INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY - MARCH 8TH

This year marks the 21st Annual International Women's Day in Toronto, but for the women in the rest of the world, this has been a date celebrated since long, long ago – women have come a long way ...

Let's take a brief look at our history – it was in March 1907 when a long procession of African-American and Jewish women garment workers took to the streets demanding improved working conditions, decent wages, a ten-hour day and the recognition of equal rights for women; however, when the march reached the upper class districts of New York, they were trampled and dispersed by the police. Many women were arrested.

Following March 8th, 1908, thirty thousand women workers in the needle trades again demonstrated – this time, for the right to vote, an end to child labour and sweatshops; they were also attacked by the police. In 1910, Clara Zetkin, a German socialist leader and a vehement fighter against imperialism and war proposed at a meeting of the second international that March 8th be observed each year as International Women's Day to give homage to these women.

More than a hundred years ago, Clara Zetkin began to work out many of the central concepts associated with the Marxist analysis of women's oppression, concepts which are no less relevant today than they were during her era. Along with Frederick Engels and August Bebel, she emerge as a pioneering theorist of women's status in capitalist society and a strategist who illuminated the way

toward a social order delivered from the effects of institutionalized oppression of women and male supremacist ideology.

Zetkin's first major analysis of the condition of women in capitalist society was presented in a speech she delivered in 1889 at the Paris International Workers' Congress:

... the chief task of the working women's movement is to fight for economic and social equality, and not only formal equality, for women. The chief thing is to get women to take part in socially productive labour, to liberate them from domestic slavery, to free them from their stupefying and humiliating subjugation to the eternal drudgery of the kitchen and the nursery ...

Part of the legacy Clara Zetkin left us is the strong belief that women are an essential force for change, women must learn to become activists on some level, in some way. It is only through struggle that we can fight the neo-Liberal agenda that this blood sucking capitalism tries to impose on us with its unjust economic policies under its inhumane system of oppression the time is right for action. We are at a stage, worldwide, when women's rights could leap into the future or be thrust back into a dark age. Women are and could be a powerful force for change. The question is: Can women hold on to the principles of genuine solidarity among our gender? These are times of great challenges and to face them, women need a lot more international feminist solidarity and consciousness than we have seen so far. There are urgent things to do - like denouncing the forced sterilization of East Timorese women, the continuous attacks on the Kurdish people's culture and survival, the assassinations and forced disappearances of women and children in Colombia we must also make our voices heard in denouncing the M.A.I. (Multilateral Agreement on Investment). This is yet another attack on people's livelihood. We must link the issues, we must learn from the women in the Third World, for they have a tremendous capacity to resist and it is they who are showing us the way forward.

THE FUTURE OF WOMEN

We are the patient revolutionaries Marching through long days and nights of time and space.

We are patient because we cannot wait,

we smile because we shake with rage, we march because we wish to stroll through beautiful gardens.

Whoever said it would be easy? And who said it cannot be done? They are both wrong. For it is hard, and it can be done.

We are patient revolutionaries – patient because it is not easy, revolutionaries because it can be done. See the vast and limitless power of our class!

See the unimaginable strength in women!

See the dream and fight for it!

Do not believe in those who say it will come easy and never believe those who say it cannot be done.

OBITUARY

STATEMENT FROM THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE OF WORKERS WORLD PARTY

It is with great sadness and a deep sense of loss that we announce that Sam Marcy, the founder and chairperson of Workers World Party, has died. The cause of death was a sudden, massive heart attack early in the morning of February 1, 1998.

Marcy, 86, had been politically active for over 70 years. His writings and struggle initiatives were known and admired by revolutionary and working class fighters and activists throughout the world.

Marcy, along with his partner Dorothy Ballan and a handful of other comrades, founded Workers World Party in 1959. During the nearly forty years that he led the Party, Marcy dealt with and clarified all the most important political issues of the day, writing regularly in the Party newspaper, Workers World, until two years before his death.



theoretical Marcy's major apply contribution was to and Marxism revolutionary Leninism to an understanding of the class war on a global scale. His analysis of the irreconcilability of the conflict between the imperialist bourgeoisie on the one hand and the progressive camp of the socialist countries and national liberation movements on the other has stood the test of time. He promoted the militant defense of all socialist against imperialist countries intervention and internal counterrevolution while maintaining a world view that was uniquely independent and consistently revolutionary.

His book "Perestroika: A Marxist Critique" (1990) closely analyzed the bourgeois trends in the USSR under the Gorbachev leadership. Marcy prepared Workers World Party and his readers all over the world for the catastrophic events that eventually became a full-scale counterrevolution there. His ability to look facts in the face and apply the analytical tools of Marxism to understanding setbacks in the class struggle was a powerful antidote to bourgeois pessimism.


"Comrade Sam" led an exemplary revolutionary life. Oppression, exploitation and a society in the throes of revolutionary change were all part of his earliest memories. He first tried his hand at socialist organizing as a teenager in Coney Island, where he grew up in a community of poor Russian Jewish immigrants. Although he finished law school and passed the bar, he never went into private practice but instead, used his legal skills as a union organizer and strategist in the 1930s and 1940s.

Comrade Sam Marcy, we will miss you. But we will miss you in the right way. Will we mourn? Because we are human beings, we cannot do otherwise. But because we are also revolutionary fighters, we will organize new battles while we mourn. This is in the noblest tradition of the working class. This, in turn, is the very essence of what we have learned from you.

We wish these international forums success in their quest for understanding and unity. Unity must be based on the teachings of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin!









From: Wales, GREAT BRITAIN

Dear Friends:

I am responding to your appeal in, unfortunately, a very modest way for I have been on a pension for so long and I have such a lot of other commitments. However, journal is absolutely invaluable, having direct contacts with the former Soviet Union - the latter being of such crucial importance if humanity is not to perish in bloody barbarism (which is more than likely unless the international working class fights back). So immediately, I enclose \$20 US to cover my subscription for next year (I believe it becomes due towards the end of this year) and £20 to the fighting fund.

While I am putting pen to paper, I wondered if you received my article on the Banking system and my points about Britain's future in

the EEC/EC/EU (my letter March 11th this year refers)?

There has been a sequel to this since I wrote in that we now have a Socialist government in France and a Labour government here (with a resounding majority). Now, if one talks to a French Socialist he/she will know what Socialism means (public ownership of the means of production and exchange) and will believe it is possible to gradually replace Capitalism with Socialism. If one talks to a Social Democrat/ Labour party person, she/he will have only a vague idea as to how Capitalism works and will "fairly" judge public/private ownership in a "pragmatic" way. However, in both cases, they will act as lackeys of big business and finance capital.

The French got a Socialist government supported by the Communists committed to tackling unemployment and boosting the social services. They expanded the economy - not in a Socialist way but by using Keynesian economics. It wasn't long before there was a run on the franc, they had breached EEC regulations, and the defence of the franc became all-important. The Communists left the government and they were kicked out at the next election to be replaced by a government more palatable to big business.

The main reason for dissatisfaction here was the attack on the social services during the 18 years of Tory government. First, they blamed Thatcher (who was ousted by the pro-EEC element in the Tory party representing finance-capital who wanted the Maastricht provisions) then sleaze in the Tory party. But the real reason was never mentioned by anyone – the drift to EC/Single Market/Hard Currency, and finally, EU. Britain had already had its industrial guts torn out of it since

joining the EEC in 1972 when the government was forced to shed its links with the Commonwealth and lost control over agriculture, fisheries, iron, coal and steel, "harmonisation" (invariably against the interests of Britain) and a large amount of taxation (from progressive to regressive). The other side of the coin however was a free hand for Britain finance to invest in the EEC. The ultimate aim is an overall government appointed constituent states to meet in Brussels (where the Secretariat is) with periodic meetings of heads of state at the capitals of the various states. But the real powerhouse will be the European Central Bank at Frankfurt (dominated by the Bundesbank) and this to be achieved by 1999. Now, they mean to achieve this which means that the last meaningful elections have already taken place in France and Britain.

The collapse of British industry came about largely because of the artificially high level of the £ within the ERM (Exchange Rate Mechanism ot the EEC). When it collapsed (from DM 2.95 to DM 2.20) industry immediately began to pick up and the Tories claimed credit for this. But their true intentions were shown the day after the collapse of the £ forced it from the ERM when the government ratified the Maastricht Treaty. The first stage of the reckoning came in the budget of 1994 when the government cut public (not private) borrowing by £10,000 million and increased taxation (mainly regressive) by no less than £17,000 millions. The result: crumbling schools, hospitals, the end of low-cost housing and a rapid increase in homelessness, filthy towns and cities and all the rest. But this is only half of it. The present government between now and 1999 is committed to further increases in taxation (and they

decided in the manifesto they wouldn't tax the rich) of another £18,000 millions and reduction to zero of public borrowing. It must therefore repudiate the Maastricht Treaty to carry out its election promises. However, not only has it not done so, it is committed to the Treaty; so is the Labour Party, so is the TUC. The first major act of the government was to free the Bank of England from government control, and in less than three months, the Bank has increased interest rates three times (with more to come) plus "shadowing the mark", so that now the £ has reached the target of 3 Deutschemarks, i.e., it is ready to enter EMU prior to a single currency and the Bank of England is going through the preparations for the single currency. So production is already winding down and unemployment will accelerate very shortly.

A little anecdote about the Bank of England. When the Nazis invaded Czechoslovakia, they lost no time in grabbing the Central Bank to get their hands on the gold and deposits. But the Czech government had anticipated this and transferred the contents to the Bank of International Settlements in Basle, Switzerland. Although Germany was a member of it, it was an international bank presided over by the benign Sir Montagu Norman – the governor of the Bank of England, who happened to be a Jew. Had they understood class parameters, they would have thought differently. Montagu Norman handed the loot over to the Nazis within hours of its request from the Nazis. Your editorial "Who Was to Blame" in this month's journal hit the nail on its head.

Denis Healey – a former Chancellor of the Exchequer in the last Labour government – said there would be riots in the streets if the Maastricht Treaty was implemented. Will it happen? Well, the French working class is very restive (the government has obtained a form of words from the EC but I believe they are only cosmetic). The German working class is beginning to wake up. But the British workers slumber on – and 1999 is not far away.

On another matter, I was astonished to read that contribution from Postmark Praha. They read Northstar Compass but clearly they have not understood what you have been saying from the earliest days about the CPRF.


Sixty seven coal miners were killed when an explosion of methane gas ignited in the Kuzbass mine, but no one turned away from his swill. Miners at the Vokrutinsky basin did not call a strike or at the Donetsk or Moscow basin in solidarity with the dead comrades, did not demand the resignation of the Coal Minister or the President (why not?). The situation and the unsafe working conditions in their mines are as bad

as it was in the Kuzbass region!

In Siberia, on the roofs of apartments in Irkutsk, there landed a tragic heavy military transport aeroplane. Hundreds of lives were snuffed out (although this fact is not publicized). But what do we see and hear over the TV and radio? ... the costs in damage in millions of dollars, but no one asked the cardinal question: WHO RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATHS OF THE PEOPLE? Who is going to be responsible that in the mines where elementary safety is overlooked for the sake of profit? Who will ask as to why military planes are unsafe and pilots are forced to fly long hours, holding on to 2-3 jobs in order to feed their families ... even if they know that the safety is at stake?

POLITICAL TWINS

Not too long ago, Ukraine was visited by the "father" of today's social-democracy, Alexander Yakovlev (former Ambassador to Canada and the architect of "perestroika" – Editors), former member of CPSU Politbureau and the Secretary of CC in charge of ideology. Mr. Yakovlev met another secretary of former

THE AWAKENING IS APPROACHING!

Am sending materials and photographs from the newspapers "Communist" and "Village News" and trying to reach those people who are so bent on proclaiming the tremendous achievements of our "independent" Ukraine and the "democratic" (read: present totalitarian) regime. Yes, be glad, you gentlemen! Ukraine is "flowering"! (or is it dying?!) Unfortunately, the present leaders of the "new order" in "sovereign" Ukraine, do not understand what is really happening in our country ... what is happening with the young generation? The tactic is now to bring this problem to a minimum. The "results" are "great" according to the present regime plans. Just about 5 years ago, Ukraine had a population of 50 million people. It looks that the work is cut-out for the president and his cronies. The Club of Rome is recommending that the maximum population for Ukraine should be 10-15 million people. But with the present policy of market economy, the present government might yet achieve this genocide.

Below, we publish facts from newspaper "Tovarish" of last year.

In 9 months in 1997, the population of Ukraine dropped by 300,000 people. In the last 5 years, the population dropped by over 1.5 million people. The main staple of food for the majority of people is potatoes and bread.

There are now over 589,200 people fully unemployed, plus hundreds of thousands that are partly employed and hundreds of thousands that did not receive their pay for over 6 months.

Until that "goal" is reached, the present regime is doing its job through hunger. Even though the miners of the region went on strikes and hunger strikes, but for what? Wasn't it they that helped to dismantle socialism in Ukraine ... they helped to dismantle the Land of the Soviets! And now, it looks as if they are not very happy with the accomplishments of "privatization"! As many miners put it: "We are unable to work any longer. We have not the strength to go on ... our tools are falling out of our hands ..." -("Communist" #49, 194, December 1997).

Many citizens of Ukraine cannot bear up to this "independent" Ukraine, and are committing suicide. In the last 6 years, there were 60,000 suicides, in this number, there were 16,000 women. Just compare, my dear readers, the following fact – in 10 years of civil war in Afghanistan, the whole of USSR lost 14,000 people. Yes, the "reforms" are going full speed ahead – over all bodies of its citizens.

"In Ukraine at the present time, there are 100,000 to 250,000 children who have no home and living on the streets ... This was reported by the head of governmental body UNA O. Vitovich ..." (Newspaper "Tovarish", #50, 1997.

It is true, according to the present regime, that children somehow are spoiling the plans of bringing the population down as promoted by the Club of Rome.

Could such a thing have happened under Soviet rule? According to the Militia, there are over 50,000 underage children on their lists who committed crimes. More than 1,000 underage children are now narcotic users daily. More than 80% of the underage children that were held by the militia were jailed for stealing food to eat or clothes to wear! Does this not say anything to you? What does this say to you, "friends" of the present Ukrainian regime? The scientists compiled a list of the statistics - in the whole of Ukraine, there are 13 million people in the present environment who are border cases of falling apart of families due to the present hardships. There are now 135,000 invalids in Ukraine – these are children! More than 30% of them shall not reach the age of 18 years. (Village Life 6, XIII, 1997).

Yes, keep on being happy, gentlemen "democrats"! The people are still slumbering ... Awakening is approaching!

PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS IN UKRAINE

THE COMMUNIST ANALYSIS OF THE SITUATION

On the 29th of March, 1998, the elections to Ukrainian parliament will take place. I would like to describe to the readers of "Northstar Compass" the situation in the 2nd largest republic of the former USSR – both in general and concerning

the left-wing movement (and communist especially) in particular.

The 7 years of capitalist restoration has turned simply into a catastrophe for the people of Ukraine. After the getting of the socalled "independence" (bourgeoisnationalistic counter-revolution) Ukraine (which was one of the most developed and rich republics of the USSR) has simply degenerated to the level of the Third World countries. The country's GDP has dropped more than 60%. The industry, agriculture are in a great depression. People do not get their wages and salaries in time, and they may have no wages for a period of over 6 months and even longer. All the high-technology sectors of economy are simply destroyed (due to the plans of IMF on the de-industrialization of the country). The beggars hide simply in the over-crowded underground stations. Unemployment, which was earlier an unknown phenomenon in the USSR, is now, by the official level, something like 2-3%, but that is because people who lost their jobs do not register themselves on the

labour exchange, so if we will take all these people into account, the real level of unemployment will become 30-40%. The inflation since 1991 shot up more than 15,000%. So this is, in brief, the economic situation in Ukraine.

What must the Ukrainian communists do in this situation? Firstly, if one calls him (or her) self a communist or Marxist, he (she) must have a clear understanding of tactics of the party calling itself "communist" in the elections to the BOURGEOIS parliament. Reading the works of Marx, Engels and Lenin, we first of all must understand quite well that it is simply impossible to create socialism using the bourgeois parliament. There must be no illusions! So then, maybe it is good simply to boycott the elections to the bourgeois parliament? No! Communists must use bourgeois parliament as a means, as a tribune on propaganda and popularization of socialist ideals, and the aims of this or that communist party. This is a very important question. Because we all know that many communist parties, especially in Western Europe, were captivated with parliament games and simply forgot about the one and the only path to socialism the revolutionary one. The so-called "Eurocommunism" has simply buried those communist parties! But it is also not correct to boycott parliamentary elections if there is no revolutionary situation in the country. The tactics of boycott is correct if there is revolutionary situation and participation in the bourgeois elections is betrayal of the revolution

If one will analyze the programmes of two main left-wing parties of Ukraine, the Socialist Party of Ukraine (SPU) and the Communist Party of Ukraine (CPU), I must say that none of these parties give us correct understanding of

this problem.

The programme of the SPU is pure liberalism. There are no words even about the wish of this party to construct socialism in Ukraine. The programme is full of abstract and obscure phrases like "Let's create the better life for Ukraine", "All together to the better life". Certainly there are no calls for constructing planned economy. There is the so-called "mixed economy" - which is capitalism in other words. It also says that "we'll lead Ukraine into European and International institutions". What does this mean? Does it mean that SPU will lead Ukraine into International BOURGEOIS institutions as a colonial country? Looking after the policy of this party during last years and reading the programme of this party, I may only come to the conclusion that SPU is a typical social-democratic party.

As for the Communist Party of Ukraine, I must also say that both the policy of this party and pre-election programme opportunistic. The programme of this party is in most items identical with the programme of CPRF (Communist Party of Russian Federation) in December 1995 elections to the Duma. The revolutionary path to socialism is simply excluded. The private sector is represented in the economy. The problem of reconstruction of the Soviet Union is described in a quite misty way.

Unfortunately, here in Ukraine, we have no party or block of parties which can be called really communist, just like "Communists – Workers Russia – For the Soviet Union" as it is in Russia.

On my accounts, the CPU will take approximately 30 or more percent on the elections, but that will not be the victory of the real socialist forces. Because this party

is parliamentarized, is sick with the so-called "parliamentary cretinism".

Some members of this party had voted for the new reactionary bourgeois constitution in June 1996, and some leaders of this party simply struggle with the labour movement. The real communists cannot support this party.

Unfortunately, the AUCPB will boycott the elections (as well as in Russia) – for no good reason!

I think that it is necessary to create a real communist party in Ukraine, which will use the parliamentary means of struggle in the correct Marxist-Leninist way.

In the letter accompanying this article, Peter states the following:

"Another problem we have in Ukraine is growing fascism. The Ukrainian fascist organization, called UNA-UNSO, is using demagogic populism and social slogans in which to raise its popularity, playing on the discontent of the majority of people of Ukraine in the present situation.

WELFARE REFORM

Nobody who has read my book, Peace and the Cold War (Part One) Labour in Government. 1945-51, can have failed to see the similarity between the first majority Labour government in Britain, which lost support and fell because it went back on its promises to redistribute wealth in favour of the working class, and the present Labour government which has now launched a plan to save £3.2 billion at the expense of the poorer sections of the community.

According to figures provided by the House of Commons Library to the <u>Guardian</u> newspaper and published in that journal on the 5th January, this grand total is to be

made up as follows: from the disabled by substituting incapacity benefit (at a lower rate) for invalidity benefit, a saving of £2,510 million; by reducing benefits to lone parents, a saving of £215 million; by cuts in unemployment benefits, a saving of £240 million; by limiting claims of war pensioners, a saving of £5 million; and by loan recovery from the destitute, a further saving of £3 million.

It is true that the government has had to find an extra £600 million for claimants in various categories because it has overshot its inflation targets, another £400 million for winter fuel payments to pensioners, and a further £200 million for housing and council tax benefits, but it still leaves the government with a net saving of two billion pounds at the expense of the poorest of the poor.

According to the right-wing institute of Economic Affairs, another two million people could fall into the poverty trap in the next five years if the link between social security benefits and average incomes, broken by the late Tory government, is not restored.

At a recent meeting of the Cabinet, at which Tony Blair outlined his plans for a major reform of the welfare system, ministers were encouraged to go out and

evangelise. But up to the 16th January, only the Defence Secretary, George Robertson, had planned to speak in public at the following week-end; and he cancelled the engagement after ordering HMS Invincible to sail for the Gulf.

As with the earlier Labour government of 1945-51, there is to be no saving by imposing cuts in military expenditure nor yet any increase in revenue by restoring the upper levels of income tax cancelled by Margaret Thatcher, much to the relief of the fat cats of finance and industry who grow richer and more numerous by the day.

On the 19th January, an editorial in the New Worker stated: "The capitalists are driven to these policies by the deepening crisis of the capitalist system – now openly on show in the bleeding, gaping wounds that are so obvious in the so-called 'tiger economies' of Asia. Capitalists everywhere are struggling against what Marx described as 'the tendency of the rate of profit to fall'. This is inherent in the system and is always addressed by stepping up attacks on labour."

There is, of course, a limit to the degradation that the poor are prepared to suffer. On the 9th January, the New Worker reported a demonstration by members of the Disabled People's Direct Action Network, many in wheelchairs, which focused public attention on the proposed cuts. According to the New Worker report, "the demonstrators made liberal use of red paint to draw attention to their message and there were twelve arrests."

A few days later, on the day before HMS Invincible sailed for the Gulf to threaten Saddam Hussein with the bombardment of Baghdad, a deputation of disabled ex-soldiers who had fought in the earlier military engagement in the Gulf

arrived at the Mirdstry of Defence and returned the medals they had won.

RALLY AND MARCH TO THE WHITE HOUSE TO DEMAND FREEDOM FOR POLITICAL PRISONERS

There are over 150 political prisoners in US jails. They are in jail because they are committed to taking action for social justice. They are Black, Puerto Rican, Native American and progressive white people who have dedicated their lives to fighting against racism, colonialism and exploitation. Some of them have been in jail for over 26 years. This makes them some of the longest held political prisoners in the world.

Throughout history, whenever the dispossessed have risen up, they

have come under attack. They are assassinated, imprisoned, and harassed. The last few decades in this country have been no exception.

Many of the political prisoners are locked up as a result of the FBI's Counter Intelligence Program (CoIntelPro). During the 1960's and 70's, the FBI developed CoIntelPro to attack, frame, assassinate, and imprison participants and leaders of the Black Panther Party, the American Indian Movement and other powerful social movements. Others have received excessively long sentences because of the political nature of their actions.


The US government denies that there are political prisoners in this country. But examining the cases of the political prisoners shows that in fact, their imprisonment and extremely long sentences are due to their political beliefs and actions. The government has tried to delegitimize these prisoners and their movements by treating them as criminals, refusing to let them make a political defense at their trials and singling them out for harassment and intimidation once they are imprisoned.

For example, Geronimo ji jaga Pratt, a former member of the Black Panther Party, was framed and imprisoned for a murder he did not commit for 27 years. He was finally released from prison in California on June 10, 1997. The FBI tried to hide evidence that he was at a meeting in Oakland, California at the time of the murder, far from Santa Monica where the murder occurred. His release was obtained due to intense public outcry and the work of his legal team.

Below are examples of just a few of the political prisoners here in the US.

SOME OF THE POLITICAL PRISONERS HELD IN UNITED STATES PRISONS

- LEONARD PELTIER is a Lakota Indian and a member of the American Indian Movement (AIM). During the 1970's, he worked to end oppressive conditions for Native Americans. In 1975, FBI agents trespassed on an AIM member's property in Wounded Knee, South Dakota. There was a firefight and two FBI agents were killed. Leonard Peltier became the scapegoat despite the lack of concrete evidence implicating him. He was found guilty of murder. He is serving two consecutive life terms.
- MUMIA ABU-JAMA is a former Black Panther Party member and an award-winning journalist in Philadelphia who spoke out against police brutality. In 1981, he stopped to help his brother who was being beaten by the police. A cop was killed and Mumia shot. Mumia was charged with his murder. The trial was a farce: a lawyer with no criminal experience represented Mumia and a racist judge prevented the defense from obtaining evidence favorable to Mumia. Mumia is now on death row in Pennsylvania.
- CARMEN VALENTIN is a Puerto Rican woman who has

committed her life to fight for the Independence of Puerto Rico. She was a high school teacher and community activist in Chicago. In 1980, she and 10 other Puerto Rican independence fighters were arrested and charged with seditious conspiracy, conspiring to free their country through the use of force. As an anti-colonial fighter, she refused to recognize the jurisdiction of US courts. She was sentenced to 98 years and is in prison in California, far from her home.

• LINDA EVANS - is a white woman who has been active since the 1960's in anti-racist movements, women's and lesbian liberation and opposing the role of the US government in the imperial domination of other nations. She also worked to support Political Prisoners who had been locked up for their activities in connection with movements she was supporting. She was arrested in 1985. She was charged with harboring a fugitive and buying four guns with a false name. For this, she was sentenced to a total of 40 years.

WHY A MARCH ON D.C.?

Despite national and international calls to release all political prisoners held in US prisons, the US government is determined to keep them locked up. We are just as determined to work until they are free. Their unjust and disproportionate sentences have already kept them away from their family, friends and community for too long. Their commitment to struggle for a better world encourages us to work for their release. Jericho '98 was formed because we believe in the power of people working together to create change. As the biblical story of Jericho shows, when we raise our voices collectively, we can cause walls to come tumbling down

CZECH SOCIAL DEMOCRATS BACK RIGHT WING

Postmark Prague reports that Milos Zeman leader of the Social Democrats, now the largest party in parliament justified his parties rescue of the new right wing caretaker government of Josef Tosovsky from an impending vote of no confidence on January 28 by citing his concern for political and economic stability. However, it was president Havel's threat to postpone elections which motivated the support since the Social Democrats now lead the former governing party (O.D.S.) by 14% in the latest opinion polls and are hence anxious to go to the polls remarked P.P. Tosovsky heads a caretaker administration which was appointed by president Havel on January 2, 1998 following the resignation of Klause's right-wing coalition government on November 30, 1997. The resignation was made necessary by the bursting of the countries Post Communist Economic bubble and the parties' financial mismanagement and corruption. The



new administration while following most of the policies of its predecessor as deregulation, such and privatization has retained seven veterans of the previously discredited Klause coalition. President Havel cut his Canary Island vacation short to be introduced to the 16 new caretaker ministers of this government. Meanwhile, the economic melt down continues with the declining value of the Czech currency and savage increases in rents and prices reports Postmark Prague (P.P.). Tosovsky like his predecessor is pushing for early NATO membership without a referendum. Both the new prime minister and Havel are determined to hold on to power as long as possible states P.P. Havel himself has encountered difficulties in his bid for re-election as president of the republic.

In spite of the fact that both challengers for the presidency were denied the opportunity to address the joint session of parliament Havel failed to receive a simple majority on the first ballot cast by the joint session. He therefore, as mandated by the constitution, was forced to go to a second ballot in which he was the only candidate. His Communist opponent Stanislav Fisher received 31 votes on the first ballot that was seven more than the parties' combined strength in both houses of parliament. Havel won on the second ballot by just one vote since Miroslav Sladek of the far right Republican Party had been imprisoned for inciting hatred against Germans and so was prevented from voting against the incumbent. Subsequent to Sladek's acquittal on the above charges, his supporters are challenging this. It will be interesting to see how the Constitutional Court will rule on this, remarks P.P.

THE DEMONIZATION OF IRAQ

Why is Iraq being demonized in our press and accused of harbouring weapons of mass destruction which pose a threat to world peace and security? Citizens Concerned About Free Trade (CCAFT) in their press release of February 4, 1998 quote Ramsey Clark, former U.S. Attorney General, as saying that "Iraq is incapable of war". Clark further charges that "Iraq's military weapons have been destroyed in highly publicized events broadcast around the world". This has left Iraq virtually defenceless against any attack by a superpower like the U.S. Why then, one might ask, is there so much concern about this Third World country of 20 million inhabitants whose land mass is equivalent to the province of Saskatchewan?; a country in which, after seven years of sanctions, one million Iraqis have died a slow death of starvation (two-thirds of them children) the statement continues. After all, the last war with Iraq in 1991 was referred to by U.S. officials as a turkey shoot and aroused opposition and horror around the world. The answer to this question can be partly found in what David Orchard is quoted as saying in the same release.

Orchard charges that "today's events are the latest in a long, brutal and sordid history of British and U.S. involvement in the Middle East which dates back to Britain's carving up of Kuwait out of Iraq in 1899 in order to take possession of its oil reserves". The U.S., Orchard goes on to say, wants complete control of Iraq's oil, something Saddam Hussein has refused to do when he

resisted American demands that he privatize the oil industry. This is why the U.S. will not lift its sanctions against Iraq, no matter what Iraq does as confirmed by the U.S. ambassador to the U.N. Bill Richardson when he said, "Iraq has no possibility of seeing sanctions lifted".

The CCAFT release charges that Iraq is no more of a "threat" to the U.S. than Cuba. One U.S. nuclear submarine could obliterate both countries. The crippling of Iraq is to prevent Saddam Hussein from becoming a rallying point for Arab nationalism, in the same way as the 37 year U.S. embargo against Cuba and the repeated attempts to assassinate its leaders are to prevent a rallying point and an alternative model for Latin America.

This press release, like many others which are given short shrift

in our mass media, show the extent to which international capital primarily American will go to satisfy its uncontrolled greed. Without the limiting affects of the USSR it is a system gone wild subjecting the global population to untold hardship and ecological devastation.


making schemes to privateers, have succeeded in placing upon American working class privatized drug costs guaranteed to maximize profits, and minimize health needs for everyone except the rich.


PERESTROIKA: THE COMPLETE COLLAPSE OF REVISIONISM



- 5. Pensioners and unemployed rummage through garbage containers to find the promised "happy life".
- 6. You can see thousands of beggars on the streets of Ukraine.

Below, we reproduce the leaflet called "SOCIAL NATIONALIST" and also the new emblem of this organization – based on the design of the swastika. What did this leaflet that was pasted all over Western Ukraine say?:



"We are social-nationalists and we look at the world through different eyes ... we are all young, energetic and capable ... we are against the old communistic system and against the new democratic system.

German fascists also could not tolerate communists and democrats – and both of these elements were put away into concentration camps ..."

Need we say anything else, dear readers? That is why the 5th Conference idea of establishing an "International Council" is a vehicle that should be in the vanguard to help our Soviet comrades to defeat approaching fascism and thus help them and ourselves from this danger!

Below, we publish a letter from Felix Gorelik, who resided in Lugansk, Ukraine and who was on our Editorial Board. Readers were very interested in the many articles that Felix wrote for Northstar Compass. Now, he is living in Germany and here is what he wrote to NSC readers – Editors.

Unfortunately, daily life and the situation in present Ukraine has forced me to seek my life abroad. Because of my poor eyesight, I had to retire as a teacher and go on pension. The pension here is only \$35 per month which is sometimes not enough to pay for your apartment and bread. The present Kuchma regime has cut the pension down 3 times ... the standard of living has gone down by more than 9 times from the previous standard, besides you have to pay your medicine, doctors, hospital, etc.

The main reason is that I could not tolerate any more the present robber regime!

Even though I'm abroad in this so-called capitalist "heaven", I never deserted my Communist dedication. I feel that the only basis for optimism now in former Soviet Union is on the present Russian Army. In 1997, in the Russian Army, there were over 500 officers who committed suicide, not receiving their pay for months on end, nothing to help feed their families.

The movement to save the Russian Army is headed by General

Rokhlyn – the most effective opposition to Yeltsin. If the officers start to organize, the working class shall support them!

I could not come to your Conference, but I wish all of you success.


We would like to point out that


