where in the last two wars over 100,000 people perished since the liquidation of the USSR and of the CPSU that held and solidified the friendship of all the people, throwing over 100 nationalities into the dustbin of anarchy. 

there was in Russia no Gorbachev's "perestroika" and Yeltsin's counterrevolution, Dudaev and Maskhadov, these two would have been officers in the Soviet Army, and thousands of soldiers, fighters would still be involved in peaceful and productive work for the benefit of their people.

In his speech Putin called upon all the Russian people to unite. Again a two-faced and demagogic appeal. Unity between who? Odigarkhov, Berezovski, Chernomydrin, Chubais, Potanina and others, who have robbed and raped the Soviet people and dismembered the great country...will the working class unite with them?

Putin from the start pledged that he shall not eliminate the grabbed industries which are now

in private hands, plus the land. His main task now is to defend the gains of the capitalist class. Practically a day before his inauguration, the head of the State, Kasianov, proclaimed that the oil industry giant is up for sale to private foreign conglomerate, but of course it shall be "controlled". People of Russia already know as how this "control" works. Taking over the Soviet industrial complexes, these private, internal and foreign owners managed to "skim off the top" billions of dollars and put them into off-shore banks for a rainy day. That is why Putin is calling for more "foreign investors" who now are stock holders and buying up properties



in the West and West Indies.

The double standards and hypocrisy was also shown in the celebration of the 55th Anniversary of the Second World War. In Moscow there took place a parade of those Second World War veterans that are still living, who received cheap gifts and flowers. Even here you saw hypocrisy on this very sacred holiday. Lies! Gorbachev, Yeltsin and all their clique have decimated all the gains of the Great Patriotic War! They fulfilled the unfulfilled plans of Hitler: dismembered the USSR. dispersed and also liquidated the Communist Party, gave rebirth to capitalism, they turned the Soviet Republics into neo-colonies of the United States of America!'


They made this "Victory Pa-

rade" as a smoke screen to fool the people in order that the people would not ask: Who is it that stole all the fruits of socialism and our Victory? Why is it that the victorious people who were the victors have become the victims?



"UKRAINE DIDN'T DIE YET?"

Please look carefully, my dear readers at the photographs herein, from the newspaper "Kommunist". These people whom you can see, for many years worked diligently on a collective farm Vatutin in the village of Karatul, Khmelnisky region of Ukraine near Kiev. They were building a new life under socialism. They were happy even though the times were hard before and during the war. With every year their lives were getting better and they had enough for all their needs. When the appearance of Gorbachev's, Yeltsin's, Krawchuk's and also Kuchma's "perestroika" came along, things changed very drastically.

Vasil Mishenko worked as a mechanic for 38 years, while his wife Olga was a milk maid. This Collective Farm had over 3,000 head of cattle and their pay was in the amount that they had everything. But now... how can you live on 37 hriven per month, which is only \$7.00 old age pension?

Now, without any input or agreement by the collective farmers, the state has privatized all the farm lands, telling people that "Now you own your own land!" He protested as did many collective farmers but they were told: "Take your personal belongings and get out to whatever corner of the earth you want!" Where can anyone go when all the machinery is on the collective farm and expropriated by the private owners?

Because of Kuchma's reforms, the village of "Mala Karatul" as do other villages and towns are dying out. His own village of 70 houses is completely boarded up and no one is living there.

"Ukraine is not dead yet" - are the words of the present Hymn of Ukraine. Yes, of course Ukraine is not dead yet...it is still breathing. Step by step the villages are dying. Ukraine is sinking away fast from its glorious past as a Soviet Republic.

Results of Kuchama's "Reformation" in the village of Sasiv

As was reported by the newspaper "Village News" (21-04,2000 by lgor Tabilsky) the collective farm "Bug" in the village of Sasiv, Lvov region, not too long ago was one of the modern, mechanized agricultural enterprises. They had 2,500 pigs, 2,200 cattle, amongst whom were 600 milking cows. The harvest of fruit, vegetables and other plants were such that all the collective farmers were very happy at their wages and amenities. The collective farmers who were retired received pensions from the collective farm as well as from the state.

After Kuchma's "reformism" (read as total robbery) the village went into dust. This can be seen by the photographs herein, as it looks today after being one of the collective farms that every other collective farm emulated to be like it.

After the collective farm was liquidated, all the farmers were forced to work in private farming



collective as if they were "share holders". This showed itself to be very false. All of the machinery. implements of the collective farm were robbed and dispersed who knows where and left in ruins. The former collective farmers now became "hungry kings". As an example, Andrei Pucila received from the former rich Collective Farm "Bug" two cattle barns in absolutely ruined condition as the photo shows. The ten cows that he got, were in such a starved condition that he was forced to ask for feed from the next village.

In order to plant and sow for this year, he has no machinery at all or even gas or oil.

Dear foreign friends and comrades! This is not just one example of the catastrophe that is plaguing Ukraine! This is not a bad dream, not a fable of bad omen or ghosts! This is today's reality. We are left only to marvel, that the citizens of Ukraine under the yoke of the present bourgeoisie robbers and Ukrain-




OUR MOTHERLAND -USSR! VANGUARD OF COMMUNIST YOUTH

old Why is the working class on the territory of the USSR not showing a determined struggle against its enemy, the present usurpers of power, leaving the working class without any social rights, thrown into a situation as slave labor or by not getting paid for 6-9 months at a time? This paradox is not understood by the communists in the West... it just takes a little provocation against the working class in France, Italy or Germany that touches upon their hardearned rights, for the streets to be filled immediately with hundreds of thousands and millions of workers demonstrating against the injustice.

In order to answer this guestion of vital importance, let us look into the question of what kind role does a Communist party play in the workers understanding of their class nature and class interests? What Russia are we talking about?

We are firm supporters of a public and frank discussion of ideas among revolutionary and progressive people and organizations. For that reason, we are pleased by the fact that the Editorial Committee of Northstar Compass have considered that our article "Chechniya: Let's denounce Russian imperialism unambiguously", published in March 200 issue of NSC, contains ideas "that are food for thought" and, therefore, deserves to be discussed. Therefore, we place ourselves willingly under the fire of criticism of the NSC readers. However, we want to express our opinion on some questions that we consider fundamental and that are pointed out in the above mentioned comment of the NSC Editorial Committee.

In the first place there is the question of the character of the

present Russian State; what Russia are we talking about? We consider the present Russia as capitalist and imperialist State and power; the Soviet power, the socialist State, do not exist nowadays. We think that this position must be a common starting point in order to centre the debate on a firm basis and, therefore, to be able to reach some conclusions. When the leadership of the USSR was held by the Krushchevist and Brezhnevist revisionists it was possible to speak about the "Soviet State", since this still kept the socialist key features. But, after the treason perpetrated by Gorbachev and the open restoration of capitalism accomplished by Yeltsin and company, we believe that the question has been completely clarified.

In our opinion, the fact of continuing talking about the "interests of Soviet people" or about "the dismembering of the Soviet Motherland", when what we are really talking about is the actions of the bourgeois leaders and of the present Russian State, seeds confusion amongst the people's masses, diminishes their support abroad and subordinates all their actuation to the chauvinist policy of the present counterrevolutionary leaders of the Russian Federation. The risk of falling into the "Great Russia" nationalism and the "defensism" advocated by the revisionist leaders of the II International, and that was such cleverly and mercilessly combated by Lenin, is more than real.

Taking this starting point into account, we have been surprised by the fact that the comment made by the Editorial Committee to our article states: "It also fails to more concretely name the players in Chechniya...the oil pipeline confrontations to make certain that it does not go through Russian territories, depriving the Soviet people of this necessary fuel ... ". We believe that to consider things in this way is a form of opposing two peoples that, in fact, are oppressed by a common enemy: the new Russian monopolist capitalism. Why do not tell that those who are bombing Chechniya are the same ones who deprived the Soviet people of all their political, economic, social, scientific and cultural gains and who are plundering and selling to the Western powers the wealth "accumulated" during the Soviet epoch? The fact of justifying the aggression against Chechniya as an allegedly defense of the "fuel of the Soviet people" sounds in our ears as the same song when Bush attacked Irag in the name of the interests of the "American people".

All this puts at the order of the day the following question: Does the denouncing and the consistent mobilization against the aggression of Chechniya favours the revolutionary process in the former USSR? And, therefore, does the consistent defense - as a general democratic banner of the right to self-determination of the peoples that formed part of the former USSR favour the revolutionary process of the former USSR? We believe so, because, among other reasons, this would mean to lead the revolutionary action against the present proimperialist leaders of the Russian Federation and would impede the consolidation of the bourgeoisie as the class in power. Well, we do not want to enlarge on that point, but only to point out all this to make clear that we are not in favour of supporting whatever process of independence, but we subordinate this to the development of the whole revolutionary process. For this reason we think that maintain conciliatory to а "understanding" or half-hearted attitude towards the crimes of the new Czars can only benefit to the

very counter-revolutionary bourgeoisie and other revisionist agents.

It is true that, as it is said in the comment to our article, we only make a general reference to the imperialist siege established which encircled Russia. We are fully conscious about that, because this has been done with full intention: we mention it just to reject it as a justification for the aggression against Chechniya. In any case, in the fight amongst the bandits for the sharing of the booty, we will always be on the side of the victims of the sharing. And we will be forced to behave in this way even with the greater motive if one of the imperialistcontenders is formed by the imperialist bourgeoisie of our own "motherland". Certainly, as reqards this point, Marxism-Leninism teaches us that there is no place for any kind of ambiguity nor can we make any sort of concessions to the nationalreactionary ideology.

In Russia, the State has changed hands and, therefore, its class nature has also changed. This must mark before and after when orientating our analysis. For instance, we cannot treat equally the actions of the Chechen leaders when the USSR existed and nowadays. For the same reason, we can and we must go back to the times of Czarist Russia, when Lenin denounced it vigorously, calling it a "prison of peoples"; what has this position in common counter-revolutionary with the attacks that accused the USSR of being "a prison of nations"? Should we continue to hide the reality with the old-fashioned and useless argument that "the enemy may use our criticisms for his own propaganda"? As we said at the beginning, we are not afraid of an open and frank discussion of ideas, and, in this sense, we cannot forget how such discussions were banned for decades to the Communists of the entire world, including the Soviet ones, who were forced to hide the treason perpetrated by the Krushchevite and Brezhnevite revisionist leaders with the excuse of "not to give weapons to the enemy propaganda". In the end, the peoples' masses were the ones who lost out with this false approach and lack of freedom of criticism and of ideological struggle; they found themselves unarmed in front of their enemies, who, in this way, were able to raise and carry out their destructive task. Only revisionism and the bourgeoisie were favoured by so much accomplice silence. Has not the time come of tearing out the gag and making anything possible to avoid repeating such a bitter experience?

As far as we are concerned, we can assure that, in the same way we have always supported - during its existence- the socialist States against the attacks of their enemies, denouncing at the same time the Krushchevite revisionism, we will continue providing support and promoting active solidarity with "Soviet people" in the future, putting the same effort into this task as we do in the struggle against their present imperialist enslaves and the revisionist lackeys

US CONSIDERED A-BOMB ON MOON By Associated Press

A secret US project in the 1950s called for detonating an atom bomb on the moon as a demonstration of the nation's Cold War might, according to a story released by a physicist involved in the plan.

The project, innocuously called "A Study in Lunar Research Flights," was never carried out. But its planning included calculations by the astronomer Carl Sagon - then a young graduate student - of the behavior of the dust and gas generated by the blast. Viewing the nuclear flash from the Earth might have intimidated the Soviet Union and boosted American's confidence after the launch of Soviet Sputnik, physicist Leonard Reiffel said. He directed the project at the former Armour Research Foundation, now part of the Illinois Institute of Technology. "Now it seems ridiculous and unthinkable," said Reiffel, now 72, who later served as a deputy director of USA's NASA during the Apollo program. "But things were very remarkably tense back then." Sagan went on to become a

worldwide celebrity for popularizing science on television. He died in 1996.

Reiffel described the plan in a letter which was published in the May 4 issue of the scientific journal "Nature".

"Nature" published a review of two new Sagan biographies. The author of one of the books suggested that Sagan breached US security in 1959 by revealing the classified project in an application for an academic fellowship. Reiffel then concurred that Sagan probably released classified information.

The exchange in the scientific journal "Nature" now inadvertently shines a spotlight on a period when science in the United States was greatly influenced by Cold War politics.

The U.S. space program was sputtering while the Soviet Union had launched Sputnik and a pair of lunar probes. The U.S. Eisenhower administration considered the lunar blast as a way to reassure Americans that the Soviet "threat" could be countered, while demonstrating to the Kremlin that the United States had an effective nuclear deterrent. Under the scenario, a missile carrying a small nuclear device was to be then launched from a U.S. undisclosed location and travel 238,000 miles to the moon, where it would be detonated on impact. The planners decided it would have to be an atom bomb because a hydrogen bomb would have been too heavy for the US missile.

Reiffel said the nation's young space program probably could have carried out the mission by 1959, when the Air Force deployed the intercontinental ballistic missiles.

Military officials apparently abandoned the idea because of the danger to people on earth in case of a failure. The scientists also registered great concerns about contaminating the moon with radioactive material, Reiffel said.

The Air Force had declined to comment on the project, pending a review of historical records. "There was lots of talk on the part of the Air Force about the moon being "military high ground," Reiffel stated.

More proof of the "lunacy" from the US who brought us the Cold War!

CUBA ACCUSES POLISH REPRESENTATIVES

Cuba has accused representatives of the Polish government of engaging in counterrevolutionary activities. The recent activities (according to Granma newspaper) refers to Polish senator Zbigniew Romaszewski, president of the Polish legislative body's human rights commission. It should be recalled that Poland was one of the two cosponsors of Washington's anti-Cuba resolution in the United Nations Human Rights Commission. The newspaper article states that Romaszewski and another polish citizen arrived in Havana in May ostensibly to promote a scientific cooperation accord between the two countries. His wife plus a translator arrived before on tourist visas to Cuba.

During his stay, the Cuban authorities saw the Polish Senator attend what was dubbed as "economic conference on an globalization" in Pinar del Rio, at which he spoke of the methods employed by the Present Polish government to destroy socialism in Poland-including the underground tactics used. Counterrevolutionaries, which included known agents of USA Miami's Cuban-American National Foundation. and members of the Pinal Del Rio's Catholic Church hierarchy were present at this conference.

In another gathering attended by this Polish senator who systematically slanderd the Cuban Revolution, was at the residence of the Polish Embassy in Havana, Romaszewski told his audience to prepare themselves to govern the island, since it is known that socio-political Cuba's system would "only survive another five years at the most". He also asserted that Cuba is now undergoing the process that occurred in the former Eastern European Socialist camp.

Noting that the Polish senator gave an undetermined amount of foreign currency to the so-called dissidents, the Granma newspaper article termed any comparison between Cuba and Poland as "absurd". It also noted that everything that imperialism was capable to muster against Eastern Europe and the once powerful camp of socialism, it cannot do anything against a small island only 90 miles from its shore.

The Granma newspaper said that Cuba will "continue to monitor the activities of those who are nothing more than mercenaries of the US State Department or the CIA - whose histories and horrors are overwhelming!"

The Miami Myth Machine By Rodolfo F.Acuna

A Imost every Mexican American, it seems, has a grandparent or a great-grandparent who rode with Pancho Villa. Few know or admit having ancestors who opposed the Mexican Revolution and supported the dictator Porfirio Diaz. The events surrounding the Cuban boy, Elian Gonzalez remind me of this tragic page in Mexican-American history.

Like the Miami Cuban Americans, the Mexican exiles arrived after the 1911 overthrow of Mexican dictator Porfirio Diaz, actively pressured the U.S. government to intervene in Mexican affairs and overthrow the revolutionaries who have taken away their land and privileges. Those exilados dreamt of the day when they would return to Mexico and resume the old ways. Time and the truth about Diaz and his dictatorship changed the reality of those exilados, for as imperfect as the Mexican revolution was, it at least gave most Mexicans another vision of themselves.

Although the Cuban revolution took place over 40 years ago, the

Cuban exiles fervor and dreams of returning to their land and privileges still burns hot. Few Cuban Americans remember that Fulgencio Batista Saldivar came to power as a result of a 1952 coup and that it was Batista's political illegitimacy that made the rise of Castro possible. In the process they seem to forget that it was Batista and other dictators who turned the island into a Mafia fiefdom that allowed Cuba to be monopolized by international land companies like the United Fruit Company. More important, they forget that many of their leaders supported these oligarchies.

Unable or unwilling to create a revolution from within, they continue to pressure Americans to fight a war that they themselves cannot wage. Cubans living in Miami, because of the Cold War and their alliance with the most reactionary sectors of US society, have been much more effective in controlling American foreign policy than Mexican exiles were in the first part of the 20th century. Certainly more enduring.

The appeal of Jorge Mas Canosa and groups as the Cuban American Foundation lies in the perception that they can control, or at least influence the American foreign policy now towards Cuba. Therefore it is not surprising that



they see the Elian Gonzalez controversy as a test of this power. So they desperately fall back on their habit of myth making, blaming their every calamity on the Cuban bearded one, and angrily blaming Castro for abolishment of democracy in Cuba, as if it ever existed.

U.S. Cuban exiles spin myths such as that Cuba was democratic before Castro, and that God destined them to free Cuba. The reality is that these people are not part of the modern Cuba. Anyone who has been to Cuba or had relations with the Cuban community in the United States would be dense if they did not notice the contrasts between the two societies just in terms of race. I remember a Cuban American neighbor telling my wife that she had married well because I was of a lighter hue. She would emphasize that although working class, she was a gallega (Galician), not an African Cuban. She very frequently called all the Blacks, los morenos, as apart and less than white Cubans.

When in Cuba last July (1999) | witnessed a racially mixed society, with over two-thirds of the island Black or Mulatto, Almost every Afro-Cuban intellectual 1 ever met repeated that he or she would not have become a professor if it had not been for the Cuban revolution. In watching the talk shows on TV from Miami or all the crowds in front of Elian's distant relative, Lazar Gonzale's home, over 95 per cent of the Cuban-Americans in the audience or the mobs are obviously white Hispanics.

I make this point because Cuba of the exilados does not exist. The integration of the races in Cuba contrasts with the reality of Miami where any intermarriage between white and black Cubans has been more an aberration than the rule. If they were ever to return to Cuba, the wanna be Cubans will find a society with different memories and values than their own.

Out of historical curiosity, we should perhaps ask how and why

the Mexican exiles fervor burned out while Cuban American community remains now trapped in a cesspool of intransigent nationalism? It is because of the success of the extremist groups as the Cuban American National Foundation, natural immigration and contact with the island, has been prevented. Unlike the Puerto Rican or the Mexican American, its island has not continuously nurtured and regenerated the Cuban American. They now find themselves trapped in time. In turn, Mexican and Peurto Ricans in the US have become more racially mixed.

The 2001 census in the USA will make very clear the growing differences between Cuban Americans and other Latino American groups. Many Latinos are indeed questioning whether all the Cuban Americans as a group have suffered a history of discrimination in the United States similar to that of Mexicans and Puerto Ricans. Cuban Americans have become a tiny minority through the stretch of the "Hispanic Label", which has allowed them entitlements usually reserved for Americans who suffered a history of discrimination.

Census 2000 will also count some 32 million Latinos, 21 million of whom are of Mexican origin. Cuban Americans will number a tiny fraction of this total...about 1.4 million, contrasted to about 3 million Puerto Ricans and 3 million Central Americans. The census will also underscore all these differences between the Cuban Americans and the others, for example: the median age of Mexicans in the US is 24.3 years, whereas among Cubans it is 40.8 years (versus 26.5 for all Hispanics and 38.2 for white Americans). The age gap will make the disparity in the income between Mexicans and white Americans even more glaring. The income of the Cuban American exceeds that of the white Americans, while Mexican and Central Americans earn about two-thirds the income of white Americans.

Relations between the Cuban

American leaders and other Latino groups have always been tenuous. Privately, many Latino leaders resent the appeal of Cuban Congressional Representatives Lincoln Diaz-Balart and lleana Ros-Lehtinen to the memory of the civil rights movement, remembering that in the 1960's Cuban Americans to advance their interventionist policies, crawled in bed with almost every reactionary group and leader, working and supporting the Republican party against the best interests of other Latinos. It has always been their way or no way, with the two mentioned Congressional representatives resigning from the Hispanic Congressional Caucus because Mexican American Congressman Xavier Becerra was elected its chair. Becerra committed the sin of visiting Cuba without asking their permission.

Thus, it is not too surprising that other Latino groups do not see the Elian Gonzalez case through the same prism as the Miami Cuba zealots. Unlike the Cuban American community, the continuing immigration from Mexico and Central America has restructed and changed most Latino communities. The Cuban American community in turn has become an intellectually incestuous, unable to regenerate itself, obsessed with preserving a past that was never...even at the expense of a small six-year old boy.

Because Mexican American, Central American and other Latino leaders have not spoken out, they have allowed the false impression that the Jorge Mas Canosas, Lincoln Diaz-Balarts and Ileana Ros-Lehtinens enjoy power within the Latino universe. Cuban Americans, to really set the record straight only comprise 4.3 percent of the 32 million Latinos in this country. They don't speak for the 95 percent!

Lastly, the elite always believe that they are the victims of revolution, no matter how much they contributed to it.



Contemporary Colonialism

Since the start of the violent civil war in Sierra Leone (Africa) in 1991, tens of thousands have died and over a million people have become refugees. The various warring factions mutilated many thousands. Finally, last year Britain and U.S. got the United Nations chief Koffin Annan to send in "blue helmets" the UN peacekeeping soldiers to enforce a cease-fire. They came mainly from African countries. The Nigerian army was the leading force, imposing a "brutal peace" among the various factions. Once the Nigerian army left, the 10-month old cease-fire between the government and the "Revolutionary" United Front" (RUF) ended when the RUF kidnapped 500 soldiers from the remaining UN forces.

Like many other conflicts in Africa and the rest of the world, this civil conflict is not mainly about ethnic rivalry, as the racist Western capitalist media says.

It's about which of these warring factions will control the richest diamond mines in the world, used to finance the armies and the power of faction leaders. The Lybia-trained RUF, which began in the early 1990's as a "people's movement" fighting the corrupt Sierra Leone ruling elite and its imperialist backers, degenerated into a brutal reactionary force. The RUF now control the lucrative diamond mines in eastern Sierra Leone. Over the last two years, the value of diamond exports has dropped from \$60 million to \$30

million. The RUF has grabbed the \$30 million.

For the imperialists it is more than regaining control of the diamond mines for the British and American mineral companies and saving the government of their puppet, President Kabbah, from the RUF forces who are closing in on Freetown, the country's capital. British and U.S. bosses s fear the Sierra Leone conflict will endanger the cease-fire planned in the Congo. UN forces will be sent there shortly in order to end the civil/regional war involving armies from Angola, Zimbabwe, Uganda, Rwanda and South Africa. Congo is the largest country in Central Africa, and very rich in many key minerals, including those used for deadly military weapons. France, is also fighting for its military interests, and is now involved in the Congo, many times conflicting with the U.S. interests.

Also, oil-rich Nigeria is not exactly a land of stability for the Royal Dutch Shell and Chevron, with billions invested there. Recently Nigeria has been wracked by religious and tribal clashes. Also, many workers and youth are fed up with the corrupt ruling class, who share the oil bonanza with the big imperialist oil companies while all the masses get poorer and poorer.

Britain immediately sent 800 elite troops from the 1st Battalion of the Parachute Regiment, which led the NATO forces that occupied Kosovo when the war ended there last year. These paratroopers then supposedly were sent to evacuate foreigners. But in reality they're trying to save the president of this former British colony. Royal Marines will follow. Britain also sent a carrier of the coast of Sierra Leone, the sixth Royal Navy ship in the region. (Former Winston Churchill, the arch imperialist, would certainly be very proud of the "Labor Party" Prime Minister Tony Blair for defending the "British Empire interests" -Editor)

Increasingly, oil, minerals and other huge deposits of wealth are

being uncovered in Africa. Internally, different factions are fighting for control of this wealth. Civil wars are erupting with murderous violence, with no clear end in sight. So while the UN chief Koffi Annan asked U.S. Secretary of State Madeleine Albright to send a U.S. rapid deployment force to Sierra Leone, Albright appears very reluctant to committing any troops, U.S. bosses are still affected by the Vietnam and Somalia Syndrome. Both U.S. invasions ended in costly defeats militarily, financially, and, at that time, in rising opposition of an antiimperialist character.

(Therefore US imperialism relies on the UN itself to do the bidding for the interests of USA.)

For African workers, already ravaged by civil wars, Aids, mass poverty and hunger, imperialism and capitalism are a living hell. The situation cries for organizing a mass communist movement in order to unite workers and peasants against their local and international tormentors!

AGAINST THE BRITISH PLAN TO DIVIDE PALESTINE

The question of Palestine has been raised in a new and acute form. The British Royal Commission proposes to divide this small country into three separate parts and by this means not only to prevent the people of Palestine from realizing national independence, but also to keep on and intensify the enmity and hatred between Arab and Jew that have been so sedulously fostered by British imperialism.

In the discussion of the report of the Royal Commission which took place in the British House of Commons, there were many different interpretations given of what Sir Henry McMahon promised the Sherif Hussein of Mecca in 1915, or also of what he meant when he said that Great Britain will, "acknowledge the independence of Arab countries, in every sense of the word independence".

There were also similar attempts to water down what was done by "Lawrence of Arabia" just as there numerous interpretations of what even Balfour said, or what Balfour meant, in his declaration of a National Scheme for the Jews in November of 1917. But, however much speculation there may be on such matters as these they all appear to be besides the point. Whatever British diplomats may have promised to one side or the other, nothing can alter the facts the Arabs of Palestine have and must secure the right to their own land, to develop their own form of government and to determine the course of their own lives in cooperation with all their Arab or non-Arab neighbors.

For centuries the Arabs and Jews have lived in close association, in peace and amity. There is no reason why it should not continue to be so. When during the middle ages, Jews were suffering the most unspeakable persecutions throughput all the rest of Europe, in Spain under the Moorish occupation they made there a mighty contribution to the advance of civilization.

Today, when in the number of countries, the terror against the Jews has reached a level never known before, the Jews in Palestine have an opportunity as loyal members of an Arab state, of contributing their share to a new advance in that country, and by this means to assist in winning the people of other lands for support of the campaign to end Jewish persecution in Europe.

This means finishing forever with the reactionary policy of Zionism. For Zionism, so far as the solution of the "Jewish problem" is concerned, has always been nothing but a harmful reactionary illusion. In actual fact it has represented and carried through an invasion of Palestine, not in the interest of the Jews, but of British imperialism.

The Arabs, I am certain, would never have objected to a moderate immigration from Europe of European Jews. The more farseeing Jews would have welcomed them, realizing the valuable part they could play in helping forward the development of the country.

But this immigration could usefully take place only on the basis of the full recognition of Palestine as an existing Arab State. Therefore, from the earliest stages of the immigration the Jews ought to have worked with the Arabs for the ending of the British mandate and for the setting up of an independent legislative assembly. Instead of following this, the only wise course, the Jews of Palestine then endeavored under the incitement of the Zionists, to carry through an occupation of Palestine at the expense of the Arabian people.

What other result could have been expected other than the tragic events recorded in recent history? No people, unless they were utterly lost and decadent, would submit without a struggle to the loss of their homeland and to the wholesale buying up of their land, which threatened to deprive them of their living and turn them into homeless wanderers. Certainly all the Arabs were not prepared to tolerate it and time and time again they demonstrated their hatred against the administration that was primarily responsible for their bitter wronas.

In the report of the Royal Commission we read:

"It has been pointed out that the outbreak of 1933 was not only, or even mainly, an attack on the Jews, but an attack on the Palestine government. In year 1936, this was still clearer. Jewish lives were taken and Jewish property destroyed, but the outbreak was chiefly aimed at the government. The word "disturbance" gives a misleading impression of what happened. It was an open rebellion of the Palestine Arabs assisted by fellow Arabs from other countries against the British mandate rule."

Despicable propaganda has been used in Britain and elsewhere in an effort to discredit the heroic struggles of the Arab people. Arab men and women valiantly placed their lives and liberty in jeopardy because they were fighting in a cause that was just, the cause of national liberation. Yet we were told that it was the outcome of some "foreign incitement" or that it was the "fanatical" Mufti and his immediate associates amongst the Effendi who were using the Arab people for some sinister end of their own. But it does not require "foreign incitement" or Muftis, to arouse the people threatened as the Arabs were. They were left no other course but the path of revolt, and all who believe in freedom, in the right of peoples to self-determination should have been wholeheartedly with them in their fight.

With great courage they have asserted their right to Palestine and demonstrated their determination to carry on till this right is recognized and established. So now, the British imperialists, faced with the impossibility in continuing with the imposed mandate, make a new and unbelievable maneuver in order to retain their power over this important center in the Near East. On several occasions in the House of Commons emphasis has been paid on the vital position of Palestine arising out of a new international situation in the Mediterranean and the Red Sea. With quite cynical disregard of the Arab people, Mr. Amery, the diehard imperialist and Conservative leader, told the House of Commons that in the new situation that had developed, "Palestine was the 'Clapham Junction' of the air" and must be retained at al costs by the British Empire. (Clapham Junction is a wellknown center in London from which roads and transport branch out to all parts of London -note by William Gallacher.)

The mandate, the regime that existed hitherto, having failed, it is with this end in view that partition is now proposed. Whatever is offered to the Arabs or the Jews, the real power, the real control, remains with the British imperialists.

But the Arab people will no more submit to partition than to the Mandate. They will carry on the struggle against the proposed "rape of Palestine" and for full self-government over the whole of the country. Already much of the best land has been taken from the Arab peasants and it is proposed that 225,000 Arabs on the Jewish side of the "partition" are to be transferred. What a blessed word - "transferred." Driven off the land they have owned and cultivate for generations, they will now be "replanted" somewhere, maybe to starve and die. "Transferred" and "replanted". How is it possible that such barbaric treatment of people (however simple their economy may be) can be contemplated?

At the dawn of capitalism in Great Britain forced year after year thousands of men, women and children were driven off the land, forced to cross the sea to the new land in the West, never any more to see or cultivate the land they loved so dearly.

Is this picture to be repeated in Palestine?

Can the people of Britain tolerate such a terrible injustice, which can only be perpetrated by the prodigal use of armed might? For certainly the Arab people will not tolerate. They will fight with every means against this robbery, against the attempted "rape" of their land, against the attempt to turn it into a "Clapham Junction in the air" for British imperialism and they will be right to fight.

But what of the Jews throughout the world? What have they to say to the criminal attempt forcibly to tear a country into pieces and drive all its peoples off the land? Are they still under any illusions about the politics of Zionism or are they beginning to understand that the Zionist reactionary leaders of this movement are actually betraying the Jewish people?

My own Jewish comrades have always been clear of the reactionary role of Zionism, but thousands of splendid Jewish men and women have come under the influence of Zionist leaders and have been led to believe that Zionism was the way of release from the persecutions that have made life a continuous hell of torture for so many Jews.

But when the Zionists lead them into the camp of British imperial-

ism, when they identify their interest in Palestine with the interests of Britain and against the Arab people, then the question arises: is this policy calculated to bring relief to the Jewish people who are enduring so much in Germany and Poland? Will it make their lot easier or more difficult? Obviously the latter is the case.

Have the young men and women in the Zionist movement ever discussed the meaning of the project that Palestine should be given to the Jews and should become " a dominion of the British Empire"? Ivor Montagu, one of our best Jewish comrades, effectively exposes and disposes of the Zionist Congress in the Daily Worker of August 14. Here is what he says:

"The Zionist Congress in Zurich, Switzerland must make all Jews, proud of their people, blush with shame.

"They will assert their rights to Palestine. They will obtain their rights. From whom? The British Government.

"The British Government, to whom Palestine does not belong, is called upon to keep its promise, which it has no right to make, by forcing the inhabitants, to whom the country does belong, to give it to the Zionists.

"The Zionists are modern; goahead, destiny is on their side; Arabs are backward, lazy, barbaric, and will be benefited by the invaders. The Zionists claiming Palestine speak with the accents of Mussolini and empire, or Hitler, or Japan in China...

"Realists among the Zionists are aware, and say frankly, that their one trump card is to play good little combination excusepoliceman for the British Empire. They are not realist enough to reflect on what happened to the Assyrian, who did the same thing, when the British Empire had no more use for him.

"Jews who were not Jewish Nazis would know their only "right" in Palestine is such that they can negotiate with liberated Arabs in the building up of a prosperous Arab state. If only they will understand this and act accordingly how much better it will be, not only for them, but for the Jewish population throughout the world."

For all of us must participate in the struggle to secure for Jewish men and women in the land of their birth or adoption of equal rights to citizenship as any other citizens. This must apply in Germany, also in Poland and all other countries. Only in the land of triumphant socialism, the USSR, has put an end to all kinds of national oppression and to anti-Semitism. The USSR represents a real fraternal alliance of the peoples. The Jews throughout the world have made a civilization of which they can be rightly proud of. Cooperation of the Gentiles with the Jews must take the place of the criminal anti-Semitism that is being so vigorously fostered in certain European countries at the present time.

But the struggles to establish the rights of the Jews in Germany, Poland and elsewhere cannot be aided if the Jews allow themselves to be used by the British imperialists for the purpose of depriving the Arabs of their rights. On the contrary the greatest possible injury will thereby be inflicted on the Jewish cause.

Therefore, I appeal to the Jewish men and women, as one long associated with them in the fight against persecutions and slander, to give no support to the attempt that is being made to carve up Palestine. Palestine is the country of the Arabs. An independent Arab state guaranteeing full and equal citizenship to Jewish men and women and will do a thousand times more for the Jews throughout the world than any alliance with British imperialism can ever do.

In unity with the Arabs, establishing a strong democratic legislative assembly, building up the economic life of the country, and in this the Jews can give an extraordinary contribution, developing its culture and general wellbeing - in this way Palestine can become a prosperous and happy country and the unity established there can be the forerunner of a much greater unity throughout the world.

No partition of Palestine, but Palestine as an independent Arab state, for this all honest Jews and all lovers of freedom, man and woman, must fight! With many thanks to Eric Mueller, reader of NSC in Texas, USA

LENIN'S ANALYSIS OF IMPERIALISM

Below we publish the Statement that was agreed upon by the Executives of the Marxist Workers Party of Australia and the Executive of the Communist Party of Australia, Melbourne Branch.

Both ot these parties signed the issued Call for an International Council for Friendship and Solidarity with Soviet People.

LENIN in his profound analyses of Imperialism drew the conclusion that imperialism has reached its highest stage of development and was in decay, was parasitic and moribund. That the era of socialist revolution was at hand.

Marx showed that each social system developed and changed with the development and changes in the means of production...and that each social system decays when the relations of production become a fetter to the operation and development of the means of production.

Imperialism has reached this stage. The social reforms of production require that the fetter of private appropriation and private ownership of the means of production be removed. The only solution to the contradictions of imperialism requires the abolition of private ownership through the socialist revolution.

The huge surplus wealth, accumulated by capitalism is not used to increase the wealth of society by increasing the amount of commodities produced, because imperialism has severe market problems. Capitalist production and reproduction is dependent on the sale of commodities produced



before reproduction can take place. But imperialism is restricting the market through its attack on wages, longer hours of work, fewer workers, lower wages, poorer conditions, part time and casual labor, and the impoverishment of the Third World. Imperialism intensifies exploitation, and reduces the percentage of surplus

value going to the working class. It is driven to this through the falling rate of profit. The growth of unemployment, poverty, illiteracy, disease and homelessness effects the market. Imperialism is decaying. Imperialism is moribund. It is unable to develop at the rate that the highly developed means of production makes possible, because the market does not grow as fast as the means of production. While the human need is there, the lack of purchasing power prevents the satisfaction of that needs. A savage struggle for markets between the imperial powers racks the people of the world, which if not resolved will result in war.

WHAT DO THE IMPERIALIST DO WITH THEIR SURPLUS VALUE?

They speculate on the Stock Exchanges, they speculate in currency, they speculate on the future price of shares. There have been repeated crashes on the world Stock Exchanges. The most recent one was the most serious. The accumulated wealth of the capitalist class does not result in greater wealth in society but in waste and speculation. Imperialism is parasitic.

Lenin's conclusion was that imperialism speeded up the centralization and concentration of capital, and consequently caused more devastating and ruthless competition between monopolies. Bankruptcies, mergers, and take over are part of the process on the concentration and centralization of capital. This process is rampant in capitalist society today. This process also increases the tendency for the rate of profit to fall, not necessarily the amount of profit, but the rate of profit.

The imperialists fight this inevitable process by intensifying exploitation. This is the law of capitalism. The more the capitalist crisis and competition forces mergers and takeovers the bigger becomes the problem of the fall in the rate of profit, and the contradiction of imperialism grow

sharper. Efforts are made to destroy the Trade Unions, after destroying the workers political party, the Communist Party...the capitalists wage an ideological war to destroy working class consciousness, assisted by the revisionists and reformists with proposals that class struggle is not necessary and that a peaceful transition to socialism is now the road forward. The peaceful cooperation between imperialists will replace the violent struggles for world domination by the imperialists and their transnationals.

The capitalists wage an ideological campaign to replace the proletarian collective methods and views with individualism. Part of this process is to eliminate the trade unions in the work place and replace them with various forms of individual contracts, part of this ideological campaign is the idea that the working class do not need a party of the working class, but a party of the whole people, i.e. class collaboration and similarly the idea that is the concept of the state of the whole people which is meant to replace the dictatorship of the proletariat. This is a further betrayal to subordinate the interests of the working class to the interests of the capitalist class.

Lenin also drew the conclusion that the contradictions between the imperialists grow sharper. The struggle for the world hegemony is very sharp today. While the USA remains the most powerful imperialist power, it is being challenged by the European Community, particularly Germany and also by Japan.

US as a world power is finding it more and more difficult to force its partners into supporting all of its military adventures.

Even though the United States is being challenged by Germany and Japan, the decay of imperialism is also evident in these countries, i.e. high unemployment, financial crisis, stagnant economies. As V.I.Lenin pointed out, imperialism will not fall on its own accord, it will have to be overthrown because imperialism has no answers to its problems, they are playing out the laws of capitalism. Imperialism invents lots of bodies to try and protect its interests, i.e. NAFTA, WTO, IMF, NATO etc. The challengers to American imperialism are also developing similar trade and economic blocs to protect their interests.

The third contradiction that Lenin spoke about is the contradiction between imperialist powers and the developing countries. These contradictions are also growing much sharper, and in a number of countries armed struggles is now the main feature of this contradiction. This is the weakest link of imperialism.

The capitalist rationalists answer to the crisis of over production is to privatize public utilities. deregulate, cut government spending on health care, public education, public transport, civil liberties. Governments seek to reject their civil responsibilities through such policies as "mutual responsibilities", "user pays", "small government" and "low taxation" and reducing the share of surplus value taken by the working class.

All of these "remedies" increase the problem of overproduction, while the basic problems remain untouched. This is just one example...social production is fettered by the private ownership of the means of production and the private appropriation of the products so produced.

The solution remains a social revolution, the social ownership of production and the goods so produced. The elimination of the profit motive and replacement by production to serve the needs of the people is a must. This needs the establishment of the dictatorship of the proletariat.

Why the dictatorship of the proletariat? Marx and Engels have brilliantly showed that the class most closely associated with the developing means of production will lead the revolutionary movement. The working class is the class on whom this responsibility falls upon.

The imperialists talk about the

"globalisation" but in fact they're talking about Imperialism, this is in fear of the conclusion drawn by Lenin that imperialism is on the eve of a socialist revolution. So these imperialist developed a whole new series of "remedies" such as more democracy, concern for the impoverished, concern for the inequalities produced by economic rationalism etc.

The revisionists endorse this view that the transnationals are all powerful, that nations have almost ceased to exist. But the fact is that nations do exist, and the transnationals are all Nation, based on and work in the interest of the domination of their base nation.

The capitalists and revisionists try to stifle resistance through fear and in this way they serve the interests of imperialism, in the same way as they tried to prevent the struggle against nuclear war by fear.

The fact is the imperialism is in a deep crisis and has no way out.

Another false conclusion that many supporters of globalization draw is that since globalization is the world power, and not a nation based, then a revolution must be a world revolution. That is a Trotskyist theory, which rejects Lenin's theory, proven in practice that since a characteristic of imperialism is its uneven development, socialism is possible in one country. Lenin also wrote that a revolution would be most likely where imperialism had its weakest link. This today is in some of the developing countries.

The need for genuine unity of all the Marxist-Leninist parties is now so that the unified demands shall be made to reverse the policies of economic rationalism.

These immediate needs, if we are to avoid reformism must be tied-to raise the strategic demand for a socialist solution to the contradiction of capitalism.

THE ELUSIVE Workin<mark>g Class</mark> Unity

The question raised in the May issue of NSC is very interesting about the working class unity. I would like to add my voice to this necessary understanding.

It was mentioned in the article that there were scores of meetings, many congresses and conferences, where they preached anti-imperialism and pro-Marxism-Leninism, but no unity was achieved amongst the Communist parties of the world or among the communist parties in former Soviet Union.

As I discovered myself and as I am convinced that somehow this necessary communist solidarity is treated more like a religion, not as a social-economic problem that must be resolved.

Somehow we view all political parties as separate entities, each trying to advance itself. Some of the communist and progressive parties do not seem to recognize the working class as an entity, but demand that the working class finance them and do the assigned tasks and at the same time some party leadership take the attitude as if it is the only thing that the working class is ever capable of. Sorry, but this just does not work that way.

The capitalists, their political parties and some well meaning trade unions suffer the same disease, competition and contradiction. Competition puts capitalism on a tread mill, and that is the way that many private enterprises go broke.

Political parties in all capitalist society suffer from the same competition as they try to resolve their problems.

Unions and their members are forced to compete for jobs, bargaining units, agreements, overtime, grievances...each time trying to advance.

Astute corporations in the imperialist stage are forced to form joint ventures and amalgamations, industrial take-overs, partnership, mergers, forming big oligarchies in order to improve their market share and profitability.

The working class in order to overcome all of their capitalist socio-economic problems have to understand how the working class is used by capitalism. The working man has nothing but his 10 magical fingers and the ability to work. The very great majority of the working class have no assets or investments to make them money. They need a job always.

Workers are constantly being used by capitalism to achieve their ends by means of racism, bribery, religion, national color, in order to keep them divided and to insure that capitalism is their boss and shall remain their boss.

Workers must be made to realize that the only way to win their demands in the social-economic field is to organize unions and unite on political issues. The Moro Liberation Struggle

Recently, the kidnapping of foreign (mostly Western) plus Filipino nationals from a Malaysian island resort by the terrorist organization Abu Sayyaf once again cast the international spotlight on the Moro people's struggle for liberation in the southern Philippines. Strangely enough, the Estrada regime unleashed an all out military offensive not against Abu Sayyaf but against a very different organization, the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF), even as it vowed to destroy terrorism. As a result hundreds of thousands of people were quickly displaced from their homes.

The Moro people are the Muslim minority of the Philippines. They consist of 13 ethnolinguistic groups living mainly in the southern Philippine island of Mindanao and the archipelago of Sulu connecting Mindanao with Sabah, the northern Malaysian peninsula on the island of Borneo.

Islam came to the southern Philippines during the 13th century courtesy of trade and began its slow advance to the rest of the country. In the 16th century, its advance was halted with the coming of Spanish co-Ionialism. The Spaniards eventually conquered and converted to Catholicism most of the Philippines. The Muslim groups in the south, called Moros by the Spanish, resisted colonization until the end of the 19th century. During this period, Spain repeatedly tried to subjugate them going so far as to mobilize the newly Christianized populations of the archipelago against their Muslim brethren. The carnage was horrific. The Spanish colonialist were out to exterminate Islam from the archipelago and to subjugate all its peoples. The result was devastation of the economies of these Muslim groups, isolation from the rest of the world, stagnation, an inward looking culture and a siege mentality, the hardening of class divisions and the entrenchment of feudalism. By the end of the 19th century, these Muslim groups were eventually conquered by Spain and put under nominal subjugation. Fortunately just then the Philippine revolution broke out relieving pressure from Muslim Mindanao. This new start was alas quashed by the massive invasion of US imperialist forces. US imperialism used a two prong approach to subjugate the Moros: massive violence and the winning over of its traditional leadership through annual annuities while leaving Islam well alone. Nevertheless, this was the time that the dislocation of Moros from their ancestral lands began with the establishment of big American concerns in Mindanao.

Moro grievances built up during the early years of the republic as a result of the largely Christian central government's neglect and insensitivity, in tandem with the Moro ruling class's corruption. Matters took a turn for the worse with the defeat of the Communist-led Huk movement in the north. To relieve social pressures in the crowded north, the central government began the policy of shipping massive numbers of non-Mindanaoans to the south. As a result, massive displacement of Moros from their ancestral lands began. With the crisis of the ruling system intensifying in the late 1960s, political violence grew explosively in the country especially in Mindanao. Moro communities often became the victims, usually by nominally Christian settler bands frequently armed or tolerated by the government. It became an explosive mix that blew up with the declaration of martial law.

The modern Moro struggle has its roots in the upsurge of the peoples movement beginning in the mid 1960s. Many Moro students participated in this upsurge and were influenced by the currents of the time. The result was a curious breed of pettybourgeois radicalism and Islamic nationalism. These Muslim student radicals would form the Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF) and its Bangsa Moro Army. The MNLF sought to create an independent Mindanao for Moros which it redefined to include all people in Mindanao, not just Muslims, who identified themselves as such. It was however Muslim dominated. The war between the MNLF and the Marcos dictatorship began in 1972. It was a horrific war. The bulk of the Philippine military was sent to Mindanao to fight the MNLF. Around two hundred thousand people died and around an equal number fled to Sabah. Property worth billions in total was destroyed. Nevertheless, due to its own weaknesses, namely reliance on help from conservative Islamic states, and a desire to prove Islamic credentials to the point of rejecting a broad united front with the national democratic movement, the MNLF agreed to the Tripoli Agreement in 1976 which in effect was an act of surrender as it bound the MNLF to the Philippine constitution.

A split ensued in the MNLF the year after that eventually leads to a totally new organization in the 1980s, the MILF. Negotiations between the Government of the Republic of the Philippines (GRP) and the MNLF continued for many years afterward even as fighting between them subsided. These were negotiations of surrender. The result was bogus autonomy, the incorporation of the MNLF into the ruling system and of its army into the police. Meanwhile, the MILF built its strength in the late 1980s because of the unresolved problems of the Moro people and became a real force in the decade afterwards. The MILF differs from the MNLF in its greater stress on Islam. It is nominally critical of the MNLF's secularism. It seeks not independence of all of Mindanao but of areas of Muslim majority and the formation of an Islamic state. Yet at the same time, the MILF is more open than the MNLF ever was to relations with the communist-led National Democratic Front of the Philippines (NDFP). In fact, the MILF formed a formal alliance with the NDFP in December 1998. One other difference between the MNLF and the MILF is the latter's emphasis on self-sufficiency and internal factors. Meanwhile, in the NDFP there is a Moro member organization, the Moro Revolutionary Organization (MRO). The MILF and the MRO work in different sometimes adjacent areas.

The Abu Sayyaf however is not a liberation movement. It has no mass support. It is a terrorist organization created by the military to try and break Moro unity. The Abu Sayyaf consists of renegade MNLF members with, it is said, links to Afghanistan. It appears on the scene at opportune times for the reactionary regime, namely during times of intensified crisis. The current administration of President Estrada is in trouble with his popularity rating taking a nosedive. Meanwhile, the crisis of the ruling system is rapidly intensifying. Rumours of coups now abound. The regime has suspended peacetalks with the NDFP and has gone into all out war against the New People's Army throughout the country. It has increased repression against all opposition and is engaging in a creeping martial law. Just then the Abu Sayyaf reappears with its kidnapping stunt. In the north the shenanigans of the counterrevolutionary "Revolutionary Proletarian Army" reappears with its rocket attacks. Bingo, increased mysterious bombings in Manila the capital like in the days just before the declaration of martial law. Moros and communists are blamed by the GRP. Most know better. Meanwhile the GRP breakoffs its peace talks with the MILF and unleashes an all out military offensive against them.



News from Bussia about Conference for a united CPSU

John Cornwell's historical account throws much needed light on the part played by Pius XII (Eugenio Pacelli) in the worldshaking events that convulsed Europe and Asia between 1933 and 1945, events that resulted in the death of some fifty million people, and the destruction of untold numbers of villages, towns and cities, and the devastation of the countryside as a whole. First, as Papal Nuncio (ambassador) to Germany, and later as Pope Pius XII. he collaborated with Mussolini and Hitler both actively and passively. He admired the dictator Antonio Salazar of Portugal and the even more brutal dictator. Francisco Franco of Spain. Like Hitler, he was rabidly anti-Semitic and had a morbid fear of liberal and democratic ideas. Cornwell calls Pacelli "Hitler's Pope" because the latter worked most closely with the nazi dictator of the Third Reich.

Cornwell describes Eugenio Pacelli's life and his reactionary views in quite some detail. This information is useful, of course, but more could have been said about the comparatively recent past of the Vatican and the popes that ruled there. Such background knowledge is very essential for the understanding of what had and has been taking place in the Catholic world.


It is perhaps not surprising that throughout the history of the Vatican and the popes, the Holy See and its absolute rulers have stood in opposition to progressive liberal ideas and have favored instead all reactionary politicians and their regressive policies. What is especially disturbing is that in the case of Pope Pius XII (Hitler's Pope) this reactionary stance included the taking for granted of some of the ugliest forms of racism and anti-Semitism that culminated in genocide. Pius XII was well aware of what was taking place in Hitler's Germany and the occupied territories, but he never uttered a word of protest. He remained silent.

We know from history that what the Vatican detested and feared most was socialism because it led to enlightenment and emancipation of the people. The Vatican preached and generally forced unquestioning obedience to the church and its numerous dignitaries, ranging from the deacons and priests to all prelates and popes. This is understandable because all reactionary politicians tend to work hand in hand with church officials. It is to be expected that for such politicians it has been invariably advantageous to encourage all religious beliefs and practices. It has been a case of mutual convenience. Lenin was right when he said that religion was the opium of the people.

Pius XII, pope from 1922-1939, who signed the treaty with Mussolini that then established the Vatican City as a sovereign state. He declared in his encyclical, Quadragesimo Anno, 1931, that "no good Catholic can be a Socialist." He also stated on many occasions that the fascist dictator Benito Mussolini was "a man sent by Divine Providence." Of course, it can't be denied that it was providential for the fascist government in Italy and the pope in Rome to have someone like Mussolini in power. They kept the population in hand. They destroyed the trade unions and imprisoned or sent into exile anyone who protested. But it was Pius XII, "Hitler's Pope", who served both Mussolini and Hitler first of all.

Particularly disgusting but not really so surprising, has been the recent announcement by John Paul II (Karol Woytila), the present pope, that he is going to canonize Eugenio Pacelli, in other words, that he is declaring him a saint. What can one say about this decision by John Paul II except that his criteria for qualifying someone for sainthood are remarkable indeed. One can't help wondering whether Adolph Hitler shouldn't also be given a place in John Paul's heaven and have him seated next to Pacelli. Or might one say that they were blood and ashes brothers. Let's not forget Auschwitz and Buchenwald and all of the other nazi extermination camps where millions of innocent people were gassed and burnt.

John Cornwell's title for the book is very well chosen, as is the subtitle. It is high time that this secret history no longer remains a secret in the not so Holy Seat of the Vatican!




