extremely important work of NSC could be jeopardized. However, if there is a *real* basis for such organizational formation, then the 5th Conference will be a good place to put forward such an "International Council".

We hope these thoughts are helpful. Best wishes for a Happy New Year to you, Helen, and the brothers and sisters of the Editorial Board. Rose and I look forward to seeing all of you at the 5th Conference.

Dear Comrades:

And how could Khrushchev topple it as easily if the party democratic machine was functioning rightly without resistance by the grassroots after less than 10 years from the victorious party leadership in the Great National War? There was a time when we supported all resolutions issued by Khrushchev and Brezhnev and the early resolutions issued by Gorbachev fearing that our criticism of some of these resolutions might be exploited by imperialism, on the one hand, and due to absolute confidence in the Soviet Union, on the other hand. But it has been proved that faith is not enough and that it should be replaced by knowledge. It is necessary to have an access to the news of the other former Soviet republics which are absent from NSC pages as well as the news of the former Socialist countries of Eastern Europe.

Once again, I thank the journal and the Editorial Board for the great effort they have exerted up till now and I wish greater future success which will contribute to the achievement of our common objective: the Resurrection of the Union of the Soviet Socialist Republics.

MY SUGGESTIONS FOR 5TH CONFERENCE

Dear Friends:

Just a few suggestions respectfully put forward for careful consideration at the coming conference:

(A) A very thorough look at "what

went wrong" within the Soviet government bureaucracy and the party CPSU during the years leading up to the break up of the USSR. Certainly, there is no doubt about a treacherous role of foreign intelligence agencies such as the CIA. But no nation as large and powerful as the Soviet Union can be brought down from the outside unless there was considerable dry rot within. For example, in the period after the establishment of Soviet Power, and the nation was suffering hunger and their military was not nearly as strong yet, they withstood the combined might of about a dozen foreign invaders and drove them from their soil. And again, during World War II, they were able to withstand and repel the most savage attack in the history of warfare, and pursued the invaders right to Berlin.

It would seem that only dry rot developing from within, combined with internal and external treachery, could bring down such a people and such a nation as the USSR!

Could it be that very large bureaucracies have a long term inherit tendency to and vulnerability to "dry rot"! We see plenty of evidence of it in our provincial and federal bureaucracies. In the early days, there was a cry of "All Power To The Soviets" regional committees of Workers, Farmers, Sailors, Intellectuals, Artists and Soldiers, etc. Could it be that "power" was somehow "stolen" or gradually slipped away into the hands of an ever-growing bureaucracy? (Deliberately or inadvertently without the citizens being fully aware somewhat like a patient with a slowly growing cancer, etc.)

Am not declaring that this is what happened, only respectfully suggesting that we all take a very long hard look so that in the future, measures can be taken when building the New Socialism/Communism, that such a tragedy for mankind CAN NEVER NEVER HAPPEN AGAIN!

Think of the good comrades who gave their lives!

(B) Would also respectfully suggest that the conference consider all the "new factors" in the complex equation in the inevitable final confrontation between the multinational giant corporations and the people. This confrontation could possibly not exactly be as foreseen by the old stalwarts in the late 1800s and early 1900s.

Could it be that fierce confrontations over the destruction of our precious life-giving environment by the socially and environmentally irresponsible activities of the corporations and policies of

governments controlled by the corporations, could occur??? The profit driven irresponsible alteration of our life-giving food and so forth and so on?

There is even the "God Awful" possibility that small contingents of workers could be convinced by "right wing" labour leaders that it is not in their interest to clean up the precious life giving environment as it would wipe out their "Hi Tech" higher-paid employment?

Somehow, preparations must be made in advance to deal fairly and effectively with this possibility. They must be shown that if we continue to destroy our environment and alter our food supply, it will eventually destroy human life and the economy on this planet; just as mankind has gradually come to realize that we must put an end to Nuclear Weapons, Chemical and Biological weapons (Land Mines, etc.), or they will put an end to mankind.

These cold hard realities are thundering downhill towards us like a run-away freight train rolling down a mountain rail line! In other words, these problems must be carefully but firmly and wisely addressed or plan for the rebuilding of the New Socialism and peaceful transition from capitalism will be meaningless.

I know there will be some who will contend (with good reasons) that this is putting the cart before the horse and that we will not be able to clean up the environment and protect the health and well-being of the people UNTIL AFTER WE BUILD THE NEW SOCIALISM. That is why we are putting forward these suggestions to stimulate enlightened and friendly discussion at the important coming conference, so that the guests can take it back to their home countries and regions for further discussion and debate.

There is no doubt mankind is facing tremendous challenges in the new century because these problems are going to escalate in number and come much more quickly.

Could it be that there simply must be a unity between the Environmental Movement and the Forces working for the rebuilding of Socialism? This possibility could be enhanced if the Environmental Movement could clearly see that those who are working for the rebuilding of Socialism have PLACED THE ENVIRONMENT AND PEOPLE'S HEALTH ON THE FRONT BURNER!

NEWS DIGEST COMMENT

VACCINATION - OR GENOCIDE?

The WHO (World Health Organization) and UNICEF (United Nations International Children's Fund) recently collaborated in a tetanus vaccination program aimed at women of child-bearing age in a number of countries. Their health initiative now stands accused of using the vaccination program as a chemical and biological weapon.

Twenty-six out of 30 women tested after the vaccination program in the Philippines were found to be harboring beta-HCG antibodies. The Philippine Medical Association released its pharmacological study of the suspected tetanus vaccine injected into 3.4 million women in their country. Nine of 47 vaccine vials were contaminated with beta-HCG hormone, which causes autoimmune disease and infertility.

There have been similar reports in Mexico and Nicaragua. Although

both WHO and UNICEF have denied the allegations, UNICEF recently lost the support of the Vatican due to concerns about money going toward "reproductive services" – the code name for population control measures.

With the Canadian government, the UN, WHO and affiliated so-called "non-profit" health organizations involved in population control activities, it is only common sense to point out that the fine line has been crossed. How can consumers ever be sure if government health care is for the provision of health services – or for population control? We cannot.

Wise Canadians must ensure that consumer choice in health care is the top priority in the coming federal election.

We must all come together to protect our freedom. Let us not be divided in the fight over special rights. Let us not ask for their protection. These are the tools that may be used to take away our freedom.



KUCHMA - 49.86!

In his time, the present president of Ukraine, Mr. Kuchma stated that if Ukraine does not reach economical stabilization, he will not stand for re-election again. Ukraine is in dire straits! But what does the head of the state say now: "I aim to rule for a long time ..." He forcefully stated that the present course for Ukraine is the "only correct one ..." How can a person lie on the facts that are exactly opposite? The National Gross Product from 1990-97 has dropped by 73%, the industrial and agricultural production is even worse. Our industrial economy has become a colonial economy. Technological development is practically at a standstill.

At the 3rd Congress of Ukrainian Union of Workers held in November of 1997 in Kiev, the chairman, A. Bondarchuk stated correctly, that "financial independence of Ukraine from International financial centres become political has now dependence. The International Monetary Fund does not even hide the fact that it dictates its policy in budget, taxes, social and economic policies and is trying by all means possible to crush the upsurge of revolutionary upheavals that are starting to appear on the territory of Ukraine".

The economic hardships have started the process of dying-off of the population. This falls on the shoulders of Kuchma and his ministers. The pensioners are the most hard hit by these policies. Look at the photos from the newspaper "Tovarish", the organ of the Socialist Party of Ukraine – you can see the plight of the pensioners. They receive pensions of 49 hriven and 96 kopeks. This is the maximum pension. This is approximately \$26 US. The minimum pension which goes to the majority of pensioners is only 17 hriven (approximately \$9 US). Even this miserable pension is held up sometimes months on end. But how can one live on \$9 per month?! For this money, you can only buy the cheapest kolbassa – 2 kilograms.

The president does not care. He has other problems on his mind. On December 17, 1997, there took place a

country-wide political strike. People demanded the resignation of the present regime, establish a government run by the working class in the form of Soviets and all people demanded that Ukraine be united with Russia and Byelorussia.

It is hard to believe that our people are still suffering and not yet

ready to take over actions to overthrow the Kuchma and Co. regime! The following was very well stated by H. Kostruba from Uman when he told the newspaper "Village News" that: "Kuchma would do a great deal of good, if he would not make hardships for the people until 1999 but to immediately resign and say that he will not run for another term!"

But I do not think that asking kindly for Kuchma to resign is the answer! They are all opportunistic – he would not understand this logic. Let us state as did B. Kozub from Kirovogradsk district to the "leader": "It is time to stop mocking us ("Village News" 2/12/1997). Kuchma should be made to resign, retire and receive also a pension of 49 hriven and 86 kopeks!"

In December 1997, in the city of Lutsk, there appeared a Jubilee 350th issue of the newspaper "Spravedlyvist-Truthflness" in the district of Volyn, Ukraine. This jubilee fell on the date practically of the birthday of its editor, S. Lukianchuk – his 70th.

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only 16, he was a member of the Security forces of NKVD who fought the bandits during the Second World War in the Donbass and Northern Caucauses region. The Red Army started its offensive and brought it to its logical conclusion. Great help in this struggle was given by the forces of NKVD, in which the young Steven Savelevich Lukianchuk took an active part.

In 1943-44, the Red Army chased the fascists from its territory, but the German occupying forces left their many agents behind. In Western Ukraine, the bandits of the OUN-UPA were killing innocent people, doing sabotage, not only murdering communists but also peaceful citizens, their own kin who were trying to bring the country up from the terrible ruins. S. Lukianchuk was in the midst of heavy fighting with these terroristic bands. He was very adept as an organizer in these battles with the Ukraińian bandits. He then went to work in the Komsomol organization, then unto party work. There, he dedicated his full strength to rebuild the ruined economy of the region.

From 1955–59, he was the chairman of the Collective Farm named after 30th Anniversary of Lenin Komsomol organization, then as secretary of the Turisko regional party centre. He had many important posts and in 1984, with the rank of a Colonel, he retired, but always active in party and governmental posts.

But when the traitorous transformation took place, his communist dedication was at its highest level. He took up the fight against not only Gorbachev, Yeltsin, but also against Krawchuk and Kuchma of Ukraine.

At the present time, Lukianchuk is organizing the people to struggle for human rights and the rights of the working class, for socialism and communism, for the resurrection of the Socialist Motherland. At this time of great danger, we, members of the Editorial Board and Committee, wish him strength, health and success in our struggle for victory of the working class over capitalism.

HOW THEY DISARMED US!

The tragic situation in our country is such that if it happened in some other country, the people would have long ago thrown out the regime. But our people – majority of them, unfortunately – are quiet. What kind of a spell left our people without capability not for revolution as yet – but to defend their social gains? Why is it that they allow themselves to go hungry, to go on hunger strikes, even to hang



themselves, but not to go unto the barricades, or picketing or meetings? Is it that our people so love the "reforms" and the "reformers" that they are ready to die of hunger for them? But no, these same people are swearing and condemning these leaders. Then why is this passivity?

No, our people did not lately become passive in class struggles. Our people were made like this over a period of years since 1953. The people, under daily barrage of revisionist media since 1953, did not know whom to listen to, since everyone was stating that they are fighting for democracy, humanism, and even socialism and Leninism.

What are the ordinary people talking about, those who complain bitterly about the terrible conditions that are imposed on us by the present regime? Some state: "I will not go with communists because they again will prepare terror and famine against us, etc., etc." "To be involved in class struggle, that's wrong, that means bloodshed! This is civil war!"

This was our lot since 1953 and we people, not knowing or experiencing civil war, not knowing hunger, unemployment or exploitation, or our heroic history – were lulled into this passivity by the same leaders who yesterday were "Communists-Leninists" while today, they lead the counter-revolution! Over a period of 40 years, anticommunist feelings and antirevolutionary psychology were formed in many people!

Did we not, all of us, former members of the CPSU, did we not help in prolonging this fog of vile propaganda? It was we that heaped abuse on Stalin, became members of different "democratic groups" (which now showed themselves to have been counter-revolutionary) we believed the partocrats, apparatchiks, that we shall build socialism cleanly, no problems, humanism shall overtake the enemies. We looked into the future through rose-coloured glasses! It was we that did not kick out the "father of Perestroika", we did not defend even Ligachev, we did support fully the "GKCP" (government members who tried to throw out Gorbachev) – even though these same CPSU leaders were themselves ill with the sickness of not calling out the people onto the barricades. Those who saw further ahead of us - as did Nina Andreeva and Svetlana Goriacheva and their initiative movement - we heaped abuse on them, as enemies of perestroika and helpers to the

CPSU bureaucracy.

Yes, even I am guilty of heaping abuse. But I never became an anti-communist. More than that, in 1991, I became a member of the CPSU. But because I am a historian, I knew full well that the class struggle is very hard. People brought to the verge of panic are capable of terrible things.

These present leaders (some of them) standing under red flags are again promising "pies in the skies", heaping abuse on Stalin, etc., etc. They must boldly proclaim that they are a party of class struggle. Yes, it would be great if we won the revolution by peaceful means, at one blow during the elections, or country-wide strike! But if these present "New Russians" who are in control now, after our victory by peaceful means, will hire killers, terrorists, sabotage agents, and will raise their swords or call upon their "peacekeepers" from NATO - they will see that we are the grandsons and granddaughters of Lenin, Stalin and Dzerzhinsky! Otherwise, we are not communists, but sheep who lead the flock to slaughter. Our humanism must be directed at those who are robbed and exploited, not for those who are the killers and exploiters! Those who feel otherwise, let them serve the masters who in turn will not even say thank you!

Let those be afraid of the Gulag or repression, who are guilty, not the peaceful dedicated people striving for their place in the sun! TODAY, WE'RE MARCHING

Oh, if that was only the truth! We could say it in other words which are not printable. In the newspaper "Sovietskaya Rossia" for December 25, 1993, there was published a very offensive, but accurately stated by one Spanish captain of a fishing vessel.

"What is it that you, swine, did with your country?"

Take a look at the date this was said and think – what would this captain have stated in 1998, when the situation for our people is much worse?

In an excellent article "Communists, Be Vigilant", the author outlines the situation in Byelorussia in the communist movement. Due to space, we cannot translate the whole article, but we quote a very informative segment that needs repeating.

"In 1991 when Gorbachev and other leaders dismembered the USSR, they stated that 'our state is an all-peoples' state' and not a state where there is 'dictatorship of the proletariat'.

During the period since Khrushchev, there grew up generations of leaders who very quickly and systematically became believers in capitalism and dismemberment of the Soviet Union.

We have to remember that since Khrushchev-Brezhnev, nearly all party secretaries, leaders of the Soviets ... these comrades who carried the whole burden of the Great Patriotic War ... these comrades who were called Stalinists, all sorts of false accusations were heaped upon them. In their place, these leaders appointed people who were mostly opportunists, not schooled in Marxism-Leninism, not dedicated workers. Socialdemocratic tendencies appeared in the CPSU and were directly and indirectly supported by the leadership in the CPSU. Nationalists in each Republic were promoted to higher posts in party and state apparatus. The CPSU membership grew like mushrooms after a rain millions of new members who flocked to it to gain positions. The CPSU even admitted into its ranks anti-communist elements. These were the well-placed elements whose aim was to undermine the party from within. This was shown most graphically when in the crisis of 1991, these same 'party members of the CPSU' started to publicly and on TV to tear their communist party cards and publicly burn them!

Workers in front of whose eyes these so-called 'leaders' – 'party workers' were tearing and burning their party cards, of course, started to look at these communists with disbelief and then with no belief in

communists in general. This was of course what was intended to be the feeling of the working class all along."

COMMUNISTS AND THE WORKING CLASS OF UKRAINE

It is already 6 years since the break-up of the Soviet Union and the proclamation of the so-called "Independent Ukraine". During these years of "independence",



Ukraine as a highly developed state of Europe, as a member of the USSR, has now become a colony with its economy in near collapse, crisis in education, culture, health, and premature death of its people. In its economic development, Ukraine has been thrown back 50 years and the slide to disaster is not slowing down. Even if we take the official statistics, which are in themselves made lower by the present regime, in the period of "independence", the population of Ukraine has fallen by 1,200,000 people due to deaths which in turn is due to the hardships and no health care! According to the prognosis of the present Minister of Health, if the present conditions are allowed to continue, the population in 2010 will fall to 25 million people, while today, Ukraine has a population of 50 million!

The marionette regime of Ukraine, headed by Kuchma and Moroz, are fulfilling the dictates of the West, to make Ukraine a colony – raw material resources to be exploited and cheap labour to serve the developed Western imperialist countries. After signing the act of co-operation between Ukraine and NATO (June 1997), world capitalism will be dictating to this "independent" Ukraine not only in the economic sphere and financial politics, but it will direct the military of our country.

The working class is beginning to be aware more and more that the traitorous policies which are being inflicted on the people are antipeoples, anti-national course of the present bourgeois reforms and ever more active the working class is coming to fight for its rights.

During the General Strike in Ukraine of March 18, organized by the All Union of Workers, there took part over 2 million people. The movement is growing wider with every month. Crimea saw thousands of demonstrators in the streets, aimed against NATO and their joint manouvers called "Sea Breeze 97"!

In the coming struggles and battles that lie ahead, the co-ordinating of these actions is done by the CC AUCPB in Ukraine, Moldavia and Predniester Moldavian Republic.

The Bureau of CC AUCPB was organized in June 1995 Plenum. It was responsible at that time for Ukraine only, but then the Moldavia and Predniester Republic were put under its jurisdiction.

The AUCPB publishes in Ukraine the following newspapers: "Bolshevik" – Odessa, "Burevestnik" – Sevastopol, "Workers-Farmers Pravda" – Mukachevo, and a youth

newspaper "Yunkom", Kiev Region in the city of Boyarka. Kuchma and company are beginning to try and shut down some of our newspapers. Thus, in Mukachevo, the newspaper "Workers-Farmers Pravda", they are trying desperately to close the newspaper, but the demonstrations of the people are making it harder for the regime to do this. We are continuing to call upon the people for revolutionary struggle for the Power to the Soviets, Socialism and the resurrection of the USSR.

Our aim after two Congresses is to cement our relations with the working class, organize it and work in enterprises with workers' collectives.

The Kharkov organization is doing very good work among the worker collectives. They have established Soviet of Workers in the enterprise "Hammer and Sickle". They organized picketing, protests, selling of our newspapers, distributing leaflets, holding meetings and agitational discussion. Kharkov workers and AUCPB members are active in the workers' movement "Kharkov Labour", taking an active part in all sorts of workers' demonstrations, picketing and meetings.

Our organization in the Donetsk and Lugansk regions is very actively participating in the coal miners' movements. Our comrades are also struggling against the miners' leaders who forbid the miners to make any other economic demands, thus trying to hold back the revolutionary movement of the coal miners to struggle against the bourgeois laws and to minimize their demands. These leaders are working hand-in-glove with the policies of the present regime.

The same process of our members is being implemented in the Predniester region. The members of the Communist Party of Workers

those who defend the present regime, a totalitarian regime, while covering themselves by a "democratic cloak"? People are starving! Citizens of this "Independent Ukraine" are having only 17% of the necessary food as is the standard in Europe. Who should be considered as "Kolbasniks"?! We had kolbasa and filled refrigerators only during Soviet times. These "new Ukrainians" are the kolbasa eaters, these new presidents, mayors and other apologists of the present totalitarian regime!

Applause greeted the speech by the Afghanistan veteran M.L. Martinetz who said: "80 years ago, there took place a real people's revolution, which brought us peace and happiness. It is no fault of the people that demagogy of Gorbachev turned history upside down ... we know the lies of the present regime.

These foreign owners have robbed our country. We support mightily the politics of those who are trying to break down the walls between our Slavic people ... we are confident that the time is near when we shall give out the deserved sentences and these elements shall pay the supreme price for their deeds against our people."

Meetings, demonstrations and Anniversary celebrations also took place in Kovel, Novovolinsk, Vladimir-Volynsk, Horokhov, Manevich, Kiverts, Turiesk, Ratno and other cities and towns of the Volyn region. People believe that time is coming when, as our Moscow poet B. Hunko writes:

Again under the red flags our Motherland – the beautiful Will arise and become, as under Stalin, young and strong!

SECOND STORY – UNDER THE COVER OF RED-PINK SHROUD

Life, as the saying goes, is sometimes very complicated. To bring sense from this shroud is not so easy now, especially during times of revolutionary and social upheavals. Revolution scares many people. Of course, to improve your life and happiness during peace time is much easier and better than to struggle and fight on the barricades. But what can you do if the devil is ruling over humanity?! Especially if this devil is bent on ruling the whole planet?!

In this regard, Maxim Gorky wrote: Seagulls moan before a storm – groan, cry, fly over the stormy waves – and are ready to fly to the bottom of the sea in order to save themselves. Loons also cry, they are not able to fight: thunder strikes and they are in terror. Penguins, shy as they are, hide their bodies in the rocks ... Only the proud stormy petrel flies confidently over the foam and waves of the sea!"

Reading these lines of the classic Soviet literature, with trepidation, you think about the leader of Ukrainian socialist A. Moroz. It was he who supported the decision that instead of celebrating the 80th Anniversary of the Great October Revolution, he supported the renaming of this great historical holiday as "Day of Consent". He even went further than Kuchma by stating the opposing sides should ask forgiveness of each other on this day! From whom should I ask

forgiveness? You do not mean from the Banderite bands, who during the Great Patriotic War were shooting Soviet soldiers in the back? ... Yes, unfortunately, there are people now who are willing to co-operate and ask forgiveness from these fascists-nationalists — with any crook. Only that there should not be any storms ... Well, what must the people do? People are suffering more and more terrible conditions, robbery from the present Mafia!

The speech given by K. Tishenko was specific, but bungled and illogical even though he is the leader of Volyn Socialist Party. He did not even know or realize the significance of the October Revolution and he did not even say a word to this event, even though the audience was there to celebrate this great event in the history of mankind. He characterized this event as "road was unclear and it was an accident of history". What did he have in mind when he said this? Let us analyze these foggy ideas of K. Tishenko through the medium of a conceived dialogue:

Tishenko: After the 1905 revolution, there took place an active national independence movement in Ukraine.

Herasymchuk: Did not October lay the foundation for all of the nationalities to freely develop their culture, entity, to even the opportunity of separation? Did not the October Revolution give Ukraine opportunity to establish itself for the first time in its history to statehood and did not that statehood voluntarily join the Union of USSR? Or does Mr. Tishenko have in mind the establishment of the bourgeois state and its Central Rada, established together with German and Polish occupational troops in occupying their own people, drowning in blood the revolutionary outbursts of the Kiev enterprise "Arsenal"? But it was the Arsenal insurrection in Kiev that gave Ukraine its freedom and the victory of October in Ukraine! Did these patriots not deserve honour, that their name and their historical deed should be at least mentioned on this 80th Anniversary?

Or does Mr. Tishenko (that former "communist") think that he considers the leader of the national liberation movement the rabid enemy of his own people, organizer of Jewish pogroms and the person who tried to suffocate the movement, Semeon Petlura?

Tishenko: It is not correct to compare socialism and independence. Internationalism is just a mechanical unity into one central body or its attempt to get social justice.

Herasymchuk: Again, this is a foggy notion. Who is it that counter-poses the two? The basic tenets, the foundation of the freedom of people and their independence are in the science of Marxism-Leninism. Of course, such freedom does not mean to forcibly divide the people, as this was done at the Byelovezh Forest by Yeltsin, Krawchuk and Sushkewich. People have the right to voluntarily unite in order to discuss the political, economic, military and other questions! Does this socialist (Tishenko) understand the unity and friendship of Soviet people in their struggles to defend the socialist Motherland, formed in these struggles of workers and peasants as opposing socialism?

Tishenko: Today, we are going to build Ukraine, looking at all the mistakes of former period, on the road that is an alternative to dictatorship of the proletariat and former socialism, but aim towards the present market economy.

Herasymchuk: Why is it that you, Mr. Tishenko, always concentrate on the "negative moments" of Great October, or on the "mistakes and problems" of the former epoch? It

seems that to "socialists", it is something foreign to transform the society towards socialism. Your kind seems to suggest a third, unknown before road of developing a society. But where is this third road? In the program of the Socialist Party of Ukraine, there is no such third road. And, speaking forthrightly, there cannot be such a third road! Historical science shows us this clearly - to throw out capitalism, only socialism can replace it. A third road is nothing but opportunism which is geared directly to the establishment of capitalist mud, where the might is right and gold rules above all.

The means of production must belong to the people. There is no other road! Or is Tishenko of another frame of mind? If that is the case, he is masked under a red-pink fog while in actual fact, he is a classical opportunist.

THIRD STORY – WITCH'S SABBATH OF BROWN SHIRTS IN LVOV

After the November 7th celebrations in the Volyn region, Mrs. Clinton (wife of President Clinton of USA) came here. This visit is nothing new to the citizens of "Independent" Ukraine. They (the people) did not care much about Mrs. Clinton arriving - they were worried about not getting paid for months on end. Others in their thousands have no jobs even to worry about. It is strange that Mrs. Clinton, speaking about the role of women in building a democracy, forgot to mention the fact of starvation, no payment, no jobs. She somehow also forgot to mention the fact of Lvov workers, men and women and even children who were attacked and beaten up by the Lvov social-nationalists, who gathered on this November 7th to re-dedicate themselves to the ideals of the Great October Revolution. It looks that

in this "Independent" Ukraine (from their own people) which is now a colony bearing the name of "Ukraine" – the present regime still has to have some people to support them.

How did this vicious attack take place in this "Independent" Ukraine? In the centre of the city, near the monument to Ivan Franko, people gathered. At about the same time, over 300 young hooligans from the Social-nationalist Party (in columns of 8 abreast) came to where the left forces were gathering for their meeting. (It's good to remember that Hitler also had a National-Socialist Party.)

When the patriots gathered for November 7th event raised the red flags of revolution, giving honour to the fallen heroes who defended the Soviet Motherland, from among the columns of these social-nationalists, the command was given: "Attack them!"

"These trained young storm troopers attacked the peaceful citizens, veterans" as seen by a correspondent from newspaper "Village News". "They attacked and clubbed the people hard and without mercy. A former worker was knocked down to the ground -(a socialist) Melnik, he got such a blow between his eyes that blood gushed all over his face - making him blind. Such a 'gift' was also received by S. Radchenko, a member of the Socialist Party. The deputy to local Soviet V. Matrokhin had his teeth knocked out ..." ("Village News", November 13, 1997). It is interesting to note that on the scene were scores of militia who were there to keep order ... there were more militia present than all the other participants at this meeting. But they did not mix in or stop this vicious attack until it was over. Why? As the facts now prove, this was done on purpose so that the

attack could take place with the connivance of the authorities. The local city authorities were well informed as to what was being planned. Yes ...

Let us give here some eyewitness accounts as to was published by the newspaper "Tovarish": "... We were attacked by these well trained young brown shirts, ages from 17-22 with the insignia on their uniforms (SNPU - Social-nationalist party of Ukraine). In their hands, they had knuckle-dusters, hammers, rocks, flails, while in their pockets, they had salt and pepper. They started to hit us. They knocked me to the ground. By my side, these hoodlums knocked down my lady friend L. Mikhailov. I looked to the other side and saw how viciously animal-like they were pounding and kicking S. Radchenko ... I could not recognize him since he was covered in blood ... I saw with my own eyes how they punched and kicked my 16 year old son, and with a rock, they split his head open; they attacked my daughter, tore off an ear from my brother. (The militia was just looking on and contemplating with smiles on their faces.) These hooligans were trained professionally as to where to hit - on the most sensitive and dangerous parts: the head, face, neck, stomach ..." (O. Stabrovskaya)

"... We were attacked by these youngsters in black shirts with their nationalistic insignia on their sleeves. I was hit hard on my cheek by a tall man, and I saw that he had a steel object in his hand. After he hit me, my cheek immediately got swollen so big that my eye vision was shut completely. In front of my eyes, they attacked my youngster who is a public school student ... his chin was split open - his forehead. We had to go quickly to get help in a hospital since even the medical help on the scene was not too eager to help us. My son had to get

numerous stitches." (L. Mikhailova)

"... Attacking us, these hoodlums were allowed through barricades set up by the militia with their nationalist-fascist flags. In their hands, they were prepared with all sorts of objects to do us harm and even to maim us. With the command "Attack!", they went through the crowd beating up indiscriminately ... These bandits whom some of our comrades were able to hold on to quickly, we gave them to the militia to take them away, but to our surprise, the militia just let them go and again, these same hoodlums started their attacks again and again." (O. Haida)

Are you not afraid, my dear reader, to read such lines here? This is not a dream! This is what is happening in Lvov nowadays. While Mrs. Clinton, a few days after this bloodletting, greeted Lvov citizens and commended them for finally bringing democracy to Ukraine ...

Yes, in former years in Berlin, the national-socialists were also beating in the heads under democratic slogans. Today, these events are happening in Ukraine.

FOURTH STORY – ABOUT THE YELLOW-BLUE FLAG

Over the government building, there is flying this yellow-blue dirty cloth. Former party functionary, putting his hand on the bible, swore (but actually, he is an atheist) and also on the former Constitution of Ukraine, that he will make stronger the independent of Ukraine. If before we produced 50 million tons of grain per year, now it has fallen off by over 50%. Production of sugar has fallen off from 5 million tons to 2 million tons in 1997. Ukraine has one of the highest suicide rates in Europe – over 40 suicides everyday. In 1996, there were over 15,000 suicides in Ukraine ... they could not cope with the present conditions. Everyday, there are 20 murders. From a population of 50,000,000, there are 1,200,000 psychologically sick people. Before, we did not know what narcotics or speed were. Today in our country, there are officially registered (this does not include unofficial figures) over 45,000 narcotics plus 200,000 transmitted diseases. The country has become destitute. But the top mafiosi regime is living a life as they never did before. And on the residence of the president, there keeps flying the yellow-blue flag ...

A DYING GUERRILLA'S TESTAMENT by Luis Adamic, Submitted by Lydia Karhu

"Yugoslavia was overwhelmed by Hitler and the Nazis in the spring of 1941."

Marko was his name and he was a small town man, still a young man – only a little while before the Axis turned its fury on Yugoslavia, he had married a girl named Yelena who came from a village nearby.

So begins a story people in many parts of Yugoslavia started to whisper among themselves in 1942, after the countries far flung resistance to German, Italian, and Magyar occupation had taken a heavy toll of the guerrilla fighters who called themselves partisans of the Liberation Front.

Sometimes, as the tale was told, Marko was a Serbian, sometimes a Croatine – this was not important to those who whispered it about.

What seemed to matter was that Marko was an honest man, not with much school behind him, but intelligent and able to say what went on in his head so that one who was even less well educated could understand him. In his spare time when business was slow in his shop, Marko used to read newspapers and books, and tell others what he read about, and evening and Sundays he liked to talk politics and philosophy.

That is the sort of man he was, this Marko, of the people but a little above the average in that he knew the meaning of things and could express his mind and heart in simple, honest words.

Later when the enemy occupied his town and began to seize men for hostages and worse yet, for slave labor in Germany and Italy and behind the Russian front, Marko told his young wite Yelena, who was with child, to go back to her father's house in her native village and with God's help, take care of herself as best she knew how, and he left his home and business, his friends and town without saying a word to anyone else, and he headed for the mountains and there, he joined other men who felt as he did about the things that were going on under occupation.

Marko was a Partisan guerrilla and he fought in one battle after another, now against the Germans, now against the Italians, and sometimes against native dupes and scoundrels who served the Axis puppet governments, and he helped to inflict many casualties on the enemy. He was a great fighter.

But the Partisan's losses also were not small, and one day in a fierce battle with the Axis, Marko was mortally wounded.

And as he lay on the ground with enemy metal in his torn body, knowing he was bleeding to death and no one could help him, Marko managed to get a little stub of pencil and some paper out of his coat pocket, and he started a letter to his unborn child:

"My little one, curled up in the darkness, blind and unbreathing soft and shapeless, I salute you. Now you are unhurried in the wonderful warmth, but the day of your birth is not far off and you are storing strength. When your moment comes you will be ready. Your mother will have given you everything you need. You will twist and struggle, something within you will fight toward the light and for air, for life – no one knows why. How I wish I could hear your first gasp and see the first blink of your eyelids."

"Keep Burning, but always under control, the fire of your passion that tempers the steel of your young years and gives them the ring of human worth. Let the flame leap and let it be so clear that in the years of your age when your work is over, its light will continue to shine in your eyes like a lamp in a dark-framed window drawing and warming those who stumble in the night and are chill.

Keep your wonder and surprise your impulse to discover, your eyes on the horizon – they are your promise of immortality. Go through storms, but fix your heart on the sun and stars above them. There is a never-changing rule in the world, dawn follows darkness.

Work as you are able, whatever the task and keep high courage and firm faith. Do not be ashamed of fear. Do not hide it, conquer it. Do not be dismayed when you see others grow tired in this confused world. There is always light around the edges of gloom, strive toward it. Work as you are able. Ponder, decide, act. Never stop the flow of thought and feeling between your mind and your heart. Let your instinct tell you what is right.

As you go on, know what is behind you. I am ashamed to leave you a world of charred hopes, of error piled upon error, blood spilled upon blood, forgive me. Know the errors of the past, but look ahead – to the stepping stones to the future, to a clear dawn.

Keep your love of life, but overcome your fear of death. Life is lost if it is not loved, only never love it so much. Sometimes the best thing a man can do is die. Keep your joy in friendship and your anger at what your instinct tells you is wrong.

Keep your pleasure in little things – a snowflake, a blade of grass, a cobweb stretched between two branches of a bush, the sheen of a bird's wing, the moisture in a linden leaf, a girl's smile. They are as big as sunlight and thunder, wind

and wave on the ocean, and the greatness of heroes. There is magic in the stillness of a seed."

Vision was going from Marko's eyes. His fingers were numb and he could barely hold the little pencil. He did not finish the letter to his unborn son. In irregular lines at the bottom of the paper, he scrawled: "Please deliver this to my wife Yelena" and he placed the letter under his cheek so that his face served as a weight to keep the wind from blowing it away.

When his fellow Partisans found Marko, they read what he had written and they all said, "this is just as I feel". And they all copied it, making it their own letter to their unborn children. ending it themselves with: "In thought, as a last benediction, I kiss your forehead, or Goodnight to you my little one, and a bright morning." Then each carried it on his person till he was killed too, and when his fellow Partisans found it on his body, they copied it – till now every Partisan guerrilla who has a wife with child copies the letter.

It was impossible to deliver Marko's original letter to his wife Yelena, for the village where she lived was in territory which the enemy held with specially strong forces. By and by however, the Partisans penetrated to that region and liberated it. But when they reached Yelena's village, they found it destroyed. Most of the villagers had been massacred, and Yelena was among the dead. Marko's child was never born.

But Marko's letter will be read by many a Partisan's child born under Axis occupation. It will be read the world over and someday, "a clear dawn" will break over the lands of the south Slavs, over the Balkans, over Europe, over all the earth.

CZECH GOVERNMENT RESIGNS

Postmark Praha, in its January issue, reports that the government of Vaclav Klaus which resigned on November 9th has not been replaced and that the country is drifting aimlessly into anarchy. The ruling three-party coalition lead by Klaus' O.D.S. had been floundering for some time, mired in charges of corruption and mismanagement prompting the Communist Party of the Czech and Moravian Republics (KSCM) through its leader Miroslav Grebenicek to repeatedly call for their resignation.

The O.D.S. has been found to have a secret Swiss bank account in which it had deposited millions of dollars resulting from bribes it received from the benefactors of its privatization programme in which state property was sold at less than market prices, resulting in the impoverishment of the state and exorbitant profits for the capitalists to whom the property was sold.

The Czech Currency has fallen to a record low. Economic growth is down to its lowest level in the history of the Czech Republic. Domestic demand is down while prices have gone up by 9.4% and investment is down by 8.3%. The deficit is between 6 and 7 billion crowns (\$180 million) and the inflation rate is sitting at 12.5%. All this will result in further belt tightening by the already impoverished Czech workers. This has resulted in calls for industrial action by all segments of the trade union movement including even the most docile of these, such as the 32,000 member glassworkers union. Strike action in January is being prepared if employers proceed with planned pay-cuts.

The Communists and the Social Democrats have indicated that they would support president Havel's decision to ask Tosovsky, the president of the Czech Central Bank, to form a government only as a temporary measure, combined with a promise of early elections. Havel who is standing for re-election in January and is being opposed by the distinguished scientist and Communist, Stanislav Fisher, was forced to admit that the post-1989 government had betrayed the principals of the Velvet Revolution

- to which, the Communists reply that he [Havel] had done nothing to stop the corruption, and in some measure, had acquiesced in it. He spent his time restoring capitalism and offering Czech soil to NATO for its nuclear basis; prompting *Postmark Praha* to remark that Rome burned while the emperor fiddled.

TWO CONGRESSES

The 11th Congress of the New Communist Party of Britain (NCP) met in London during the weekend of last December 5th and 6th. It met at a time when capitalism in crisis worldwide was seeking salvation through a series of aggressive imperialist blockades and threats of war. In his presidential address to the Congress, Eric Trevett said: "This crisis is proving to be a cauldron of capitalist instability. The objective factors necessitating revolution are maturing. The subjective factors – a working class equipped with

revolutionary leadership – has yet to be established."

Moving the main Political Resolution, Andy Brooks, the NCP's General Secretary, said: "Only the working class, winning state power by overthrowing the capitalist class, can achieve its emancipation." Later in his speech, he said: "It is working people and mass action that bring change."

One of the prerequisites for a successful outcome to the struggle for working class power is a united working class, not just in Britain but throughout the world. That, some headway in this respect, has been made in Britain, was evidenced by the presence, at the NCP Congress, of fraternal delegates from three other British Communist Parties. As the New Worker duly reported on December 12th: "The new formulation of progressive co-operation between the New Communist Party of Britain, the Communist Party of Britain, the Revolutionary Communist Party of

The time for a return to the principles of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin has come. In Britain, the New Labour Government has already revealed itself as a pillar of the establishment, threatening even the child-allowances of single parents and the allowances of the disabled as an alternative to taxing the rich. The Parliamentary Labour Party, with a few notable exceptions (these can be counted on the fingers of one hand) divide basically into three categories: the Old Labour Right, the New Labour Right, and the anti-Communist Left. THE IMPLICATIONS OF M.A.I.

The Multilateral Agreement on Investment (M.A.I.) is a treaty that is being negotiated amongst the member states of the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (O.E.C.D.). These negotiations have been ongoing since 1995 with virtually no publicity, no public input and no justification as to the need for same. In fact, as recently as last spring, members of the Canadian Government denied that such

deliberations were taking place. This leads one to ask – why the secrecy?

The truth is that what millions fought and died for in the last war and what Hitler failed to realize in World War II, world domination, is being accomplished not through the force of arms but by financial blackmail and coercion. What this treaty will accomplish is a world government, consisting multinational corporations most of which will be American, that will have the power to dominate and dictate to freely elected governments what they can and cannot do. Nation states as we now know them will no longer exist nor will their borders. Governments will no longer have the right to regulate the extraction of their natural resources nor the protection of their ecology. For the first time in history, foreign corporations will have the right to sue and otherwise deal with foreign governments without going through their own national While foreign governments. corporations will have the right to prosecute governments, foreign governments will be denied this right.

Tony Clarke, president of the Polaris Institute and author of The Silent Coup: Confronting the Big Business Take-over of Canada, is quoted in the daily Hamilton Spectator as saying, that "few people are aware that transnational corporations are emerging as corporate states and working to promote advantageous trade agreements and legislation". He goes on to say that "they have become political machines in order to shape public policy" (in their favour). He is also quoted as predicting that hospitals that are

now being closed in Canada will re-open in a few years run for profit by large transnational health-care businesses.

David Orchard, president of *Citizens Concerned About Free Trade*, in his remarks to the St. Lawrence Forum on November 18, 1997 in Toronto, traced the origins of free trade as follows:

"The Americans – i.e., American Capital – found in the late 1970's and early 1980's that they were unable to realize their aspirations through the existing General Agreement on Trade and Tarriff (G.A.T.T.) treaty. They, therefore, entered into a free trade agreement with first of all, Israel, then Canada, and later, with Mexico. hey are now extending this agreement to include all the member states of the O.E.C.D. In this fashion, they are attempting to dominate and subjugate the world one country at a time. National governments will be unable to regulate the extraction of their natural resources such as was the case with the national energy policy instituted by Canada to regulate the petroleum extraction industry. Central banks, through which governments regulate finances in their individual countries will be eliminated. Governments will no longer be able to accord preferential treatment to their national businesses nor will they be able to insist that local people be hired by a foreign company."

Orchard cited one example in which the government of Ontario, under the past premier Bob Rae, wanted to institute a government-run auto insurance policy, and was threatened by an American insurance company, State Farm, with a \$1.3 billion suit for damages under the free trade agreement, should it institute this insurance. The Ontario Government was therefore forced to abandon this project. While not all

aspects of this complex document have been finalized, consensus has solidified on the inclusion of the so-called investor-to-state dispute resolution process which will be used in the implementation of the foregoing examples. Not only will corporations be able to sue when their interests are threatened as described above, but if a government was, for example, to create a crown corporation which would result in the loss of profits by a corporation in another country, that corporation will then have the right to sue and collect damages from the government in question. In short, elected governments will be regulated by transnational corporations who are elected by no one and responsible only to their shareholders, many of whom may not even live in the country that is being regulated. One might ask - is this the democracy for which we all aspire?

WHO WAS CHE?

WHO WERE HIS FRIENDS? WHAT DID HE DO? WHAT DID HE FIGHT FOR? HOW DID HE BECOME CHE?

Che was born in Rosario, Argentina on June 14, 1928, a month premature. Later, the family moved to Aha Gracia, Cordoba, Argentina. The cleaner air and fragrance of coniferous trees better suited their lovely child, Che. His father is Ernesto Guevara Lynch, and his mother i Celia de la Serna. Che was the oldest of five siblings.

Che's name as a young boy was Tête. On May 2, 1930, his parents took him for a dip in a pool. Tête started to cough and wheeze. His parents rushed him to a hospital. They found Tête had asthma.



His parents had thousands of books at home. His fellow students would come to read books that even their school did not have. Che read Marx, Engels, Lenin, Kropotkin, Bakunin. He also read Tolstoy, Dostoyevsky, Victor Hugo and Jules Vernes. Che loved poetry very much. He wrote some as well.

From 1945-51, Che studied at Medical School in Buenos Aires. In 1951-52, Che travelled with his older friend Alberto Granado all through South America, treating people with leprosy. Che completed a 6 year course in 3 years, and became a doctor. On December 24, 1953, Che arrived in Guatemala and met Antonio Nico Lopez, who told Che about Fidel's vision.

In Guatemala, Che got to see the aggressive American intervention in a foreign country – American Imperialism right in front of his eyes. The best president ever elected in Guatemala was Jacobo Arberz Guzman.

Sam Zemurray, the man who ran the United Fruit Co., owned all the Telephone and Telegraph Facilities, controlled the only port, had a fleet of 50 white freighters to ship his goods, owned almost all the railroads, and 50% of the best farmland in Guatemala. So Arbenz, buying some cropless land back from Sam, made him feel bad. So Sam called a few friends of his in the U.S.A. Almost all of them had shares in United Fruit. His friends were

John Foster Dulles – Secretary of State, Allen Dulles – Head of the CIA, Walter Bedell Smith – Under-Secretary of State, General Robert Cutler – Head of the National Security Council, Thomas G. Corocan – CIA Operative, even the American UN Ambassador had shares in United Fruit. Talk about a conspiracy, here it is! Talk about conflict of interest! What do the best and brightest of Princeton and Harvard care when dollars are all that are worshipped?

In March 1953, the CIA and United Fruit offered bribe money to high ranking officers in Guatemala. The CIA also offered bribe money in a Swiss Bank to Arbenz. He rejected it. The CIA cut credit, oil and goods to Guatemala and paid for over 200 articles of lie in newspapers. CIA/USA distributed over 100,000 copies of anti-Communist leaflets, 27,000 anti-Communist cartoons and posters. Played pro-American films for free at the cinemas. The CIA used Frances Cardinal Spellman to tell Archbishop Mariano Rossell Arellano of Guatemala to preach to the very religious Guatemalans that there is a devil called "Communism" and to fight it. The CIA planted weapons that they claimed came from outside Communist countries. The CIA also had a propaganda radio station called "Voice of Liberation".

On June 15, 1954, Dwight D. Eisenhower ordered the Coup de grâce. On June 26, the CIA supplied their bought troops with US airplanes and pilots. One US pilot dropped some bombs on Honduras. The CIA blamed it on Arbenz, while the National Palace was attacked from US airplanes. The CIA had speakers on the roof of the US Embassy in Guatemala. broadcasted sounds of a great war to scare the people. On June 27, Jacobo Arbenz, fearing the wrath of the CIA on his people, stood down as president.

Castillo Armas, the new puppet president, care of the CIA, now started torturing and killing thousands of people. There was a hit list for 72,000-100,000 people. All 7 top union leaders were murdered. 75% of the population was banned from voting. opposition newspapers were closed. All subversive books were burnt even Victor Hugo's "Les Miserables". Allen Dulles wanted people hiding in foreign embassies tortured and killed. Armas did not get to it. In an Argentine Embassy was a young 25 year old Argentine doctor named Ernesto "Che" Guevara. His first wife, Hilda Gade, whom he met in Guatemala, said, "up to that point, he was merely a sniper. From here on, he was convinced that the struggle

with an end to racism. In 1895, Marti and 6,000 rebels landed in several places in eastern Cuba. Sadly, he was killed in the battle of Dos Rios in May 19, 1895. The American ship SS – Main sat in Havana Harbour while they claimed it was blown up by a Spanish Mine. We all know today that the explosion came from within the ship.

On April 25, 1898, the Spanish-American War began. The war included the Philippines, Guam, Puerto Rico and Cuba. In 1899, the Americans had a new flag flying in Cuba, with the Red, White, and Blue plus one star of the Untied States. The new colonial power detested the Cubans. In 1901, the Platt Amendment gave the United States the right to intervene in Cuba's

foreign and local corporations, even from the American Mafia kingpin, named Meyers Lansky.

On September 21, 1954, Che fled for his life from Guatemala to Mexico City. In June 1955, Nico Lopez set a meeting between Che and Fidel's brother, Raul Castro. In July 1955, Che talked with Fidel all day long. He made such a great impression on Che that he joined as the third member of the July 26 Movement. Now, Che was with Fidel who knew that if Americans with all their churches took Cuba by the gun and not prayer, then Fidel must take Cuba back by the gun and not prayer.

On November 25, 1956, 82 guerillas, including Che, left Mexico on the Granma. They set soil for



against Yankee Imperialism must be an armed one, supported by the people".

José Marti was burning with hate of colonialism in Cuba. He wanted his country to be 100% independent. He was exiled and went to New York and Florida. Marti organized Cubans in America under C.R.P. – the Cuban Revolutionary Party. As much as he wanted independence, he also equally wanted social and economic justice

affairs. Before the war, US interests controlled 15% of Cuba's sugar cane industry. After the war, it leaped to 75%. From the 1902 election of Tomás Estrada Palma to Bastias flight of January 1, 1959, all presidents kowtowed to the interests of the United States. Batista was close to John Foster Dulles. Nobody spoke against Batista. If you did, you would be hanging from a tree in Havana. Eulgencio Batista was ruthless. He took bribe money from

Cuba. Che copied a poem by Pablo Neruda and took it with him, named "Farewell". On December 2, 1956, the Granma reached Los Colorades Beach in Oriente Province, Cuba. Most of the guerillas were killed or captured by a surprise attack by Batista's troops. Che was wounded. On December 21, 1956, only 15 of 82 guerillas united after hiding from Batista's troops. They now went to the Sierra Maestra Mountains where they started

building their Guerilla Movement.

On May 27-28, 1957, guerillas captured Batista's army garrison in the Battle of El Uvero. In July 1957, Che became a Commander of a Second Column. On August 31, 1958, Che led an invasion in Los Villas Province. On December 28, 1958, Che began the battle of Santa Clara, the capital of Los Villas. On January 1, 1959, Batista fled Cuba. On January 8, 1959, Fidel Castro entered Havana to a huge crowd of cheers. On February 9, 1959, Che is declared a Cuban citizen. On October 7, 1959, Che was head of the Department of Industry of the National Institute of Agrarian Reform. On November 26, 1959, Che is appointed president of the National Bank of Cuba. In July -October, Cuba nationalized all major foreign and domestic banks and corporations. On April 17-19, 1961, United States invaded Cuba, using Cuban born troops trained in America and US client countries. They were defeated in 72 hours. By Castro wanting missiles after being attacked made America think this man is not to be bought or intimidated. This man was a Hero, Fidel Castro.

On October 28, 1962, Soviet Premier Khrushchev agreed to remove Soviet missiles if USA pledged not to invade Cuba again. On December 9, 1964, Che left to speak at the United Nations and visited some African countries. On March 14, 1964, Che came back to Cuba. On April 1, 1965, Che delivered a farewell letter to Fidel Castro. He left Cuba to help Belgian Congo (now Zaire). He entered through Tanzania using a cover name Tatú, Swahili for #2. On October 3, 1965, Castro publicly read Che's letter of farewell.

On November 4, 1966, Che arrived in Bolivia in disguise, with a cover name. From March 23 to October 8, 1967, Che's guerillas

battled with Bolivian troops. They tried at the same time to educate the Bolivians about justice and equality they deserve as human beings. On October 4, 1967, a deserter led the Bolivian army to Che's stash of weapons, ammunition, secret documents and the medicine for his asthma. On October 8, 1967, 17 guerillas and Che were trapped by Bolivian troops. They captured Che. On October 9, 1967, Che and two of his men were murdered.

Richard Bissell, head of the CIA 1958–62, said "From time to time, individuals would appear on the scene, and it would be very important to have them disappear from the scene".

John Tilton, CIA Chief of Station in Bolivia 1966–68, said "The operation to locate and capture if possible Che Guevara was a CIA Operation, run by the station (CIA) with the co-operation in the field of Bolivians".

Felix Rodriguez worked for the CIA. He had fought at the "Bay of Pigs". Rodriguez was the man who caught and murdered Che with Bolivian soldiers. Che was wounded and tied in a Bolivian school with two of his guerillas. Felix Rodriguez said "He was laying down on the floor, in a dirty floor. His hands were tied to his back, and his clothes were torn". Rodriguez waited for orders while photographing captured documents, like Che's diary. Felix Rodriguez said "while photographing the diary, a telephone call came from the room behind me. It was the call that gave the order 500, 600. 500 was Che. 600 was to execute him. I took the call." He continued: "So I came over into the room where he [Che] was. And he was sitting on the bench ... He [Che]

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looked at me [Rodriguez] and said ... 'I should have never been captured alive!' And I [Rodriguez] went to where Tehran was and said Saliento shoot him from here down, don't shoot from here up (the neck), because this man is supposed to die from combat wounds. And he said [Saliento the soldier] Si mi Capitan, Si Mi Capitan. I understand that he borrowed an M2 Carbine from a Lieutenant Paris who was in the area. And I left. It was one o'clock in the afternoon when I left there. At 1:10 p.m. Bolivian time, I heard the shots. I looked at my watch and took note that that was the time when Che was killed."

John Tilton, CIA Chief of Station in Bolivia 1966–68, said "It made him look like a martyr, because laid out on a stone slab, pale, and long dirty hair. He bore an eerie, ghostly resemblance to Jesus Christ. Which was picked up by some people. And it was not good publicity, it was not good propaganda, for the operation of his demise."

When I was in Cuba, I met a man that worked with Proctor & Gamble before the revolution, and after, was "Director of Exports". He knew Che. My friend's name is Miguel A. Pria Groso. He told me Che did much hard work. He always ate with the workers in factories. He always did what was on his mind. A man of action. He had no thoughts of why should I risk my life for others. He was always the first to volunteer. Before Che went to Bolivia, he was in disguise at table near his wife to see if she would recognize him. Che's wife was with their baby daughter. The little girl fell and Che rushed and picked her up to see if she was all right and kissed her. Then the little girl turned to her mom and said Mom, mom see that man (she pointed to Che but the mother did not recognize him) that man loved me, mama!


LETTERS FROM ABROAD

Again, I would like to say that I was very happy to get your letter from Canada! This matter is even more wonderful, because here, in Ukraine, Canada was and is well described as the country of huge Ukrainian diaspora, but this diaspora is described as a great number of

Ukrainian nationalists, but as far as I know, previously, during many years, the Ukrainian diaspora in Canada was divided in 2 parts. One of them was anti-Soviet, nationalistic one, and the other was pro-Soviet, the communist one. Is that true?

In this letter, I'm sending you 2 sets of snapshots. The first one, I made this summer during my participating in the "Rally To Moscow"; and the second one, I photographed on November 7, 1997 when I was in Moscow. I think these snaps will be of some interest to you. The backside of these pictures, I have written various explanations and comments.

As for the situation with present Ukrainian (as well as Russian) youth, I must say that most of young people in the former USSR lost any ideals - they don't believe anybody, and mostly they think of socialism as of something which was in the past. They don't take seriously any words concerning socialism, communist and labour movement and so on. There are certainly radical political groups of youth and youth sections in different left-wing parties, they are not so numerous. Nevertheless, the situation is not so critical - in the big cities, there appear radical Marxist young groups. For example, in Moscow, the great number of punks were involved in anarchist movement and some of them later on joined the new Revolutionary Communist Union of Youth (Bolshevik), which is, in general, the youth organization of RCWP. By the way, I may say that radical political punk-rock is very popular among ex-Soviet young communists and other radical leftists. Such acts like "The Sex Pistols", "The Clash", "Dead Kennedys" and Russian punk-group Grazdanskaya Oborona are very popular among the new Soviet counter-culture.

As for my other hobby, I can name sports. I'm fond of wrestling, and for 3 times a week, I take the sambo wrestling classes (This kind of wrestling was invented by Russian revolutioner-Bolshevik Spiridonov in 1920's and is a mixture of national types of wrestling of various nations of the USSR). But unfortunately, sports is now very poorly financed compared to the Soviet times.

Dear Friends:

Recently, I had a long open letter addressed to you and Northstar Compass by the MLKP of Turkey. As a relatively new and enthusiastic member of the Northstar Compass Editorial Board, I am concerned that we take to heart the fraternal criticism raised in the letter by serious and sincere anti-imperialist and revolutionary fighters – that we embrace the valid points and reject or correct that which is not valid.

First of all, I believe MLKP is mistaken in describing Northstar Compass as a "revolutionary journal". Rather, Northstar Compass is a pro-revolutionary, pro-Soviet journal; that is, it is a supporter of the Russian Revolution and its legacy and of Soviet restoration. This is a continuation of the traditional mission of the Canadian "Hands Off Russia" committee beginning in 1918 in the context of today's conditions in the former USSR, in Canada and the world.

However, even given this correction, I believe the core of the criticism offered by MLKP is correct. Namely, much more space in the pages of Northstar Compass could have, and should have, been devoted to the May-July '96 death fast and hunger strike in Turkish dungeons. As a letter correctly points out, "... much less important events ... even letters take ... much more space ..."

MLKP movingly cites the great Dimitrov, Bulgarian communist leader of the world anti-fascist struggle in World War II, as follows: "Such worthy examples of proletarian heroism must be popularized, must be contrasted

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with the manifestations of faint-heartedness, Philistinism, and every kind of rottenness and frailty in our ranks and the ranks of the working class. These examples must be used most extensively in educating the cadres of the workers' movement." (Georgi Dimitrov, Selected Works, Volume 2, p. 117)

MLKP points out: "Here, you have a fresh example and an irrefutable proof of the vitality of the cause of revolution from a country, where communists, national liberation fighters and anti-fascists are defying militantly a blood-thirsty and militaristic state in all fields of life; in the streets, at the factories, at the barricades and under torture, in dungeons and at court."


