

LENIN WILL LIVE!

The hatred and insolence of the neo-fascist generals and the hierarchy maintained in power by the guns in Russia today has bared its slavering yellow fangs by their announcement of the closure of the world treasure of history, the Lenin Museum, and the removal of his body from the Mausoleum on Moscow's Red Square. The world's working people have more than a little bitter experience with class hatred. Inbred in their bones is the knowledge of what happens when their class enemy, monopoly corporate capitalism, seizes power by whatever means, gains the upper hand and proceeds with the exploitation, oppression and terror that is its rotten soul and heart.

Will Lenin, his works, his world building accomplishments, be erased from history as the current gang of anti-Communist, anti-Socialist and anti-working class neo-fascists hope and expect? To provide answers, we re-produce the following: (They are the words of a Communist)

"Scores and indeed, hundreds of times in the course of the centuries, the labouring people have striven to throw off the oppressors from their backs, and to become the masters of their own destiny. But each time, defeated and disgraced, they have



been forced to retreat, harbouring in their breasts resentment and humiliation, anger and despair, and lifting up their eyes to an inscrutable heaven where they hope to find deliverance. The chains of slavery remained intact, or the old chains were replaced by new ones, equally burdensome and degrading. Ours is the only country where the oppressed and downtrodden labouring masses have succeeded in throwing off the rule of the landlords and capitalists, and replacing it by the rule of the workers and peasants. You know Comrades, and the whole world now admits it, that this gigantic struggle was led by Comrade Lenin and his Party. The greatness of Lenin lies above all in this; that by creating the Republic of Soviets, he gave a practical demonstration to the oppressed masses of the whole world that hope of deliverance is not lost, that the rule of the capitalists and landlords is short-lived, that the kingdom of labour can be created by the efforts of the labouring people themselves, and that the kingdom of labour must be created not in heaven, but on earth. "Eulogy - 'On the Death Of Lenin'," 1924, by J. V. Stalin.

While a question may be properly raised as to what "short-lived" now means almost seventy years later, there can be no doubt that a corrupted, fawning group of neofascists, lickspittling before the almighty financial institutions of the West, cannot and will not destroy

Lenin. His gigantic legacy as one of the "men of history" that led the way to a new, higher level of demanded change, and who genuinely foresaw "A New World Order" of international friendship, and solidarity in societies in which the individual would be encouraged to develop to the maximum of their potential, is indestructible. WHO DARES TO RAISE THEIR HAND FOR CHANGE ...?

Via the brain-numbing television screen, and the print media, people have been subjected in recent days to a grisly, dreadful, blow-by-blow account of the murder of a two-year old child in Liverpool and a subsequent "homicide" trial of Boys 'A' and 'B', aged ten at the time of the crime. By the time they were eleven, they had officially become convicted murderers and sentenced to imprisonment, apparently for the rest of their lives.

"Idle Freaks of Nature", shrieks the headlines. If that is so, what does that make the crews of B-52 bombers, helicopter gunmen in Vietnam, over Panama, Somali, to say nothing of Lt. Calley of the U.S., invaders of Vietnam at Mai Lay?; The household pets of Imperialism?

So, a morally bankrupt society says "justice has been served" and turns away to proceed with the varying pleasures or annoyances of living. Perhaps here or there, a state of numbness or sheer unawareness prevents a rational examination of where really lies the responsibility for the unspeakable events of the death of a baby and the life incarceration of two boys, not yet

in their teens. No doubt moralizers, intellectual and "scientific" dogooders will now settle down to a prolonged, hair-by-hair examination to find out how the next sermon of platitudes should or should not be delivered. The media of course will go silent as quickly as it is apparent that "viewing time" or "news circulation" is no longer positively or profitability served by the gruesome "story".

But are not these children all of a particular society, just as were the dead children of the war-torn world?; just as were (and are) the starving children, the hopelessly condemned children who practise prostitution to feed a drug habit and craving in the "great" cities of the world, whether Toronto, New York, Moscow, Manila or elsewhere? Is it not true that everywhere, rampaging corporate power has mustered sufficient corruption or to rule by firepower, that this society (which is first and foremost, their creation) condemns children to horrors and death beyond imagination of a sane person? Is not this the central driving force of the societal insensitivity, carelessness, and unbelievable hypocrisy that creates not only the Liverpool debacle, but the rampant growth of AIDS, social and venereal disease, blind illiteracy and a future of zero expectations above the level of badly kept animals for uncounted child victims? What is the root of this human tragedy that boggles the mind, how are these unfathomable mind sets (for those who remain rational) learned, as learned they surely were.

But now, we have the knee-jerk reaction to the monstrosity of children entrapped by a society engorged and blind on the bauble glittering "consumerism" that has been the empty substitution for human values and human care. We can now see the victims in their awful


degraded innocence, portrayed as the perpetrators of the crimes. Have we really reached the point of human conduct and understanding where we breed and birth "throw away" people? Tragically, we have reached that point.

Responsibility must be fixed before justice can emerge. The greed crazed, exploitation that serves as the basis of the ethos and morality of society now devours the life of its young. That can only be a precursor of mass suicide by the human species, a death warrant for us all!

Will the responsibility be assumed by the great financiers, the great weapons makers, the aristocracy of "the Royals" et al.? Not very damned likely, given their histories in one or another way of class murder and extermination of humankind in the name of profit and power. Oh yes, perhaps they even hold their "delicate" noses as they have since the inception of child labour in the textile mills and coal mines and the massacres of Cawnpor, Mogadishu, Lidice or ten thousand other places and times where profit and power were to be "won" or "defended". Never in the oak panelled suites of the mighty has disease, illiteracy, coupled with brutalization been other than an idea that said "these were certainly and forever the 'lot of the poor' ... working or not". Firmly grasped by these human ghouls is the truth that war, pestilence, crime, disease, ignorance, exploitation, drugs, all in one or another way, create the "top dollar" profit sheet. The death of a child or a million children, as we have seen, is something to "cry out the crocodile tears of feigned remorse", but in the end, to be exploited. So the two deprived children of Liverpool will rot, mentally, physically and in spirit to become the monsters the media, the courts, the society now assures us they are. What of other children?

In different ways for millions, the same thing.

But surely, because we are not beasts, we are not depraved, somewhere a spark of resistance to all of this will grow. Perhaps even a raging conflagration for change, for an end to it, as it now is, will consume us all in the demand for cleansing, a new day of friendship, solidarity, concern and cooperation, for social, political economic justice so the children may not be consumed and degraded. Our time, the time of corporate inspired unlimited and unbridled individualism, profit, power and competition, demands there be nothing less. "Let the very stones cry out" for humanity, for justice, for peace and the preservation of our planet, for the nurturing and safekeeping of our species. Let humankind now rise up to bring such a new day. Otherwise, there will not be grand children to either curse us or to love us. Now is the time to demand change.


ON THE 76TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE GREAT OCTOBER SOCIALIST REVOLUTION

The autumn of 1942 found the Soviet Union in a particularly dangerous situation: the Nazis were at the gates of Leningrad and only 120 kilometres from Moscow. In the south, the Germans were at the Volga in the vicinity of Stalingrad and had reached the foothills of the Caucasus. They had seized a vast territory, including such economically important districts as Krivoy Rog, the Donetz Basin and the Maikop oil fields.

In the year 1942, the Soviet people suffered greater adversity and hardship than in any year during the entire war. However, a powerful war industry had been established and with superhuman effort the Soviet workers were producing military equipment in sufficient quantities for the front. The collective and state farms maintained a continuous supply of food to the fronts as well as raw materials for industry, while the transport workers ensured delivery of essential supplies.

At the centre of all this activity was the Communist Party, urging the



workers on to greater efforts, and leading them in the struggle to destroy the fascist enemy. And destroy him, they did. In a brilliant strategy, after a battle which lasted for six months, the Soviet Army, in January 1943, inflicted a final defeat on the German army at Stalingrad, from which the Nazis never recovered.

The strategic initiative passed from the Nazis into the hands of the Soviet army, and so remained until the last remnants of the Nazis and their allies had been driven from the soil of the U.S.S.R.

In the words of the Supreme Commander, Joseph Stalin, "The Battle of Stalingrad ended in the encirclement and rout of the German Army, 300,000 strong and the capture of the bulk of the surrounded troops. To visualize the extent of the slaughter on the battlefield of Stalingrad, which was on a scale unprecedented in history, one should know that after the battle, 147,000 dead German men and officers and 46,700 Soviet men and officers were picked up and buried. Stalingrad marked the beginning of the decline of the German fascist army. Germany never recovered from the Stalingrad slaughter."

At Stalingrad, the people of the Soviet Union passed a great historical test. From this victory over the forces of fascist reaction, the working class, at the head of the entire people, led by its Communist Party, continued with the destruction of the Nazi hordes in the Soviet country and the liberation of Europe from the yoke of the Nazi fascist barbarians.

The Soviet victory at Stalingrad was one of the great turning points of history. The Nazi advance had been halted: it had become a defeat, and then a rout. In the Soviet advance to Berlin, the Soviet Army piled up victory after victory, until at long last, after 1,409 days, on the night of

April 30, 1945 the red banner of victory was hoisted over the Reichstag. Eight days later on May 8, 1945, at the Berlin suburb of Karlshorst, the Act of Unconditional Surrender was signed. The Soviet Supreme Command was represented by Marshal Zhukov, the Allied armed forces by Air Chief-Marshal Tedder of Britain, Commander of the U.S. Strategic Air Force, General Spaatz, and General De Lattre de Gassigny, Commander-in-Chief of the French Army.

The commanders of Germany's armed forces Field-Marshal Keitel, Admiral Friedeburg, and Colonel-General Stumpff, signed the Act of Immediate and Unconditional Surrender of all German Forces on Land, Sea and in the Air.

UNBELIEVABLE DESTRUCTION

Twenty-seven million Soviet people had died in the struggle. There was hardly a family that had not lost a member in the war. Everyone rejoiced to realize that these sacrifices had not been in vain, now that the war had ended in total victory.

In a Globe and Mail article dated July 18, 1990, under the byline of David Morgan, it is stated that "Deaths in Leningrad alone exceeded the war losses of the United States during its entire history - almost one-and-one-half million killed." "Of the 5.5 million officers and men captured by the Germans, four million were dead before the war ended. Captured Soviet Troops were often surrounded and left to starve in their thousands by German Guards." Morgan continues: "We forget the scale of destruction because we have never experienced anything like it: no country has. Seventeen thousand towns, 70 thousand villages, 31 thousand factories, 84 thousand schools, 40 thousand miles of railway

tracks were destroyed and 25 million persons were left homeless.

On September 13, 1945, Pravda published a report by the Extraordinary State Commission for the Investigation of the Nazi Invaders' Atrocities. Included in the destruction listed, were: "31,850 industrial enterprises, 98,000 collective farms, 18,076 state farms, and 2,890 machine and tractor stations. The list of Nazi atrocities covered several pages of newsprint. The U.S.S.R.'s total losses in the war were estimated at some 2,600 thousand million roubles (at pre-war prices). To bring this figure home more vividly, we mention by way of comparison, that in 1940, the total state revenue of the U.S.S.R. was 180 thousand million roubles. In other words, the Soviet Union's losses amounted to almost 15 times the annual state income as shown in the last pre-war budget, that of 1940. These losses, as shown above, represented one third of the total wealth of the U.S.S.R. at the time of the Nazi attack on June 22, 1941.

In the face of the unbelievable destruction suffered by the Soviet Union at the hands of the invader, it is not difficult to understand the attitude of the many who questioned the ability of the Soviet people to achieve parity with the world's industrialized nations. It was usual for those who did not understand the Soviet people, to estimate that 25

to 100 years would be required to rebuild the Soviet Union. But these were the same people who had come back from defeat, to drive the Nazi beast from the Soviet country, liberate Europe and achieve the unconditional surrender of the "invincible" Nazi war machine. By applying the same courage, fortitude and organization, the Soviets, by the beginning of the fifties, had achieved the main indices of pre-war economic development. In this brief period, they had not only re-built the damage inflicted by the war, but had planned, put into operation and completed the fourth five-year plan.

By 1953, the Soviet Union had not only repaired the damage, but had already created the economic basis of Socialism and were entering the lower stages of a classless, communist society.

Since the beginning of the democratic revolution in February, 1917, which grew into the Workers' and poor peasants' revolution of November 7, 1917, The Russian Socialist Federated Soviet Republic, and later, the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics, have achieved heights which at every stage have been decried as impossible.

Since becoming the ruling class through the Soviet Power, they have successively crushed the counterrevolution of the Czarist Generals. They defeated the intervention of the early 20's and drove the thirteen counter-revolutionary imperialist armies from Soviet soil. They withstood the hardships of the period of War Communism and the period of the NEP. When the counterrevolution resorted to sabotage and terror, they used the power of the Soviet State to destroy the terrorists and saboteurs. They achieved previously unheard of economic construction, thereby winning the admiration of the world. They tried

throughout the 1930's to prevent war through diplomacy and unity and when this failed, they annihilated the aggressor in the Great Patriotic War. And they prevented the outbreak of nuclear war for forty years following World War II.

Is it not possible that such a working class and the republics will find their way back to Marx and Lenin and return to the Socialist path which they have so brilliantly blazed in the past?

THE PHONY YELTSIN & G-7 ELECTION ...

FOR A "PIG-IN-A-POKE" DUMA, AND A RUSSIAN "CAT-IN-A-SACK" CONSTITUTION

106 million Russian voters, of whom 38 million live in the country, can well be forgiven if they are baffled, terrorized and apathetic



about the G-7 and Yeltsin imposed election, December 12th. Consider the following:

- (1) If less than 50% of the 106 million cast their ballots, then there will be no Constitution, no "Duma". That is the "rule" imposed by Yeltsin's "Election Commission". In that case, the President still would have the guns and firepower to impose his will, as on October 3rd to 6th, and of course, the right to rule by decree, other things being equal.
- (2) The entire charade is the result of a series of illegal acts and procedures by Yeltsin and his cohorts (that included Ronald Reagan and George Bush) and now, has Bill Clinton, the C.I.A., the Mafiosi and Western banks, including the I.M.F., the European Bank of Reconstruction, the World Bank, etc., etc.
- (3) These illegal acts began with the dissolution by Yeltsin, Krawchuk, Shuskeivich and other Republic leaders of the USSR (and with Gorbachev's approval) and then setting up, without mandate from the people, the C.I.S. In fact, the people voted overwhelmingly to retain the USSR! This was followed by seizure of state power in Russia by Yeltsin, in connivance and agreement with the then Supreme Ruskoi, Soviet headed by Kashbulatov and Yegor Gaidar. They had all apparently agreed (with a few honourable exceptions) to proceed to the dismantling of the USSR, "privatization" and the socalled "free market economy" by which they meant "restoration of capitalism". Disagreements between these worthies came with the question of "how to proceed" with the destruction of Socialism, and the division of the spoils.
- (4) Because of these differences and the struggle for power between them, and after much posturing and cleavage between Yeltsin and the Parliament, (which meantime had

dumped the voracious "Westernizer", Gaidar) finally, by Presidential decree of September 21st, Yeltsin suspended the Constitution under which both he and the Parliament were elected, banned the Parliament, and eventually after "buying out" General Grachev, the "Defence" Minister, gunned and burned the Parliament Buildings out of existence and wantonly killed an estimated 1,000 Russian citizens. Then followed the arrest of his (by now) opposition leaders, Rutskoi and Kashbulatov, along with hundreds more, an imposed state of terror and censorship, destruction of the Constitutional Court. He then called the election for December 12th. Clearly, these were acts that went far beyond mere "illegality," and were in fact, acts of brigandage, terrorism and counter-revolutionary war. "Normally", the U.N. should have investigated!

It must be underlined that while all possibilities of "compromise" were totally ignored, Yeltsin's bloody rampage for power had the full overt and, we believe without question, covert, support of U.S. President Clinton and the "Group of 7" nations, the U.S.A., Great Britain, Japan, Germany, Italy, France and Canada. Tax payers' dollars were shovelled by the billions to the bloody dictator by all, and there cannot be a doubt that Yeltsin's guilt is shared in full by the overt complicity of these "statesmen" of anti-Sovietism. Left dangling still is the date of Presidential elections, originally called by Czar Boris for June next year, but now of uncertain date, or set off for years.

A NEW CZAR ERECTS ANOTHER "POTEMKIN VILLAGE"

Why does Yeltsin, apparently already secure following his

installation by the "guns of Grachev", seek so desperately for a "new" hand-tailored constitution? It would provide a kind of "cozy-coat" of alleged "democracy and freedom" (not to mention legitimacy) to wrap his bloody dictatorship in, thus, providing his backers with a "soothing syrup" to feed critics of the G-7 and Bill Clinton's complicity in their blood-stained course, pursued so energetically and avidly on behalf of the bankers!

Even Wm. Safire, former speech writer for Reagan and unswerving minion of the political right, says in

the New York Times of December 2: ... "he (Yeltsin) put his 'cat-in-the-sack' constitution on the ballot, certain that at least half of the electorate would vote, and certain that a majority of that half would buy his notion of a super-powerful President ... now he realizes it's in trouble ..." He goes on to quote Izvestia, usually a tame mouthpiece for Yeltsin, as saying "it (the constitution) doesn't cure dictatorship, it just relieves the symptoms ...". At the time of Safire's writing, only a minuscule minority of the 106 million voters had the foggiest idea of what the document said, or



what it would do, in true "pig-in-a-poke" style. As a result, he reports, "Yeltsin's men are rushing out 20 million copies (and are) predicting chaos if it is not accepted ... "Democratic debate", Safire asks rhetorically? "forget it", he replies.

IS THERE A REASON TO PARTICIPATE?

One could wonder why any political party of the left, or opposition to Yeltsin, should be involved in this apparent mad powergrabbing charade. NSC knows however that the Communist Party of the Russian Federation, led by Gennady Zyuganov, with whom we have previously been in limited contact, is participating. We have therefore, faxed him in Moscow as follows:

"On behalf of the CFSP and NSC, we would like to wish you success in the coming elections ... Being aware of the complex and critical situation in Russia and the march toward Fascism ... we constantly fear for the ideals of Socialism that are more and more obliterated in the rush toward capitalism ... we do get a varied picture of the thinking among various political parties ... We have heard from almost all the groups in Russia and have received their programs. In order to get a full picture, we ask you to send us your program and the reasons your party is taking part in these forthcoming elections, knowing in advance the identity of "winners" and "losers". We would like to publish the program of your party in forthcoming editions of our NSC. Hoping to hear from you, shortly,

In any event, the Toronto Globe & Mail, dated December 4th, in headlines over a story by John Gray, their Moscow Bureau Chief, says: "Yeltsin Coalition Cracking" and "Reform Cabinet Could Collapse". Gray writes: "The loose and uncertain coalition Yeltsin has gathered around himself to guide Russia from Communism to a democratic market economy, appears to be cracking under the strain of the December 12th election ... But now, there is even danger that the cabinet may collapse even before election day ..." According to his story, Western and "international institutions are reluctant to risk loans or investments in Russia". These are the forces thus far most closely tied to Yegor Gaidar and Yeltsin. But apparently, the moguls of high finance believe that Gaidar's "shock treatment" of closure and privatization of the gigantic state enterprises, built under Socialism, would lead to unmanageable unemployment, social unrest and economic, and, possibly even greater political upheavals. Gray writes that the "other side" of this division advocates a "softer" approach and a "gradual" transition to capitalism. Izvestia, (according to Gray) warns "it is very likely the opposite views of the budget and their partisan obligations will bring the cabinet members to a head-on collision ... No compromise is possible now. One or another group must resign, and this may happen soon".

"HEADS UP" WHEN BANKS "BACK OFF"?

NSC, and from a very great distance from the developing conflict, warns our readers that this may not be some simple economic "division" in the cabinet that is now creating tension or possible disaster in the Yeltsin camp. We are inclined to think

that any "bankers' reluctance" to "invest" may have more to do with the long, outstanding revolutionary and Marxist-Leninist Socialist traditions that lie deep in the soul of Russia and its people, and coupled with that, a fear that Yeltsin et al. is not capable, as their kept boy, of delivering that soul and their country to the financiers, whether by military gunnery and diktat, Presidential decree, or social reformist flummery. The Yeltsin and his "partners" situation, more and more reminds us of the parachutist that made nine out of ten successful jumps from great heights, but who forgot to buckle on his parachute for the tenth try. The results were disastrous, to say the least. Could it be that Boris, his friends and backers are now aloft for their tenth leap, and perhaps the "bankers" want out? We think so, without yet breaking out the champagne for victory over reaction!

In previous editions, we have carried information and materials of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks, led by Nina Andreeva, and the Russian Workers Communist Party, led by Victor Anpilov, now jailed by the Yeltsin forces, and other forces seeking the restoration of the Socialist Soviet Union and who have called for a boycott of the election. Should Yeltsin, Gaidar, et al., take their tenth leap, the world will know in the next few days. What that might do to the "just cruising along for super-profits" politics of the "Clinton-G-7" crowd will be (shortly) a later chapter.

"RUSSIAN PLANE VENTURE TAKES OFF" "ILYUSHIN HAS TEAMED UP WITH U.S. FIRMS ..."

"Four years ago, the (Soviet) Ilyushin Design Bureau received a proposal from a group that included Armand Hammer and Robert Maxwell for a project to combine Western and Russian aviation technology in a new commercial airliner ... under the venture, Ilyushin is equipping a modified version of its new 375 seat long-range jumbo jet, the 11-96 M. It will have engines from Pratt & Whitney of East Hartford Conn., and avionics (the electronic brains of the plane) from Collins Air Transport Division of Rockwell International Corp. of Seal Beach, California ... By combining a Russian airframe with U.S. technology, the companies expect to sell a plane that meets Western standards. And, because they can take advantage of low Russian labour costs ... about \$1.00 (US) an hour for aerospace workers compared with \$20.00 or more in the U.S. ... they are selling the plane for less than \$70 million, a saving of 30% over its closest Western competitor from the European Aerobus Consortium ..."

WE COMMENT:

Several things hit us in the eye from

this story: First, the "deal" that undermines totally the development of Ilyushin and the Russian aerospace industry, was made four years ago (1989) while the Soviet Union was still in existence and we presume, under Gorbachev's "Perestroika". We know that both Hammer and Maxwell (both now dead) were close "friends" with "Gorby" and it looks from here like a clear "sell-out" of Soviet interests. Secondly, perhaps the Russians can consider themselves "lucky" they were left the "right" to build airframes, the least labour intensive and technologically advanced and cheapest part of the plane. They are lucky because usually when dear old "Gorby" set up a deal, some other part of the USSR had disappeared or East Europe had been eaten up. Meantime, the Senators, Congressmen et al., of California, Conneticut and other spin-off areas can tell their electors how very very clever they were, and why they should really be elected once again. There's nothing like "'free' enterprise".

But the third element of this story cannot be happy for anyone who works the aerospace industry for a living ... or even for Boeing, McDonald Douglas et al., who until now have held pretty much of a monopoly in selling super-jumbo aircraft. The \$1.00 an hour Russian wage scale undercuts aerospace workers everywhere, and provides a competitive edge in the marketing of jumbos that will be very difficult if not impossible to meet. But then, such are the ways of "free enterprise", "competition", "global restructuring", etc., not to mention that other frayed notion, "anti-Communism is good, planned economies that would prevent such things happening are very, very bad". There will be lots of time in the unemployed line-ups for aerospace workers to think about that.

"Another group, the Cuban Committee for Democracy, is opening an office in Washington to lobby for an end to what they call the U.S. policy of 'isolation and strangulation' ... William Ratcliff of the Hoover Institute and former Reagan-aide Roger Fontaine have called for the Clinton administration to lift the economic embargo, while refusing any political contact with the Castro regime ... Meanwhile, the administration is making contingency plans for how to cope with a massive flow of refugees, should violence erupt on the island ..."

WE COMMENT:


The struggle of the Cuban people for the right to develop their own political, economic, social and cultural life appears headed toward the crunch. For 33 years,

they have endured the economic blockade of the U.S. Governments, assassination attempts on their lives, and perhaps most seriously, the withdrawal of support from the USSR that began under Gorbachev. "UKRAINE SHIVERS AS ENERGY DWINDLES"

Ukraines' rapidly dwindling energy supplies have prompted Prime Minister Yefim Zviagilsky to call for an "economic state of emergency" to force energy saving measures ... If nothing was done to import gas and oil ... "Ukraine could expect an Armenian winter" ... The energy crisis is now dominating Parliament ... "Since we cannot stop heating homes or supplying



agriculture with fuel, we must close down a number of high-energy enterprises", said Vilen Semenyuk, energy minister. Meanwhile, with temperatures touching minus 20 degrees, C. Ukrainians are adjusting to power cuts and colder homes in the worst winter in 50 years."

WE COMMENT:

"The worst winter in 50 years" means that since the end of WWII, Ukrainians have received sufficient quantities of oil and gas from Russia to have at least some comfort, under the former Socialist USSR. The "choice" to "Westernize" in the capitalist mode that they are trying to impose under the "leadership" of the "about face Communists" and nationalists and the U.S. state department, is precisely the reason they will now endure "the worst winter in 50 years", cold, shivering and with probable death tolls not before seen in peace time under the USSR. That is a pretty high price to pay for the "right" to what the nationalists and Zbigniew Brezinski would undoubtedly call "freedom and democracy". Or, is it really a historical farce? "MOB CASTS SHADOW OVER RUSSIA'S LAND OF OPPORTUNITY",

and

"WHEN YOU LOOK AT HOW THE MAFIA MAKES MONEY AND HOW GOVERNMENTS MAKE MONEY, YOU WILL SEE A LOT OF PARALLELS ..."

Olivia Ward, the Star investigator of all things anti-Soviet and now "anti-Russian" and certainly, "anti-Communist", tends to get her directions mixed somewhat in this article. But she comes into the range of truth when she writes: "more than 80% of Yekaterinburg (formerly Sverdlovsk) residents ... want to form a Republic and gain more power

over their economic futures. Here, as in other parts of Russia ... the shadow of the criminal underworld looms over the state as it does over individuals. 'Separatist tendencies in political life are mirrored in the criminal world'. She quotes Editor Plotnikoff of 'Sleuth', a monthly tabloid reporting on crime and investigation. 'When you look at how the Mafia clans make money, exporting rare earths and metals, and how Governments make money, you see a lot of parallels."


From time to time in past issues, NSC has pointed to some of these "parallels" and informed our readers of vast sums of money that mysteriously "escaped" from the former USSR into Swiss bank accounts. The sums amounted to billions, and we have as well, raised questions as to the particular roles of various bankers and banks, the Mafia, Government representatives, etc., in these dealings.

But side by side with the Olivia Ward story, the headline of the same newspaper of November 13th can be brought into the unfolding scenario of high level crime. That headline said: "Canada Tied To \$150 Billion Bonds Scam". The story, written by Jennifer Gould, reveals that there is an ongoing investigation by "private investigators for the Russian government who have been in Toronto for six weeks, "hunting for stolen Russian bonds, which are linked to international fraud", according to "sources". Also revealed was the fact that while the RCMP are apparently not "actively investigating the case ... they are 'keeping an eye on it'."

That particular scam, according to Gould's story, revolves around North America securities and bonds "that were supposed to have been cancelled in the mid-1970's and early 1980's" but instead, were stolen by Mafia groups who used them by

passing them to "unwitting ... or crooked ... European bankers. Some banks in Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union were founded on loans that used the dirty bonds as collateral, said one private investigator", the story reveals. The only bank implicated that has had its knuckles rapped with a \$750,000 fine is the largest U.S. commercial bank, Citibank. The fine was imposed by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) according to Gould. Despite the fact that Canada's federal finance department says it is unaware of the fraud, "securities investigators and others say that, in fact, Canada plays a key role in the international fraud, because: (1) it is likely that American bonds were smuggled ... through Montreal to Palermo; (2) there are \$1.5 billion of Canadian securities among the illicit bonds and stocks that have surfaced; (3) Montreal police obtained a search warrant in a hunt for dirty securities; (4) Missing Russian bonds are being sought in Canada; and finally, according to one U.S. investigator, 'Canadian Government bonds may be involved'."

Gould reveals in her story that: "Juval Aviv, a private investigator on the case said: "... the banks may have to bear the responsibility down the line. This has the potential to



shake the economy of the eastern bloc ... this could become a major scandal. The American Government is aware but (it's) being kept a big secret ... They're afraid to shake Yeltsin's banking apparatus' ..."

There is more to the story. However, apart from the single exposure in the Saturday Star story, the fact of a \$150 billion scam has apparently died, or been killed as a news item. To our knowledge, nothing more has appeared. That in itself is sufficient to raise eyebrows and curiosity, given the suggested relationship between Czar Boris, the Mafia and Western governments. There are other, possibly unrelated, but curious elements that seem to dove-tail with the Star exposé.

One such is Toronto's "own" Dmitri Yakoubovsky, he of the \$5,000,000 mansion in the Toronto Willowdale area, and who apparently rose from "Corporal" to "General" in record time as a member of the Yeltsin regime's mysterious entourage. In

July this year, (according to the New York Times of November 23rd) he was forced to flee Moscow to avoid arrest. He was alleged to have been spirited back to Moscow from Toronto at the request of Yeltsin to "sift through suitcases of documents for incriminating evidence against Yeltsin's powerful enemies", the

Times tells us. "After a nerve-tingling journey that began in Moscow railroad station ... the young lawyer made his way back to Canada, where the threats against him continued." Yakoubovsky "was the obvious source of bank documents purporting to link Vice President Rutskoi with a kick-back scheme ... his name also came up in connection with shady business dealings involving a key Yeltsin ally, Vladimir Shoumeiko, who had been his boss, briefly."

Shoumeiko is now a Vice President under Yeltsin, despite the fact he was briefly "out of the Yeltsin circle" for unexplained reasons. Yakoubousky is likewise the man pictured in NSC, Vol. 2, #2, September edition, with our late unlamented Prime Minister, Kim Campbell. He was likewise rumoured, (although this is not fully established) to be acquainted with Canada's other unlamented Prime Minister, Brian Mulroney, of "Boris & Me" boar shooting fame, or, notoriety. This connection appears to have developed through Seabeco, the Swiss-based trading empire headed by one "Boris J. Bershtein, a Soviet emigre, whose sudden success in business in the mid-1980's has been reported to have been financed by Communist Party money", the Times story says. If so, it appears that the financial "watch-dogs" had disappeared during the Gorbachev, "Perestroika" period. Previous regulations forbade and made illegal the carrying of even a single "rouble" from the USSR. But now, apparently billions float not only across that border of Russia, they have all the safeguards that the Mafia or Governments alike can provide to make their journey in dollars, safely, without impediment and into the safe hands they were dispatched for. Frankly, we cannot prove whether or not Yakoubousky or his pals in Moscow are implicated. But we think it might be worthy of somebody doing an "open" investigation. Perhaps such an "open" investigation could likewise influence the public to demand an end to the kind of dismal flouting of legal requirements, etc., by Mafia, Governments or whoever, and without fear or favour and regardless of who might be implicated in thievery and skullduggery. The "parallels" just might disappear to the public benefit of both citizens in Russia and Canada!

These items are taken from the following newspapers: "Democratic Ukraine", "Izvestia", "Tovarish". "Spravedlivost-Truthfulness", and "For the USSR". Three of these newspapers are not socialist or communist, but many times, truth "slips out" - Editors.

"GOLOS NATSII" STARTED TO PUBLISH EXCERPTS FROM "MEIN KAMPF"

This newspaper is published in Lvov by UNA and started with the issue No. 33 to publish excerpts from the book by Adolf Hitler. The Editorial asked the readers to look at Hitler in a different light – look at his theory of Nazism and the readers will see that Hitler and his fascists were not idiots or mad men as Communists of the world would have us believe! As Ukrainians, we can just take this "Slavicphobia" as truth, but as nationalists, we have to learn from the theory of Nazism!

"DEMOCRATIC UKRAINE" October 13

People of Lugansk, Ukraine,

together with thousands of Ukrainians from different districts welcomed General Consul of Cuba Pulio Garcia and together with the district, Supreme Soviet have signed agreements of trade with Cuba, in spite of the ravings of Kiev's nationalists. Cuba in its turn, takes hundreds of children who suffered at the Chernobyl tragedy to Cuba for rest, treatment ... all without costs to Ukraine. MURDEROUS ASSAULTS CAUSE JOURNALISTS TO GIVE ULTIMATUM TO MILITIA AND COURTS AFTER OSTANKINO!

Journalists of USA and Russia gathered to open up a Fund to promote fairness and truthfulness.

At Ostankino Tower, Ivan Scopan, operator of French TV-1 was together with his friend who operated the Moscow section of TV-1 Patrik Burra. When Ivan fell after being shot by OMON police, his camera was still running as he fell wounded. We later played the tape and we heard him scream, "don't shoot, don't shoot, we are journalists"!

The journalists that gathered on October 20th in Moscow to discuss this tragedy were besides themselves with anger, shouting, raising their fists as they recounted the slaughter on October 3-4 and the beastly actions of the OMON police against journalists and Peoples Deputies in the White House.

People were beaten savagely by batons, by shields, boots – they broke cameras, they broke ribs so that people screamed in agony, demanded dollar pay-offs and only after they received hard currency did they leave the journalists alone.

They herded us like cattle – they did not explain why and what for, they did not allow us to get in touch with our newspapers, editors, family members or friends. Medical help was barred from looking after the dying and the wounded. From 67 journalists that were beaten, 32 were beaten beyond recognition.

No matter how much the journalists of both countries demanded from Courts an explanation as to why nothing is being done to bring the guilty perpetrators to justice, so far, the Russian Courts and judges are quiet. They will not touch any of the complaints or start investigations.

The journalists demanded a court hearing as to the causes of this tragedy against the journalists. The journalists were told that they could cover car accidents, or other natural disaster, but with the ban on newspapers, these journalists are in the hands of the present government in Russia.

FIDEL AND CHE IN MY LIFE

Maybe it's a nightmare - the present situation of my people. Sometimes it seems that they're taking my country away, tearing it into pieces. Not too long ago, it was a mighty country of socialism but now, it is being dismembered by bourgeois nationalists. Being groomed by the West as a born again "democrat", Yeltsin has covered in blood the Supreme Soviet. He is affirming fascism. Being born is a new bourgeoisie who look down on the worker, outlawing my party, the party of Communists. They are falsifying history, the heroic history of my people to serve their ends - these renegades who just recently gave up their Party Cards. They cannot defeat the truth of Lenin, they take upon themselves the title of "truth of the people"! October will forever live history is giving birth to new leaders of the revolution. Although the heart is heavy with tragedy, I'm looking towards the future with optimism. Because there are people like these on our planet, like Fidel and Che Guevera is living in the hearts of the people. My friends and I saved their portraits during difficult times of defeats and successes.

I remember the year 1956 in the village of Yasnaya Poliana, Zhitomir District of Ukraine. I was then going to a village school where I was teaching geography ... While at the same time, I was the leader of our Komsomol Organization in the Collective Farm. It was an event that I will forever remember because on December 2 of 1956, we heard that Fidel and his compatriots landed in Cuba at Los Colorados. Even though this news came to us a bit late, we were agitated and followed this landing of Fidel on the small vessel "Granma" with interest and fear, as to the outcome. These heroes were against a despot, well armed and financed by America - the Dictator Batista. We felt that the ideals of Socialism are being carried on all over the world. This gave us strength and courage.

During these times, we had it hard in our lives. Our country was in ruins and devastation after the Great Patriotic War. We rebuilt the industry and agriculture, but lack of necessities were ever present. But we worked diligently - because we firmly believed in the right of our ideals. Young teachers, Komsomols, collective farmers did what was necessary to bring in the harvest during the day, while at night we thrashed the wheat and other products that we took off the land. But we knew that Fidel and Che and other patriots had it worse in the Sierra Maestra mountains, the mountains of Cuba where the partisan movement was swelling with volunteers ready to fight and die to defeat the fascist Batista dictatorship and with it, the Yankee domination of the Cuban people. We also found time for cultural activities, clubs and other events.

We formed special brigades to find new resources, new ways of

promoting better growth of all needed grains, vegetables and other fruits and we made sure that the hidden shortages were brought into the open and steps taken to liquidate these shortages for the benefit of our country.

We took amateur films, had our own wall newspaper. People had trust in us and saw our dedication to socialism. We also believed in our people. Together, we were building and defending our common goal – socialism.

In October of 1958, I and my friends were admitted into the ranks of the Communist Party. What happiness! To me, this was very symbolic, since in about two months, on January 1st, the Cuban revolutionary army liberated Santiego de Cuba. On the next day, the Army headed by Che Guevera liberated Havana, together with Fidel Castro and Camilo Sanfuegos. This is why we, newly admitted Communists, considered ourselves as brothers-inarms with our Cuban comrades. To this day, my friends and my family are very proud of this historical coincidence.

Following the developments on this island of Cuba, just a short distance from the country of world imperialism and reaction - the USA this was not just a lucky coincidence. There was taking place a new phenomena of people liberating themselves from tyranny and oppression, right under the noses of mighty imperialist countries. History was following the path of Fidel and Che, new leaders of a revolutionary movements. Colonial countries started to awaken and fight for their liberation. Our Soviet Union gave moral and other support with this movement for the liberation of the oppressed. On our part, we were building up our country, we tapped resources in Siberia, Kazakhstan, built the mightiest hydro-electrical dams in the world, in Tadjikistan and Kirkghizia, on the rivers Yenesi and Angara — built automobile production facilities like Togliatti. We were on the verge of total self-dependence as a monolithic country, helping the world to maintain peace and progress.

And we, as teachers, were teaching the children to love our Motherland, we told them about the Great October Revolution and its meaning for workers of the world. We told them about the Cuban revolution and all other movement in the colonial countries where people were striving for freedom. We impressed upon our future generation the meaning of internationalism.

No matter how the present traitors try to eliminate from our minds the truth as we were taught, it is impossible. Only those that are blind and full of nationalistic hate believe that this can be done. Only the wolves in sheep's clothing can accomplish this ... because these elements never had any other thoughts in the first place!

But to most of us, Lenin is still living now in our hearts, because Fidel is living. "Aurora" is making the enemies afraid because in the centre stands "HAVANA". They are also afraid that in centre of the main square in Santa Clara, a monument to Che Guevera is standing while in the centre of Havana, the vessel "Granma" is there as a symbol of victory and courage, as is our "Aurora" in Leningrad.

We are going along our path to the future. There is no other choice for mankind.

"You are like Che or Fidel, fanatics", we are told by our opponents now. How can anyone now call us fanatics if we want to defend our Motherland? These leaders of Cuban revolution, like Camilo Santiefuegos, to me, were always a legend, a symbol of



revolutionary courage, high moral values, hate for the enemy, dedication to the ideals for the benefit of the people. The life and dedication of Fidel Castro and his revolutionary comrades is a life of dedication and struggle for humanity and human dignity and happiness.

As a teacher in higher school establishments, I always try to instill in my students the ideals of communism and internationalism, humanity and brotherhood. I never fail to mention the heroic struggles of the Cuban people and other nationalities that struggle for human liberation. "truth", as Fidel always stated, "is the weapon of a revolutionary". That is why our Soviet people were following us – the communists, when our leaders were "real communists"!

Now, I'm a Professor at a University in Lutsk. It is extremely hard in these times of neo-fascism and more and more open fascism to teach – but my principles will not be sold. I talk socialism, I talk communism and I talk internationalism. On my working table are portraits of Fidel Castro and Che Guevera (since it is forbidden in schools to put up Lenin, Karl Marx or others). I talk to them and I believe in them.

But our hearts and thoughts are very disturbed now. Why did the world system of socialism fall apart? Why was the Soviet Union dismembered? Why are the names of our revolutionary leaders erased from our maps, history books? Why are the streets named after V.I. Lenin renamed and now carry names of enemies of my people such as Bandera and other bourgeoise Ukrainian nationalists, who fought against their own people together with Nazi Germany?

Fidel "talks" to me on my desk. Che "analyzes" the situation together with me. It is certain that we did some things that were not correct, if in

the socialist countries we let Satan in to have a ball! Yes, it is very difficult today! But, wherever was the path of a revolutionary without problems? the main effort now is to save the ideals of Communism and to cleanse it from pollution. "The party of Che, Party of Camilo, the Party of Lenin", said Fidel, "never, are you listening, NEVER! - will stop calling itself Communist Party of Cuba". The Cuban people, in spite of the problems of building socialism, will support that! This also makes our resolve even mightier for the ideals and future of socialism in our Motherland. We will never surrender our ideals and dedication!

The main aim now - we have to resurrect our Communist Party in my suffering country. Because without a Communist Party, there is no revolution, no socialism. Without the party and its authority, we cannot move forward (F. Castro)! Only the reborn and dedicated party can stop the further inroads of capitalism-imperialism and fascism. We have to re-learn Marxism-Leninism again - clean the muddy waters of opportunists and pseudo-It is extremely communists! important to make a distinction between revolution and counterrevolution, socialism from capitalism, international solidarity of people from aggressive imperialism under the flag of United Nations Organization.

Someone even called the Putsch of Batista of Cuba in March of 1952 as a "revolution"! Some of our people even today say that the market economy is a "new form of socialism"! But life itself proves to everyone the falsehood of this argument.

The Cuban communists are right, when they say that the American imperialism has not changed its aggressive policies. No matter how imperialism tries to hide under different cloaks of masquerade, such

as "democratic, humane, people's democracy, etc., etc.", or some other "capitalism", the results are the same. This is confirmed by events in Somalia, Yugoslavia, Palestine and in the Persian Gulf – and not to forget, in the United States of America itself.

I believe the sun of October will always shine over our planet Earth. Because we are millions. "There is no might, there are no such problems, that the enemy would be able to defeat our resolve to build our future in socialism" - Fidel Castro.

TRADE UNION ROUND-UP VARYING VIEWPOINTS, from

MOSCOW REVISITED, AS FASCISM LOOMS ...

By John Benson

(The writer had visited the capital of the USSR on a number of occasions in the past. This year, on October 6-9th, he was there again and saw at first-hand the destruction of the Russian Parliament. He was there as a member of a delegation that met with the leaders of several trade unions as well as discussing with a number of Muscovites. He was formerly the Secretary of the New South Wales Seamens Union, and also served as the Executive Secretary of the World Peace Council in Helsinki from 1978 to 1981.)

"To be in Moscow in the early days of October was to witness the capital of a once-mighty nation going through a painful political convulsion which has left the people frustrated and confused, and above all, frightened. It is obvious that the armed assault on the Parliament and the killing of the supporters of the elected representatives of the Russian people has left a tragic stain on the restored Russian flag.

Under one ruthless decree after another, explained as necessary to protect democracy, many arrests were made and, reminiscent of Pinochet's Chile, people were being incarcerated for an arbitrary period of three days for a process of "questioning" and intimidation.

Under the "state of emergency" declared by Yeltsin, sixteen newspapers that had questioned the legality of the President's arbitrary measures, or merely reported factually on the extremes being

implemented, were either banned or, on their own initiative, suspended publication in the face of savage censorship.

On the morning of October 6th, our delegation of Australian trade unionists, met President Klochkov of the Federation of Independent Trade Unions of Russia (FITUR). He commenced the interview with the comment that while FITUR had not taken sides in the events around the Parliament, a number of rank and file members, concerned with the threat to peoples' rights, had joined the picket lines. He said FITUR's Executive had produced a document expressing support for Constitutional Government, and that while the Trade Unions did not seek political power, they could not accept violations of workers' rights. He also expressed the view that with Yeltsin's victory over Parliament, they could expect continuous attacks on trade union organizations. Their newspaper "Workers Tribune" had already been closed down.

Throughout the meeting, President Klochkov appeared nervous and distracted. Later events were to justify his uneasiness. A few hours later, a senior aide to Yeltsin telephoned to inform Klochkov that a further decree had been prepared and awaited only Yeltsin's signature. This new decree was in fact the banning and expropriation of all property of FITUR. The aide said the only way the decree would be withheld, would be if FITUR put in place a new leadership. In the face of that ultimatum, Klochkov felt he had no alternative but to resign.

This threw the FITUR executive body into a state of pandemonium with some arguing that he should not have resigned, and with others taking a more conservative view. Following two emergency meetings, a decision was made to defer Klochkov's resignation until October

14th. As there has been no further news since that date, it must be assumed that Yeltsin had his way.

During this period, the attitude of the Union leaders we met can best be described as one of division, uncertainty and near-despair. It is also obvious that all organizations face the same "sword of Damocles" treatment.

Local, elected government bodies throughout all the regions of Russia have been invited to resign and "reform". This is also, of course, a "not-so-subtle" method introducing "political cleansing" to do away with all bodies who do not give unquestioning support to the Yeltsin regime and program. One citizen told this writer he feared the next steps would be indiscriminate arrests in a campaign of official terror. Another commented that the banning of the media and threats to the trade unions meant that all organizations not supporting Yeltsin, or who had within their ranks any communists or socialists, could expect discriminatory repression.

Several were of the view that the word democracy was a "joke", being used by different people to support differing views and by Yeltsin to justify all of his suppressive activities.

It is clear that not satisfied with the vicious repressions of October 4-5th, the Yeltsin forces are now pressing on with a determined agenda to obliterate all opposition from the Russian political spectrum. That is not only to gain that power for the immediate future, but by intimidation and threats to achieve a state of mind throughout the Russian people that will silence any future criticism or opposition.

We Do Produce Totally By Volunteer Labour. The parallel with the rise of Nazism in Germany in the years leading to WWII cannot be ignored.

EDITOR'S NOTE:

A ranking figure of the Soviet Trade Unions, Igor Yourgens, who visited Canada many times prior to the downfall of the USSR and with it, the All Central of Trade Unions, is well known to both many Canadian trade unionists and to Michael Lucas as President of the former Canada-USSR Association. He has given a lengthy interview to Fred Gaboury, representative of the World Federation of Trade Unions in the U.N. The interview was published in the People's Weekly World of November 5th, this year. We republish excerpts.

"Igor Yourgens, the 1st Vice President of the General Confederation of Trade Unions of the Commonwealth of Independent States, told the PWW that recent events in Moscow as reported by the media 'deliberately overshadowed the real reasons and the real problems' ... Yourgens said the January 1992 decision of the Yeltsin Government to privatize state enterprises and liberalize prices was 'tantamount to passing over to a new political, economic and social system. This was perceived by many as synonymous with human rights guarantees and prosperity for all.' He said that generations brought up with the knowledge that the state would provide them with 'assured subsistence believed that a "poor welfare state" would be replaced by a "richer welfare market" ...' the sharp fall in the average standard of living has 'caused these hopes to give way to a mood of growing anxiety. Even as late as 1989, most of the population of the USSR were "average" wage earners ... (but) by the end of 1991 the first Soviet millionaires appeared on the scene, as had the first beggars ...'

After ticking off some statistics indicating the depressed state now in Russia and including the fact that 'consumption has fallen 40% from a year previously in January' and 'Real incomes have fallen 60%'; 'Life expectancy has declined 9-12 years for males and 5-7 years for women since 1991', he went on to say 'It's no wonder that workers and their organizations are questioning the ability of the market system to improve material conditions ...'

Yourgens challenged the conventional wisdom of 'outsiders' who see all Russians that accept the present situation as 'democrats' and those who express disagreement as 'hardliners' ... He also said the trade unions have two major concerns: 'To guarantee democratic consultation as opposed to authoritarian rule', and 'to preserve social stability and justice. It would be contrary to the principles of the ILO to advocate returning to what some might call "wild capitalism".'

Pointing to 'billions of dollars, pounds and marks invested in Yeltsin's rush to introduce a market economy', Yourgens said that protection of that money is clearly a major factor influencing Western political and financial opinion ... Was it a mere coincidence that just after the bloodshed in Moscow, the Berlin stock markets topped levels not seen since the fall of the Berlin Wall ... Markets are assuming that you can forget Russia being a problem ever again because Yeltsin has won his famous victory ...'

He is quoted in an assessment of the bloody October 4-5th shoot-out of

the Parliament Buildings: 'Hundreds dead, thousands wounded, there is no Parliament, the Constitutional Court is suspended, local councils have been "advised" to shut down and prepare elections, the main opposition newspapers are closed as well as a number of political parties and censorship reinstated ... Both sides are to blame, as they were unable to reach a compromise, yet those in power must accept the real guilt for the schism in society; the original impulse for the bloody conflict was their decision to dismiss the Parliament', Yourgens stated.

The General Confederation of Trade Unions of which Yourgens is a Vice President was founded in December 1990 as the successor to the All Union Central Committee of Trade Unions of the USSR, and is an umbrella group with affiliations from all former Soviet Republics. They have conducted, or led, several strikes during the past period.

WE COMMENT:

Brother Yourgens' interview comes down hard on the economic problems and disasters confronting the former Soviet people. Of course, the intervention of foreign capital is the mainstay of the drive toward repression and fascism, and the united role of the organized working class, as envisaged by Lenin, should be the element that turns the wheel of fortune once again forward in that unhappy land. For reasons unexplained, but perhaps understandable, given the ferocious oppression by the Yeltsin dictatorship, Yourgens reserves comment on the future tasks of the trade unions in the former Soviet Union. We await clarification of the intense situation.

EDITOR'S NOTE:

The General Council of the World Federation of Trade Unions from its meeting in Warsaw, in its 45th session, forwarded a message of concern and solidarity to the Federation of Independent Trade Unions of Russia, the organization referred to in John Benson's leading article, above. In part, they said:

"(We) express grave concern at the tragic events that have occurred in Russia in recent weeks and the accompanying loss of lives. We are convinced that in this difficult time for Russia, the trade unions can and must play an active part in the construction of a democratic society and be an element that cannot be bypassed in carrying out economic reforms to benefit the vast majority of the people. The WFTU General Council expresses its feelings of solidarity and wishes the FITUR success in its activities, protecting the rights and interests of workers in the Russian Federation.

WE COMMENT:

We are heartened by this message from the WFTU Council to FITUR, representative as it is, of working people on all the continents of the world. Such expressions of solidarity between working people will not only force the reactionary forces seeking the return of Capitalism to the former USSR, it will expedite and solidify the massive struggles that must now be undertaken world-wide against the TNC's and their depredations and assaults on working people, not only in Russia, but on a world-wide basis. We express or hope that all trade union centres, both national and international, will follow the WFTU lead. In response to the message, FITUR said they were "counting on your future understanding and support because trade union solidarity is a formidable force.

Given our interest in supplying foreign trade unions with objective information on how an intolerable situation in which two parallel authorities that existed in Russia was resolved, as well as learning the opinions of delegates with regard to the future of the international trade union movement, we intended to

participate in the work of your meeting. However, developments in Moscow (Oct. 3-6th, and following – Ed.) and preparations for our extraordinary Congress, have prevented us from keeping our plans ..."

WE COMMENT:

Read in conjunction with the report of John Benson, above, the FITUR response to the WFTU takes on special and ominous meaning ... a meaning not to be missed or evaded by any trade unionist, or trade union organization in the world. The WFTU itself was originally split by Cold War policies that were thrust into the labour movement by the virulent policies and leadership that caved into the U.S. State Department. Now it stands in the leadership of the struggle by unionists everywhere to reunite on a world-wide scale, to confront the TriLateralists and bankers pulling the puppet strings in the G-7 nations and to re-open the doors of democracy, and the right of the Russian and former USSR workers to put in place the society they shall decide, as well as to protect the immediate interests of their families, communities and nation. NorthStar Compass hails and will make whatever small contribution we can towards such world-wide unity.

The All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks Addresses the Trade Union Question:

A written statement, by General Secretary Nina Andreyeeva, prior to the Moscow blood bath, says in part:

"Our working class is learning very quickly how to fight politically for their rights ... Workers are no longer naive as they were before, lulled by traitors in the CPSU and their trade unions. The workers are becoming revolutionized ... the authorities are trying desperately to divide the working class into small units, smaller unions, into so-called 'intellectual-engineering' units and societies, etc. ... On the eve of the disintegration of the CPSU, traitors

started the process among the workers by introducing 'anarchosyndicalist' tendencies to 'give' the factories over to 'workers collectives' ... the role of the working class is not to exploit other workers in either their own country or in other countries, but to give birth and to build a classless society without exploitation. It is necessary now to know the programs and methods of all the various parties, to analyze these, point out errors and to try and convince them that right opportunism is dangerous and that the role of the working class is international solidarity ..."

WE COMMENT:

Whether or not full agreement can be reached with Andreyeeva's analysis of all that transpired in the past, we believe that differing or rejection of her conclusions is not possible. Under the conditions now prevailing under the G-7-Yeltsin dictatorship, it is inevitable that the pressure toward right opportunism, class collaboration and sell out will increase at a furious pace. Experience of the struggles for workers' rights in the already existing capitalist world, and in the neo-colonialist world underlines that. We also agree with her statement of the historic role of the woriking class. That is what Marx wrote about!

COMMUNIST PARTIES, WORLDWIDE SPEAK OUT ...

Below, we publish excerpts from official statements by Marxist-Leninist Parties of Japan; Australia (as carried in The Guardian, October 6th, 1993); The Portuguese Communist Party; and the Canadian Communist Party. All deal with the Russian Federation's downhill course of bloody mayhem, the erasure of democracy and Fascist Diktat. Our purpose is to bring to our readers some

insights into the potential of world-wide solidarity developing among the anti-Yeltsin forces.

From: "The Guardian" organ of the Socialist Party of Australia:

"The storming of the White House in Moscow was not a victory for democracy, but it's murder ... Forcing Yeltsin's hand to impose a dictatorship was the deteriorating economic and political situation. Attempts to impose a "market economy" (that is, capitalism) have had catastrophic economic consequences ... the conflict was sparked by the unconstitutional action of Boris Yeltsin in attempting to disband Parliament ... Western leaders are chorusing their support for Yeltsin. He is their 'man' in the Kremlin who can be expected to carry out the demands of the World Bank and the IMF ..."

The Secretariat of the Socialist Party called on their Government "to reconsider its hasty and short-sighted blanket endorsement of Yeltsin's actions. This position discredits Australia's claim to stand for democracy and the rule of law ..."

From: The Portuguese Communist Party, September 13th and 22nd, Statements from their Press Office:

"All these (Yeltsin's) decisions are outside the presidential powers, and represent yet another shameless abuse of power with a view to eliminating, by coup d'Etat, any institutional obstacles to setting up dictatorial and arbitrary personal power ... It is particularly timely to stress the authoritarian and antidemocratic course of subversion of constitutional legality which Yeltsin and the reactionary circles around him have continually conducted. It is

an inseparable tool of the savage policy of capitalist restoration in Russia and the plunder of Imperialism ..."

– September 13th, 1993.

"The Portuguese Communist Party renews its profound solidarity with the workers and people of Russia, with the Communists and other democratic and progressive forces who fight against despotic projects that are inflicting painful suffering on the Russian people ..." – September 22nd, 1993.

From: The Communist Party of Canada: (People's Voice, November 1993)

"The Communist Party of Canada joins with supporters of democracy around the world in condemning the illegal seizure of power by Boris Yeltsin ... the revolt against Yeltsin (Oct. 3-6th) was a desperate and spontaneous upsurge, lacking the necessary leadership and mass support required for success. ... We are witnessing the establishment of an authoritarian regime with the trappings of bourgeois democracy ... We warn against any attempt by the U.S.A., NATO or the U.N. to intervene in Russia ... Russians who built socialism on Soviet soil will never accept this new form of tyranny in the name of so-called reform."

From Japan: "Akahata of October 8th, commented editorially on the situation in Russia"

"The intensified situation in Russia, which started from Yeltsin's unconstitutional decree to dissolve Parliament, has entered a new phase ... the killing and wounding of many people shows there was no democratic spirit or capacity to settle their dispute by peaceful means by either side ... Capitalist countries such as the United States and Japan

(and Canada - Ed.) which have supported Yeltsin since he took power and gave him full support for his actions this time, including dissolving Parliament and armed suppression. On October 6th, the heads of state of the G-7 countries sent a joint statement to Yeltsin and was initiated by Prime Minister Morihiro Hosokawa ... There is a strong tendency in the media to describe this Russian catastrophe as a struggle between 'democracy' and 'Communism' ... But Ruskoi. Kashbulatov fought with Yeltsin ... in August 1991 and shared the common attitude of being against Communism and in favor of capitalism. The would-be 'Communists' in the anti-Yeltsin forces are alien to scientific socialism. What is now going on in Russia has nothing to do with socialism and communism ..."

OUR COMMENT:

In the mid-1930's, the Communist International developed the universal anti-Fascist policy of "The United Front of the Working Class Against Fascism and War". Our understanding tells us that Marxism-Leninism is an international science of the working class. It was that "United Front" policy of the Communists that many historians give major credit to for the final military defeat and "unconditional surrender" of the Axis Powers. As we re-enter the dark world of finance-capital backed fascist aggression in Russia and ferocious attacks on the peoples of both the industrial and under-developed world. cognizance of this past history is a major need. The internationalism and solidarity of workers and all progressive forces now becomes more and more an immediate requirement. We are happy to see more and more the emergence of this among the Communists of the world, and we raise our hands in salute to all parties, communist or otherwise, who travel the road of unity

of the people for eliminating the corporate sponsored resurgence of the fascist threat ... regardless of its various disguises in 1993.



THE BLOOD-STAINED TRAIL OF U.S. HISTORY

The history of the United States is a blood-stained trail which reaches to the furthest corners of the globe. To understand the full significance of the course which has been taken, one must go back to the time of Christopher Columbus and his crew setting afoot in America. It is a story of pillage, plunder and slaughter.

Following Christopher Columbus came the Spaniards to continue the course of destruction. Then came the British who brought in African slaves in chains to work on the plantations of the South. The actual

story of U.S. development began after the revolution of 1776.

The next major U.S. development began with the Civil War. A myth has been propagated in the history books that the Northerners fought the war to free the slaves, whereas their aim was to provide the equivalent of slave labour for the emerging factories of the industrial age. Lincoln supported this aim.

The U.S. achieved its greatest prominence following the Second World War, in which it did not participate until it was attacked at Pearl Harbour. In the meantime, it amassed huge profits from trading with both sides. After World War Two, U.S. assumed the role of world policeman. Its military incursions involved many countries which it proceeded to invade one after another.

In their attempt to mislead people, United States has rewritten the dictionary so that words mean their opposite. This is often referred to as "engineering consent". Thus, "free world" means Capitalism, "Evil Empire" refers to the former Soviet Union. "Retaliatory Strikes" are the justification for their military incursions, the "Defence Department" means the War Department, "Peace Makers" mean the armed forces and "Peace Keepers" mean standing armies of occupation, "Freedom Fighters" are the paid forces that enslave

people!


The essential function of that is to design, propagate and create a system of doctrines and beliefs which undermine independent thought. In this, the state has established a whole system of fabricating and spreading false information, in which it has willing helpers consisting of the Press, TV, Magazines and Universities and Schools.

While the Civil War was fought ostensibly to free the slaves, there was no hesitancy at slaughtering hundreds of thousands of Native Indians, destroying their homes, seizing their lands and driving the survivors onto reservations. The Indians fought bravely but they were no match for American fire-power.

After 1960 came a series of military encounters directly and indirectly involving the United States, spread throughout the world. We cannot record all of them, so we will select some of the more outstanding ones.

Most of the U.S. adventures came into being as the result of the "Cold War", when the Americans developed a paranoia about the "Evil Empire" which had to be destroyed. These military encounters involved many countries.

In 1962, the Kennedy administration launched a major terrorist war against Cuba. An embargo was set up by the U.S.



and still exists to this date. It included attacking civilian installations, bombing hotels, sinking fishing vessels, poisoning crops and livestock on quite a significant scale, assassination attempts on the head of state, murders, bombing aircraft and bombing of the Cuban missions abroad.

Indonesian Genocide began in 1965. A further incident followed when 700,000 people were massacred, within a couple of months, with the support of the United States. It was greeted in the U.S. with applause because it returned Indonesia to the "Free World"!

Israel became involved in 1967 when it defeated the Arabs in the

In turn, the U.S. has supplied Israel with arms and military support against its neighbours. Some people in the Jewish community regard anybody opposing this role as a self-hating Jew and a traitor.

In 1975, another massacre occurred in East Timor, similar to the "killing field" of Pol Pot, except that it was carried out under the guise of a Peasant Revolution.

In 1950, United States, behind the banner of the U.N., attacked Korea as "security against the Soviet Union". There was no justification for this since the U.S. had already more security than had even been attained by any country in history. It had no enemies nearby; it controlled both

Then followed the Central American holocaust which started in 1980, after years of U.S. Imperialist domination. This will be recorded as one of the blackest marks of U.S. involvement in the invading of these countries, where the leaders were assassinated or forced to flee for their lives. Foremost among them was Nicaragua. The Sandanistas were finally pressured to sign an agreement with the Contras which produced very little positive results. The former democratic countries were replaced by a blood-thirsty group who terrorized or murdered more than 100,000 people. The situation has not improved to this



Seven Day War. It has been regarded since then by the U.S. as a strategic asset, serving its interests as an "attack dog", together with Saudi Arabia and Iran. The major American interest in this region is not Israel but the energy resources which, for 40 or 50 years, had become the largest and the cheapest in the world.

oceans and was overwhelmingly the most powerful state in the world. There wasn't a shred of evidence that the Russians had anything to do with the Korean attack nor is there today. The U.S. was forced to withdraw its armies by the strong North Korean Forces prepared to defend themselves.

In 1983, the little island of Grenada was attacked by the U.S. because it was deemed a "Soviet outpost". Grenada is a little pin point island. By the furthest stretch of imagination, no one could envision this tiny spot as a menace to anybody!

In the early 1960's, American military attention was on Vietnam

where one of the bloodiest wars in history was fought, resulting in more than 2 million casualties. Here for the first time, Agent Orange and Napalm were used against the people. The reason given for the attack by the U.S. was "Internal aggression", another concoction of American lingo.

In June 1985, "Peace for Galilee" was marked by the Israeli invasion of Lebanon, with the blessing of the United States. Israel had further goals, namely to take over Lebanon and install "A new order" which would mean a client regime based on the right-wing Christians and selected privileged Muslim elites. Omar Quadaffi, a popular leader, was now labelled as "mad dog" of the Middle East and the "king of international terrorism" who had to be destroyed.

In the attack on Panama in 1989, the aim was to eliminate its former henchman Noriega, who had turned against them. Apparently, Noriega was not under control, so he had to be replaced and U.S. defence forces accused him of drug-running and arrested him. He was thrown into jail and is still awaiting trial. He has been identified as a C.I.A. agent. It is suspected that this affair was motivated mainly by the upcoming negotiations on the Panama Canal Treaty.

The Gulf War in 1990 in which the main cause originally was oil supplies in the Gulf area, and over which the U.S. was determined to retain control. Saddam Hussein, who had formerly also been an agent of the U.S. and had supported their aims in the Gulf, turned against them. He was now described as the "Butcher" of the "Near East" and also, "Little Satan". Israel and Saudi Arabia remained faithful to serve the needs of the U.S. All of the invasions were the result of the Alliance for Peace in support of the

U.S> program of destruction as set forth by John Kennedy.

At the time of writing, U.S. troops are engaged in Bosnia and their helicopter bombers are attacking Somalia in their attempt to enforce acceptance of their policies.

Recently, an American-engineered peace treaty between the Palestinians and Israelis was concluded in Washington. There was a great deal of hype published in the press with glowing pictures of a new world in the making. A great many questions remain unanswered with strong opposition from elements on both sides. Will it succeed? Only time will tell.

Now that the Soviet Union has temporarily fallen, the U.S. can no longer claim that its armies are defending the free world against the "Evil Empire". With its one million troops, it now has the most powerful armed forces in the world. What justification can it offer at this time for the trillions of dollars that it spends on its up-keep? A feeble reply is that it is providing jobs for those in service. Just as much can be accomplished by digging up the roads one day and replacing them the next day.

The U.S. now dominates the United Nations Organization, with that body being merely its rubber stamp. The U.S.A. remains the greatest military force but it has fallen behind Japan and Germany economically. Ultimately, a new global order must arise conforming to social and environmental laws. Presently, the thieves, scoundrels and traitors have seized positions in high places.

One is reminded of Walt Whitman's poem dedicated to the defeated French Revolution:
Liberty let others despair of you,
I never despair of you,
Is the house shut, is the master away
He will soon return – his messengers

come anon.

The future lies with the people Even though it seems so far away.

POST SCRIPT:

At this time, recent changes predicted in the above article have taken place. Yeltsin has destroyed the constitutional parliament by gunfire and called spurious elections. In Poland, reaction received a severe defeat when a new government led by Communists was elected. In Georgia, Eduard Shevernadze is desperately trying to cling to power.

We issue a caution to the United States, where President Clinton has already declared that Yeltsin receives his support. "Keep your nose out of affairs beyond your jurisdiction. The people of Russia can very well take care of themselves without your interference."

GROUPS PROTEST YELTSIN MASSACRE IN MOSCOW

The campaign in Solidarity with Labor in Russia charged that the Yeltsin regime ordered a coldblooded massacre in Moscow on October 4 and 5. There is evidence that the real death toll was many hundreds, perhaps close to 1,000. To date, many people are still missing and unaccounted for. The group also charges that there is a conspiracy of silence on the part of the Clinton administration and the U.S. media.

The Campaign protested on Monday in several U.S. cities, including a picket outside the Russian Mission to the United Nations, and a public meeting in San Francisco was held last Saturday.

"There is a cover-up going on, and we want to expose it," said John

Daly, an organizer for the Campaign. "We also want freedom for the Yeltsin regime's political prisoners. It is the butcher Yeltsin who should be on trial, not those who defended Russia's Soviet-era constitution and working class ownership of industry.

"The Clinton administration is supporting Nazi-like terror in Russia. The U.S.-backed Yeltsin regime massacred hundreds of workers to secure his plans for capitalist economic reforms. Sixteen legislators and leaders have been imprisoned, including Victor Anpilov of Labor Russia. All elected bodies have been





abolished and working class parties and newspapers have been banned," Daly added.

According to Daly, on October 15, the pro-Yeltsin newspaper Komsomolskaya Pravda cited reports that hundreds of bodies of people killed in the Parliament Building by Yeltsin's forces were being removed through underground passages and secretly cremated.

Campaign organizer Laurel West added, "Clinton says he is for democracy, but to him, 'democracy' is whatever makes Wall Street and the big corporations richer. Yeltsin is targeting anyone who doesn't want Russia's wealth handed over to the capitalists and U.S. corporations. Yeltsin plans to take away what legally belongs to the workers and create mass unemployment and homelessness for the people of Russia."

The Campaign in Solidarity with Labor in Russia was formed to fight against U.S. support for Yeltsin dictatorship. The Campaign is calling its first activities, on the anniversary of the 1917 Socialist Revolution, in solitary with working women and men of all nationalities in Russia.



OBITUARY

THE PASSING OF A GREAT CANADIAN ...

Dr. James Gareth Endicott died on November 27th in Toronto, in his 95th year. The obituary in the Globe & Mail of November 29th states: "Dr. Endicott was possibly the most vilified Canadian during the 1950's when the Federal Government in a sort of knee-jerk reaction to Communist witch-hunts in the U.S.A., considered charging him with treason." His "crime"? The revealing of evidence that the U.S. and U.N. forces had used "germ warfare" against the Korean and Chinese defenders of North Korea. For those then involved in the Canadian Peace Congress, which Dr. Endicott had headed up and helped to organize, it was clear that the McCarthyite anti-Communism of the day lay at the roots of the efforts to vilify and subject him to "character assassination" had not This was totally succeeded. confirmed at a huge Maple Leaf Garden meeting in 1952. Estimated at a minimum 18,000 people, backed onstage by his father (also the Reverend James Endicott and former Moderator of the United Church in Canada) and by Nels Thibault, head of the Mine, Mill & Smelter Workers Union in the country, Dr. Endicott's devastating charges overwhelmingly approved and accepted by the huge throng. The Government of Louis St. Laurent backed off of their announced intent to place "treason" charges and returned his mailing rights, which they had tried to ban.

Born in China of missionary parents, in 1925, he joined the United Church Missionary Service there for 21 years. As a key advisor to the ruler Chiang Kai Shek, in the later years, he broke with him over the war against the Communist forces conducted by Chiang and the ruling Kuomintang in the face of almost overwhelming Japanese aggression. He condemned Chiang and publicly voiced his support to the revolutionary advances of the

Communist forces led by Mao Tse Tung.

On his return to Canada, he undertook leadership in the growing peace movement organized against the Cold War and the intense dangers of a nuclear holocaust. On platforms from Victoria B.C. to the Maritime Provinces of the East coast, he brought his message of peace, international brotherhood and solidarity among the people. He toured the country with the redoubtable Dean of Canterbury, and on at least one occasion, in Timmins, Ontario, speaking to a capacity crowd jammed both upstairs and downstairs into the Ukrainian Labour Temple, and with a milling crowd of two thousand outside, delivered the Beatitudes "Blessed are the peacemakers" to the accompaniment of the loud shattering of every window in the hall. Fortunately, "peace security" forces had firmly blanketed the

For his sterling activities as head of the Canadian Peace Congress, he soon became a Senior officer of the World Peace Council, headquartered first in Geneva, and later in Helsinki. His world travels and efforts on behalf of ending all wars, whether "Cold" or "hot", won for him high honours, acclaim, and acceptance in the world peace community, including in the Soviet Union and in China. Sometimes barred from entry to the U.S. to attend U.N. meetings there, he found official governmental rejection but great warmth and support among a large section of the American people.

Fearless, indomitable, possessed of a keen and searching mind, Dr. James Endicott may truly be said to have given an immense contribution to holding off the dire threats of nuclear holocaust, on a world-wide scale.

For those of us fortunate enough to have been his friend and fellow peace activist, we extend our condolences to his family. His gigantic leadership for peace is a matter of pride to Canadians. We dip our banners in solemn salute to a great Canadian, and vow that his precious torch of life and peace will be carried forward in these dark days.

Concerned Friends of the Soviet People, and NorthStar Compass, sincerely honour his memory and his deeds. We are honoured to have walked side by side with him for a way in the never-ending struggle and quest by the people of the world for Peace.

(We had stopped where Anya Divina, born 1919, her mamma Ukrainka, papka (papa—endearing) a Chaldon—a Siberian nationality, is lying on the ground seriously wounded, the vicious battle with the murderous German-fascists raging all around her. Though unable to move or even turn, through her mind float through many happenings of her

young life – in Siberia, the Ukraine and with the heroic partisan brigade.)

* * * *

"The girls' faces are flushed, ruddy, not like on your faces, stern muzhiks. Dressed like for a holiday into long, flowery dresses all the way down to their very heels, red ones, blue ones and bright yellow ones. On their feet – exquisite, high laced, shining, sparkling shoes, upon a high heel. They are not walking, they are floating like gorgeous peacocks.

Where are you running? Why are you passing me by? ... Probably for a stroll to the river, to see the lyodokhod ...* They floated by like a vision ...

They are too excited to stop for me ... I myself would have galloped away, to ... once more – see ... at least once more to glance at the lyodokhod on the Siberian rivers; don't know anything handsomer!

The entire village poured out onto the river bank – a spree, a merrymaking. From joyous excitement, the accordions are getting flabbergasted, with matching little verses are dancing and hopping the girls, disclosing in their little verses their thoughts during those past long winter days, about a darling, about love, about jealousy. And I really don't know how it all winds up, but only, as a rule, they are always dancing and jumping and stumping and singing, with the rivals and telling in the verses what would have been impossible to speak in ordinary conversation. And in those verses, for whom it is being sang, her darling, he's supposed to catch onto it, how she is longing for him, how much she loves him ... And she sings about this openly, in front of everybody ..."

..."Mayakovsky: 'Read, Envy, I - am a Citizen of the Soviet Union!'

... Chelyabinsk ... shipbuilding factory-mill ... Mamochka ... we

gathered at the rail-road station ... I'm helping to evacuate the mill to the East ... Why I then left Chelyabinsk? ... At the station, old men are untying some-kind of knots on their handkerchiefs and are laying out the few rubles which they, obviously, put away for their old age, and now: 'Take it, dochka!', (endearing 'daughter') ... And the Germans want to conquer such a people – it won't be! ...

Why I left Chelyabinsk?

Mama! Dearest mamochka! I could not live in the rear any more ... Onto the Front! 'People are needed here!', was saying the factory

Mama, mam ... Where are you kind, good mamochka? I carried out my duty to my motherland. Don't cry mama, I did what I was duty-bound to do ... Don't judge me, mama ... Proshchay! ...***

MOTHERS! The heart-rending sufferers in every war. They never forget. Carl Sandburg wrote this of Abraham Lincoln:****

Just after the battle of Gettysburg, a woman came to see Lincoln - crying. Her husband and three sons were in the army. She had lived for a time on part of her husband's pay till money from him stopped. She was hard put

SOME CRITIQUES

Hello:

I was reading NorthStar, Volume 2, #1, August 1993, and came across the article, "Czarism and Social Progress". On page 7, you speak of the Greek Orthodox Church as being the greatest landowner. Wasn't it the Russian orthodox Church you mean? The form was adopted from Greek but in Russia, it would be the "Russian" Orthodox with Russian language services and customs native to its own country.

Our Encyclopaedia Britannica tells us on this subject that "From 1037, the Russian Church was subject to the Constantinopolitan Patriarchite and for two centuries nearly all Metropolitans and most Bishops were Greeks. Eventually the Russian and Slavonic element prevailed. After Vladimir's death in 1015, his son Svyatopolk "the damned" assassinated his brothers ... but was defeated by another brother Yaroslav, elective Prince of Novgorod, who reunited all territory under the grand duchy of Kiev and embellished his capital with a cathedral in Byzantine style ..."

Tracing the development of the Byzantine (Greek) church, in part, the Britannica says: "In 873, Pope John VIII ... Allowed the Slavonic services ... (but) in spite of the triumph of the Latino-German party, (in the west – Ed.) the Slavonic liturgy was not quite stamped out ... and survived in out-of-the-way corners of Great Moravia ... it appears to have penetrated into Bohemia, Poland and Croatia, but all these countries finally accepted the Latin (Roman) Church and so were permanently cut off from the Orthodox Serbians, Bulgarians and Russians ..."

From all of that, we deduce that the essential divisions, wars and separations of "Orthodoxy" in the East European, Greek and Russian Churches took place over harsh and often violent disputes that clothed themselves in liturgical problems and differences, but were really about land, dukedoms, etc. We know that the "Russian" Orthodoxy came to central and majority religious hegemony over the last named by the Britannica, (i.e., Serbians, Bulgarians and Russians) while those pursuing the non-Slavonic liturgies, etc., were confined to smaller followings, properties, duchys, etc. It is probably true that the former (the Russian Orthodox Church) held more land and wealth. We suppose our concern now is whether or not they will support Yeltsin and the Western bankers in their mad-dog rush toward Presidential and even Fascist empowerment in Russia. Only as a member of the great family of nations could Ukraine have achieved the industrial, cultural and economic might and have become a member of the United Nations Organization as a sovereign country.


Was the USSR an Empire?

THE BATTLE OVER MONUMENTS (Thoughts about the Obelisk to Glory)

Night covered the city with its wings. Just here and there, the lamplights shine over the streets. The moon cast a look of anguish at the monument to the fallen soldier. who was clutching his chest to stem the flow of blood. This Soviet soldier never made it to Berlin in 1945. He remained here, forever alive on the Memorial Square in Lutsk alongside thousands of graves of my countrymen who found their eternal rest under the shade of firs. Others laid down their lives shot by the treacherous Ukrainian bourgeois nationalists.

Please stop your walk onlooker ... are you listening to the voices of the grass and leaves? This is not a wind that is blowing among the graves. This is a prayer for those who died at the hands of traitors. Let us remember that time here when one of the sons of mankind died in 1941. The Red Army in horrendous battles was retreating further east. Bleeding profusely, a

wounded Soviet soldier ran into the nearest village house, not far from Lutsk, in order to change the bloodsoaked bandages and find someone to ask for some food. But in this village house lived not a man, but a traitor, an Ukrainian nationalist. He, together with other bandits, pounced on the Red Army man, broke his arms, tied him to a horse and dragged him over roads and into the forest ...

In the Western territory of Ukraine, at the hands of OUN-UPA (Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists — Ukrainian Underground Army) thousands of peaceful citizens met horrible deaths while trying to liberate mankind from Nazism. Basing ourselves on the records of UPA, they themselves admit that they received from Hitler over 700 mortars, 10,000 machineguns, 26,000 automatic rifles, 22,000 pistols, 100,000 grenades, 70,000



mines, plus millions rounds of ammunition. In a book published in Toronto, Canada, 7 volumes "Documents of UPA" on page 208, the story goes that in just one small locality, the bandits received from German Army 2,000 rifles and 3,000 machine-guns. All these armaments were utilized to fight the Red Army and to kill innocent people of Ukraine.

During spring of 1943, the bands of OUN-UPA started a mass terror campaign against the Polish people living on the territory of Western Ukraine. During a religious holiday of Peter and Paul, over 5,000 Poles were liquidated. Under the direction of Stelmashuka "Rudogo" on 29 - 30 September, there were 15,000 people killed. In May of 1943 in the village of Stepanskaya Huta, Rovensky District, a band of OUN with Taras Borovec at their head, gathered all the population, over 300 people, including children, women and old people, into a church and set fire to the wooden building. In particular, the bandits were beastly against the family of Valentin Turovskij, who was a member of the partisans. They beheaded his wife and cut off her breasts. Two small girls of 2 and 4 years of age, they left by the house, their heads chopped off and wooden stakes driven through their bodies.

On May 30th by the villages of Horlupy and Olyka, the bandits captured any peaceful citizen that was walking theroad or was tilling his land and who was Polish, and cut off their tongues and gouged their eyes out.


The genocide was carried on by these nationalists even after our land was liberated from the Nazis. The limited sources of the archives that were preserved from September of 1943 to 1951 after the Poles were nearly exterminated; in the Volyn district alone, there was more than 8,000 murdered by these bandits, among them, 1,055 children. The Banderites always organized


diversions against the Red Army. In the village of Kotov, Kiverchiskyj District, September 17, 1944, UPA got hold of Artemchuk, village chairman. In front of people gathered for the execution, a bandit cut out his heart, put it in the palms of his hands and smiling, said to the people: "Look at the strong heart of a communist! The heart beats even on the palms of my hands."

Unfortunately, there is no peace even for the dead in their graves. Just like before, the soldier is holding himself by his heart, as if again someone has put a bullet in his chest. Again, we see the raising of nationalist heads. Let us take a look at the Memorial Tablet, under which lay the remains of heroes that

gave their lives so that we can be free. On this plaque was written, "Party, Soviet and Komsomol members, died at the hands of Ukrainian bourgeois nationalists". It is obvious that we have elements that are enemies of their own people, as was Judas. As can be seen, the wording was defaced, and the words which say that these people were killed by the Banderites, were eliminated. The Banderites are seeking revenge.

Even during our so-called "perestroika period", the bandits in Lvov, the son of a bandit-terrorist Y. Shuhevich who yelled out "Kill Jews and Moskals (Russians)" dispersed a Conference of Russian Cossacks. Appearing in 1991 in Ivano-Frankovsk at an evening affair





dedicated to the 100th anniversary of one of the founders of OUN, E. Kovalevec, member of the Council of Capovich declared: "Only with guns in our hands can we defend our democracy. Without arms, there is no democracy or no Ukraine."

What is scary now is the fact that these elements with the permission of the Ukrainian authorities are again pushing Ukraine into nationalism. In Western Ukraine, Banderite bandits are demanding to be recognized as patriots of the Second World War! During a state visit of the Polish Deputy Minister of External Affairs officially stated, if OUN-UPA is rehabilitated by the present regime of Ukraine, Poland will break off diplomatic relations.

... It seems to me now, that all of our monuments, memorial squares, which depict the heroism of our people in the fight against fascism, are fighting together with us against this black plague. People must save these monuments for their children, grandchildren and future generations. Towering over the Memorial to War Heroes is an Obelisk dedicated to Victory. On top of the Obelisk is a Medal of Victory. There is already a campaign by the authorities to dismantle not only the Obelisk but the whole Memorial Complex, because it "does not represent anything - it is the wrong symbol"!

But the Medal of Victory is not just a "symbol", the red stars on the Memorial represent the highest medals the Soviet people are able to bestow on their fallen heroes!

"Hands Off Our Sacred Monument"! – roar the voices of the dead. Are you not listening, people of the earth? Listen to the mother, standing near the Obelisk whose tears are shed for her son. How important are the words of a man who will live in our heart forever: "People, I love you! Be vigilant!" – Julius Fuchik

WHERE ARE WE BEING LED BY OUR LEADERS?

Nationalism is like a cancer growth which must be removed or the patient dies. DECLARATION

of the Secretariat of the Central Committee, All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks on the Results of the Elections and Referendum

Elections of December 12, 1993 completed the pre-election blitzmarathon, which, as was expected, unfortunately gave a semblance of law to the Yeltsin plan of the Constitution and the election of a Duma. The election campaign was held with wholesale buying of have-not electors, social demagogy, hooliganism and trickery, the composition of which the hidden "democrats" will have to study and analyze. All stops were pulled by Yeltsin's machine to "guarantee" their results in the referendum on the Constitution. The Yeltsinites suffered defeat in their aim of getting an "improvised" parliament which, as we see, will become unworkable and an odious buffoon, than even more all previous "monuments" of Russian bourgeois the polarization of political movements in the country and imminent growth and danger of reaction and fascism.

The results of the election "extravaganza" and the crash of the promised television reception of the elected body to open up the "New political year" showed, that the participation of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation (CPRF) in the elections not only split the communist movement in the country,

but guaranteed the acceptance of the Yeltsin constitution and the temporary victory of the counterrevolution. This Constitution, makes possible in Russia the foundations of future Feuhers. We cannot allow during these critical times for our Motherland that the usurpers of leadership, the "leaders" and "little leaders" with their pretences, to subvert the anti-fascist front for their own narrow-party interests, as was the case during the beginning of this year. Robbed and humiliated by traitors and falsifiers, the people are awaiting some words from you, workers of culture, arts, education and technical personnel. Time has come to make a decision and not "be above" the calamity that has befallen our Motherland!

All Communist Party of Bolsheviks are ready to support all people of positive thought and actions towards the salvation of our Motherland.

FASCISM AND REACTION WILL NOT PASS! MOTHERLAND OR DEATH!





A CALL FOR WORLD-WIDE SUPPORT TO AN ANTI-FASCIST FRONT, and

A COMMENT ON THE RUSSIAN "ELECTION" CHARADE ...

As we go on the press, early results filtering through the commercial press indicate that the illegality, not to say immorality, of the charade of "democratic elections" under the Yeltsin regime has plunged Russia into an even deeper state of chaotic misgovernment.

The claim by the Western media, in harmony with the Yeltsin & Company gang of "Westernizers" (meaning those engaged in the I.M.F., the European Bank of Reconstruction, the World Bank, et al., rush to capitalism) would have us believe that 50%, plus, of the 108 million voters in fact cast ballots is directly challenged by the most knowledgeable sources in Russia. We await further developments on that score.

The emergence of the neo-Fascist Liberal-Democratic Party led by Zhirinovsky is a chilling development, coupled as it is with virulent anti-Semitism, proposals for the reestablishment of the "Russian Empire" (which can only mean an attempt to return to the barbarism of the Czars) and other wild and unbelievable demands and proposals. Press reports, as this is written, indicate that Party may well have taken something approaching 30% of the ballots cast. We suggest however that equally unsubstantiated suggestions that the extreme right wing advance is like the rise of Nazism should not at this time be fully accepted, although some elements of that are present, including the role now in Russia of international finance capital. The

question around this surge to the right appears to us as whether or not the Western financiers, who have propped up Yeltsin-Gaidar and their so-called "reforms", will now shift their support to this openly Fascist grouping in their efforts to establish open-house for their invest-ment and exploitation of Russian resources and cheap labour. That is as yet an element that has not appeared, but which may well be in the process of surfacing. Coupled in that particular and very possible scenario is the fact, published else-where in this edition, that the bankers of the West seemed to have second thoughts in some as to the ability quarters at least, of their pet buffoon Yeltsin, to deliver Russia to them.

In a summary story written for this edition, we have quoted a fax to Gennady Zyuganov, head of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation asking for a statement of their program since they had agreed to participate in the election, so we might publish it to enlighten our readers, now world-wide, as to their position. We have not received a reply as we go to press. This, we find both distressing and difficult to understand. We now reveal, that at our expense, last year, we brought to Canada, an activist from Moscow (whose name we shall not reveal in order to protect his security) in a genuine effort to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the situation there. This anti-Yeltsin activist spoke to us as a member of the CPRF. It has been our continuing hope since that time that political charges against the CPRF by other Communists in Russia would prove resolvable and that eventual unity would develop between all the Communist parties.

It is now clear that failure to reach a united position to boycott the election, and participation in them by the Zyuganov group was an essential element for the pro-capitalist crowd, including Yeltsin and the Western bankers, to reach their goal of a

fundamentally repressive and dictatorial constitution so they might govern at their will. On this basis, we now take most seriously charges of reformist and social democratic policies levelled against Zyuganov and his associates. It is now impossible to believe that the CPRF, whether they call themselves Communists or not, will be able to defend the true interests of the Russian people and their Republic in the face of Yeltsin's Constitution from the onslaughts they will now suffer under the new Constitution of dictatorship. In this light, the accusations of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks gain clear credibility, and the danger of rule by Presidential diktat is consolidated. We can easily understand the reformist and Social Democratic nature of the CPRF if as charged, the Gorbachev forces stand behind Zyuganov and his associates, as hidden advisers.

In future, we should be pleased to find we have erred in this estimation, and that unity will emerge between all Communist forces in Russia, but we now accept the estimations of Andreeva on this score, and fully comprehend and support their call for "all patriotic forces, democrats and people of good will to create an All Russia Anti-Fascist Front, ... to turn the country into the path of peace, democracy and a truly socialist future for the working class."

The illegal pseudo-elections have advanced the cause of T.N.C. reaction on a world-wide scale, presenting all people with a growing threat of fascist dangers. It is time for all citizens to think of what each of us can do to repel once again the monopoly capitalists threat of fascism to the Russian and former Soviet people, as well as to the world at large.
