UNPRECEDENTED PROSPERITY DIALECTICALS IN RUSSIA AND OIL AT \$40 A BARRELL (By Ana Lucia Gelabert)

If two entities A and B each has \$10, and A robs B of its \$10, then B sees sudden poverty while A enjoys "unprecedented prosperity", robbing B.

In 1982, comparatively speaking, the U.S. had \$20 for each \$10 the USSR had: richer and more advanced technologically, especially as regards production of household and consumer products. But clearly the USSR was also a world superpower, even if comparatively weaker and less affluent than the USA.

From 1980 to about 1993, with the underlying strategic goal of bankrupting the USSR, which they calculated would be compelled to follow suit, the Reagan and then Bush administration engaged in an unprecedented arms buildup, "Star Wars" and all that, huge even by Cold War Standards, and to finance it had to increase the U.S. national debt from

\$908 billion in 1982, to \$4412 billion in 1993, in just 12 years, 385% higher than in the previous 204. Cutting taxes to big corporations and the even after deducting the costs of very rich helped a bit to build the deficits, while cutting social services to the working class and poor reduced them a bit, but no doubt the bulk of the massive fiscal deficits was due to the massive weapons program.

The Reaganomics arms buildup should have bankrupted the USSR but did not, because contrary to calculations, the USSR did not follow suit. Instead, going overboard, with Gorbachev, with one weapons reduction proposal after another. All rejected. ... In the end the USSR collapsed, partly due to internal contradictions [and partly due to the Reagan-Bush military build-up -Editors.] and by the demoralization after decades of revisionist leaderships.
