

NEWS DIGEST COMMENT

HOW U.S. FEDERAL RESERVE SHIPS MONEY ... TO MOSCOW FOR ... GUESS WHO????

Robert I. Friedman's lengthy expose in the January 22nd edition of "super-slick" magazine "NEW YORK" should serve as the final antidote for remaining naive souls who consider the enforced "collapse" of the Soviet Union a move toward an era of peace, progress, stability, security ... not to mention "freedom and democracy". Titled "The Money Plane", with front page and elaborate photos, it runs to ten pages, is instructive on the international rise of the Russian Mafia ... and is bone chilling. But in fact, more questions are being raised than answered.

The continuing world dominance of U.S. nuclear AND conventional arms; the eastward push of the NATO military presence to swallow holus-bolus all of eastern Europe and camp on the borders of the former USSR is enough to frighten even the most sanguine. But another ghoulist twist is added by Friedman's article. In part, he writes:


"Five nights a week, at least \$100 million in crisp new \$100.00 bills is flown non-stop from JFK (the N.Y. main airport – RS) to Moscow where it is USED TO FINANCE THE RUSSIAN MOB'S GROWING INTERNATIONAL CRIME

SYNDICATE. State and (U.S.) Federal officials believe it IS PART OF A MULTI-BILLION DOLLAR MONEY LAUNDERING OPERATION. THE REPUBLIC NATIONAL BANK AND THE U.S. FEDERAL RESERVE PREFER NOT TO THINK SO ..." (emphasis added).

Whatever these institutions think, it is absolutely clear that the U.S. government and its various official law enforcement agencies have to be "IN THE KNOW", all the way to the top. If, as Friedman says, the nightly cash shipment "is for the mob", it doesn't require a Yale law school degree to see that such are more than "a little bit 'illegal' ... just a mite outside the law" ... to say the least.

But the "law enforcement" agencies sit on their hands IN BOTH WASHINGTON AND MOSCOW, watching the "cash flow" eastward. From this, it can be assumed THAT BOTH GOVERNMENTS ARE HAND-TO-HAND IN CAHOOTS WITH THE MOBSTERS! Maybe "Alice in Wonderland" wouldn't believe that, but others, not so naive, would.

On another tack, according to the front page centre photo and story of the February 8th, London, U.K. based newspaper "European", none other than the formerly outlawed Chechen "bandit" Dudayev, is "elevated to respectability" as the "Chechen Rebel Leader". Headlined "Dudayev Accuses West of Funding Russia's War", the story has him threatening "The West" if they don't stop it. For anyone familiar with the tragedies and farces of the four year Yeltsin regime ever since he and "Commander" Bill Clinton embraced (literally) in Vancouver, the idea of "U.S. funding of the Yeltsin war on Chechnya" would hardly be a major surprise. And soldiers, as well as miners, need to



be paid.

Since 1990 (or earlier during the Gorbachev days of planned and deliberate "error-stroika") the central, all embracing aim of the G-7 TNC crowd has been propping up and supporting in whatever ways necessary, the corrupt, sodden, crime-ridden regime that was installed by gunfire and U.S. dollars over the remains of the former Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. TNC spokesmen Clinton, Kohl, Major (and Thatcher), Mitterand (now Chirac), Mulroney (now Chretien) and whoever was sent by Italy and Japan to represent them between scandals, have never wavered from that aim. That still persists today, even more vociferously and tenaciously in light of the resurgence of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation and the coming Presidential elections in June, this year.

Viewed from that perspective, Delta Airlines' nightly flights with the "nice crisp, unused \$100.00 bills" directly from the U.S. Treasure Reserve to bankroll Yeltsin's and the oil barons' war in Chechnya is not only plausible, but very probable. The Russian people recall too vividly the Yeltsin-Grachev shoot-out and blood bath of October 1993 vintage, not to suspect this illicit and dangerous connection.

They will remember how Clinton backed the Yeltsin-Grachev blood spilling in the destruction of the Supreme Soviets, the wanton murder of thousands and the jailing of the leaders of the Supreme Soviet. Why would Clinton and the Federal Reserve bankroll this outrageous war? For the same precise reasons they lent support to the Moscow based gangsters and butchers of 1993 ... to "keep Russia safe for TNC plunder"!!!

MONOPOLY SPAWNS **GANGSTERS AND MURDERERS** ...

It is no secret that monopoly capitalism spawns and maintains crime, gangsterism and corruption whenever it holds sway. Relations

between U.S. governments at every level, monopoly and organized crime are very relevant, going back to the earliest development of U.S. Imperialism and today's TNC's. A study of the relationship of U.S. Texas oilman, ex-President George Bush and his C.I.A. henchman, drug lord Noriega of Panama would prove instructive. But don't hold your breath too long for that!

Is there a Russian Mafia, and is it connected to the government and the new, primitive "class" of Russian capitalists? It would be the surprise of the century if that were not true. Two or more years ago, NSC exposed some of these links and connections with the drug trade. It would be even more astonishing if the violent, totally unscrupulous ruling gangsters of Russia were not entrenched, arm-pit deep, in the new, uncontrolled, 1,000 or more Russian banking "adventures" ... or that in the prevailing state of lawlessness, they didn't murder

each other more or less wholesale, and at random, as Friedman reveals.

Finally, why would not international finance capital, whether the U.S. Federal Reserve, Republic Banking, or any other financier get involved in all such "lucrative" businesses and rackets? It has happened before, in India, Africa, Asia, South America, etc., etc., ad infinitum. Such practices are both endemic and systemic in that world of profit grabbing, thievery, corruption and violence.

TO SEEK A RATIONAL SOLUTION ...

Just eighty years ago, the following was written:

"Monopoly has grown out of [colonial] policy. To the numerous 'old' motives of [colonial] policy, finance capital has added the struggle FOR SOURCES OF RAW MATERIALS: FOR THE EXPORT OF CAPITAL: FOR SPHERES OF INFLUENCE: i.e., for good business, concessions, monopolistic profits ... in short, FOR ECONOMIC TERRITORY IN GENERAL ... Monopolies, oligarchy, the struggle for domination, RATHER THAN STRIVING FOR LIBERTY; THE EXPLOITATION OF SMALL OR WEAK NATIONS BY AN EXTREMELY SMALL GROUP OF THE RICHEST AND MOST POWERFUL ..." Read that passage substituting the words "Cold War" for "Colonial" and use the term "Transnational corporations - TNC's" interchangeably with "monopolies" and the current tragic situation of the former Soviets is focused sharply.

In his seminal tract "Imperialism, The Highest Stage Of Capitalism" written in 1916 while in exile, Lenin not only exposed in detail the far reaching Imperialist atrocities against all people everywhere, he advanced the cure ... revolution of the people led by the working class and the eradication of monopoly

capitalism and its political powers. He warned repeatedly of the pervading political, economic, military, ideological and state powers that finance-capital exerted over countries, resources, peoples and nations. He laid particular emphasis on the role of the bondholders and bankers of yesteryear (the actual and linear antecedents of modern day TNC's), globalization, and of course, the eternal, "unchallengeable" posturing of the economic-political status quo. He organized and led the "Bolshevik Revolution" of 1917 and the formation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. The people with the working class at the head, rallied around this new concept of change and development of their lives. The world had never seen the like. For the first time, all value produced by labour was to be held in common, and not expropriated by the monopolists and owners, for private and corporate profit. The wealth produced was to care for all.

For their audacity, challenging the until-then-unbroken rule of the

monopolists, the Soviets experienced a seventy year siege. Economic blockade, wars of interventions, inspired civil war, diplomatic isolation and the massive unprecedented Nazi attack. followed by the 45 year "Cold War", internal sabotage and subversion until the final betrayal in the 1980's and early 1990's all came down on the heads of the Soviet people. Throughout the 70 odd years, the ideological lies, half truths and monstrously misleading propaganda continued without abatement.

The desperate, violent and illegal efforts of the monopolists to overthrow the Socialist state finally met success. What was at stake? First, the Socialist, working class revolution of 1917 removed from the monopolists' grasp one-sixth of the world richest natural resources. They were determined to reclaim and re-establish their "right" to control and super-exploitation.

Secondly, the revolutionary actions of the Soviets in developing a Socialist economy and breaking the stranglehold of the monopolists



(TNC's) had let loose a "virus" of working class and popular dissent throughout the world which developed to its full would conceivably see the end of all monopolist power. That "virus" had to be contained and killed. That is what the 70 year "siege" was also all about. Tragically for the Soviets, and for oppressed and exploited people everywhere, it finally succeeded. Friedman's "Money Plane" is part and parcel of that continuing siege by the monopolists.

It is apparent that internal corruption and the discarding of Lenin's Marxist-Leninist thesis that it was the working class who would lead in "building Socialism" extended into the top ranks of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union. Space does not permit examination of that disgusting process, except to note the role of Gorbachev, Yeltsin and their non-Communist, anti-Marxist anti-working class opportunism, led the way. That, of course, was precisely what the foreign monopolists wanted, and we believe it is not an accident, or a natural process of economic political development.


WHAT NOW ... "MONEY PLANES" FOR THE MONOPOLISTS' LACKEYS ... OR A RETURN TO SOVIET POWER AND EVENTUALLY ... A HIGHER FORM OF SOCIALISM?

As this is written and the preparations for the June Presidential elections advance, with Yeltsin stating that if he should lose, he will "lead in a new Civil War" ... other "straws in the wind" underline the desperation of the G-7 monopolists (TNC's) and in particular, the bankers and bond-holders of 1996. Senior Associate of the Carnegie Endowment, former top economic

adviser to Yeltsin in 1992-93, Anders Aslund, writes (International Herald Tribune, Feb. 1, 1996) "... Yeltsin's tottering presidency boils down to little but excessive violence against the vovulation, extraordinary favoritism and corruption ... [His] electoral strategy makes no sense ... The Communist Party leader, Zyuganov, looks BY FAR THE MOST LIKELY WINNER ... He will need additional support ... BUT MANY ARE EAGER TO ASSIST HIM" ... The Communist Party is not involved in the corrupt big-business interests dominating Yeltsin-Chernomyrdin, he observes (emphasis added). This "former adviser" during the Grachev bombing of the Supreme Soviet, now sounds even a little panic stricken that his, and others (including the C.I.A., World Bank, IMF et al.) work may be thrown in the garbage bin, when the Russian people win by voting for the CPRF, Zyuganov's resurgent Communist Party.

A second very interesting straw (perhaps dirty linen) "blowing in the political winds" is carried in an op-ed, New York Times feature article on February 10th, 1996. Here, we are "treated" to 24 column inches of Henry Kissinger's pal in Moscow, Mikhail Gorbachev: "... there is a real danger that we'll restart the arms race. I wouldn't be surprised if the nuclear-security card was resurrected in the coming elections ..." opines this Social Democratic opportunist who posed for several years as a Marxist-Leninist head of the CPSU and the USSR, only to wind up as a paid-for and kept lackey of the international finance-capital crowd. For years now, he has sat in his sand-box in Moscow as head of the U.S. subsidized "Gorbachev Foundation" ... "a research institute", says the Times.

Given the emerging desperation



of the TNC's to ensure their stranglehold over the Russian people; given the 75 year history of lies, deceit, wars, violence et al., against the Soviet people; and finally, given the re-surgence of the Communist forces of Russia, it would be no surprise to see the drunken, bumbling, but ferociously violent, Yeltsin dumped by his friends of the west. In his place, who else do the banker bondholders of TNC have to try and take over the mantle of "governing"? Only wily, corrupted, and kept Gorbachev seems to fit the bill.

But that plot might not work, and the TNC moguls might be forced to again prop up their "old and failing" betrayer, Yeltsin ... if he doesn't succumb and stagger "off the mortal coil", or, if they can at least give an appearance of sobriety to the bedraggled "statesman of perfidy". In that case, a Gorbachev candidacy might be used as an attempt to split votes away from the Communists, and even possibly send votes toward the other renegade of monopoly affection, fascist Zhirinovsky, and his rightwing lovers of monopoly.

Perhaps in all of this, the U.S. Federal Reserve will be called upon to add a few more sacks of "nice crisp, unused \$100.00 bills" to Republic Banking's daily flights. Who knows? Perhaps "the mob", whether Russian, American, or just plain TNC bondholder-bankers, might even put another flight in the air to finance their various schemes to keep control of the Russian-Soviet people. These are but some of the conundrums the Communists and peoples of the former Soviets will confront in days to come. We wish them good-speed in the days ahead.

But unequivocally, the greatest threat and condundrum for them and the rest of us (indeed, for the entire world) may well be a new round of conflict, interventionist wars fought over the blood sodden land of Russia and the former Soviet Republics and Eastern Europe. It is not a time for relaxation of the highest order of vigilance. Such a war could hardly avoid becoming global in scope!

From: NEW YORK TIMES OP-ED ALMOST ANYONE IS BETTER THAN YELTSIN

"The time has arrived for a fundamental Western reassessment of Boris Yeltsin, because he has abandoned everything that the West appreciated in him. All along, Yeltsin has played very different groups against each other, the worst group in his administration has won a complete victory.

Zyuganov will have to make deals, even with Mr. Yavlinsky who is an anti-communist, but Zyuganov is rumoured to promote Mr. Yavlinsky to the Premiership if he wins."

SOOTHING TONE BY ZYUGANOV AT BUSINESS FORUM

"In Davis, Switzerland, February 4: Plutocrats of the world, you have nothing more to lose if a Communist is elected President, than you do already under the unpredictable Boris Yeltsin.

This was the message by Gennady Zyuganov to the business and political leaders from around the world in this Alpine ski resort. Mr. Zyuganov promised to safeguard private property, investments and to continue a market economy in Russia if he is elected in June ..."

ZHIRINOVSKY BACKS BUCHANAN

"Vladimir Zhirinovsky, the ultranationalist candidate for the Russian presidency, has hailed the victory of Patrick J. Buchanan of USA and told him that they could co-operate to deport American and Russian Jews. He called Buchanan "brother in arms" and wished him a "convincing victory" in November.

Interfax, quoting Zhirinovsky, said he had written to Buchanan, saying: "You say that the U.S. Congress is 'Israeli-occupied'. We have the same situation in Russia. So, to survive, we could set aside places on U.S. and Russian territory to deport this small but troublesome tribe".

We presented these 3 items from New York Times in order to show our readers what is happening and what the main players of Russia are saying in the American press.

Zyuganov by all Western accounts, and by members of his own party, are becoming alarmed at what he might do after elections, if he becomes the next President.

Could this be "pre-election tactics" on his part? Unfortunately, all things point to the opposite way. Such criticism coming from Russian communist parties could be looked upon as "sour grapes", but his utterances to the West and his "guaranteeing" the Multinational Corporations their piece of the pie of Russia, these are not "tactics" at all. These are promises to Imperialism.

Because Zynganov and his leadership REFUSED to go into the election block in December with other communist parties and movements, it was a sure sign that his program is not for building socialism. Even his own members are stating the same as Northstar Compass tried to convey in our previous issues.

Zyuganov will have to make even more concessions to the right-wing and nationalist parties in order to stay in power. He could find himself in bed with Yavlinsky and Zhirinovsky! What a strange love affair this TROYKA will have in one bed, we can only guess at the results the morning after!

Reactionary forces in Russia and U.S.A. do understand each other's needs ... everything points to this. Therefore, we must make this statement: Will the REAL COMMUNISTS PLEASE STAND UP AND BE COUNTED IN RUSSIA!

But does this mean that we have to abandon our principles? Never! No one can force this upon us.


DEAR READERS:

The working class will see and judge. SLOVAK COMMUNISTS' RAPID GROWTH

The Slovak Communist Party (KSS) is growing at a rapid rate, Central Committee secretary Ladislav Jaco told journalists at a party press conference in Bratislava, the Slovak capital, last week. A flood of recruits in the last four months of 1995 – when 1,400 people joined the KSS, in a country whose

population is 5 million – took the party's membership to 20,000. This compares with about 6-7,000 on the eve of the 1994 general election, when the Communist candidates polled 87,000 votes – less than 3% of the turnout (but double their result in the 1992 general election). By comparison, membership of the Slovak Social Democratic Party stands at a mere 1,400 and only the Party of the Democratic Left (SDL) has a bigger membership on the centre-left of the political spectrum.

The objective reasons for the party's growth are several, according to Jan Risko in this week's issue of the Czech Communist weekly Nase pravda: a growing desire for the higher living standards, full employment, free health services and other benefits Slovaks enjoyed under that socialism, the KSS's call for "systemic change" rather than partial reforms, which makes it unique among Slovak parties, with the creation of a socialist society free from the errors and defects of the past, and the party's opposition to Slovak membership of NATO, which also marks it off from other centre-left parties.

The KSS's achievement in setting up a functioning organisation in all but four of the country's administrative districts - in the south west region there is a large Hungarian ethnic minority and they and the ethnic Slovaks are preoccupied with nationalist diversions - is all the more remarkable because the KSS does not have a single full-time worker and its only income is from members' dues. Its technical equipment was supplied by the Communist Party of Bohemia and Moravia (KSCM). Party chairman Vladimir Dado works as a selfemployed baker. He failed to arrive


at last December's KSCM congress, at which he was to have represented the KSS, when his shop was broken into and robbed on the eve of his departure. So that the party's progress is also attributable in large part to its activists, whose patient and dedicated work is at last bringing results. Even in the 4 south western districts lacking a functioning KSS organisation preparatory committees have been set up. No doubt last year's reregistration campaign, members were issued with new membership cards, played its part reactivating inactive members.

NEW PROGRAMME

The party's emblem is the traditional hammer and sickle set in a five-pointed star, which is carried on the masthead of the KSS monthly Usvit ("Dawn") - a 4 page broadsheet in red, white and black, edited by Ivan Hopta from the East Slovak town of Humenne where he is a town councillor. At December's meeting of the KSS Central Committee a new draft party programme was approved. This will be the subject of inner-party discussion between now and the KSS 2nd Congress in June. Called An Alternative Way Forward for the Slovak Republic, it will be the programme on which the KSS will fight the next general election in 1998. Even the studied media boycott on all news about the KSS has failed to halt the party's progress. When former top Czechoslovak Communist Party leader Vasil Bilak – expelled from the party in December 1989, along with most of the other old leadership - was admitted to the KSS, following a decision to invite him and other "discredited" former Slovak leaders to join the KSS, the media ignored that too, clearly believing that "bad"

publicity in the current political situation would be "good" publicity for the Slovak Communists!

REFLECTIONS AFTER THE ELECTION

At the time when in the former Republics of the Soviet Union the social-economic crisis is growing, political parties and movements are fighting each other for seats in the bourgeois parliaments in the newly born "independent" states. As an example, in Kirkghizia during the presidential elections, the winner was the former head of the State Askar Akaev. The elections to the Duma in Russia took place, also the second round of elections to the Supreme Soviet of Ukraine. How do we look at their results?

FIRST CONCLUSION

In the society's understanding, there is a significant movement to the left.

More and more, people are becoming aware that the pseudo-democrats in fact are the vehicle through which the masses are being manipulated. A majority of the people are beginning to understand that the necessities of life can only be guaranteed by socialism and communism. This is proven that in the elections that have taken place, first place was won by the Communist Party of Russian

Federation. For candidates from the Communist Party of Russian Federation and the Labour-Democratic Party of Russia, there voted over 34% of voters. Concrete data and results in the Russian elections were contained in our NSC, January issue. The fraction of Communists in the Russian parliament is the largest of all parties. This in itself proves that the people want to return back to socialism. There is no way that the question of taking over the state by the workers - this is out of the question at this time. The state apparatus, before the elections and after these elections, is still in the hands of the bourgeoisie. The Communists received a substantial number of votes and seats, but they do not have an absolute majority. Aside from this, many members of the CPRF in fact are very far away from being communists.

Nevertheless, it has to be noted that all the movements to the left must be looked at as a tendency, gathering more and more a global character. This is confirmed by the successes of left forces in Bulgaria, Poland, Hungary, Slovakia, Serbia and many others. More and more, the influence of communists is felt in former German Democratic Republic. In the Predniester Republic, that broke away from Moldavia, majority of the population is left oriented and want to remain within the boundaries of former Soviet Union. But ...

SECOND CONCLUSION

In the revolutionary movement, the revisionist and opportunist roots have grown very deep.

As an example, the workers of Russia are putting their hopes in the rebirth of socialism on the CPRF. Many sincere and dedicated communists are members of the CPRF. But, nevertheless, its own

leader Zyuganov stated that his party is closer to social-democracy than to communism. The CPRF leadership (former CC CPSU – editors) are orientating to market reforms and less control of the economy by the government.

The same situation and attitude is seen among many other "left" parties. As an example, the leader of Ukrainian Socialists Alexander Moroz, having the important post as the Chairman of the Supreme Soviet of Ukraine (former communists in CC CPSU-Ukraine – editors) according to his views is more centrist, than left.

THIRD CONCLUSION

In Russia as in Ukraine, and in other former Soviet Republics, the state governing apparatus is still in the hands of the right political forces.

As before, the anti-communist forces and parties are in the majority in the bourgeois parliaments. These forces represent the interests of large capitalist monopolies. If in some countries there were elected former communists – as an example in Poland – we must look at them exactly as "former communists" who now have been reborn. They are, of course, far to the right of their former selves, as before they were far from dedicated communists. As an example, in the program of the Communist Party of Russian Federation factually there is absolutely nothing said about socialism, not to mention communism. Programs of such manner are closer to the liberaldemocratic persuasion.

As history teaches us, the state never departs voluntarily. They never give back the stolen people's wealth that they grabbed during their bourgeois reign. This is confirmed by Yeltsin's barbaric attack with tanks and cannons against the Russian Supreme

Soviet, by his ultimatum of anticonstitutional totalitarian regime of personal rule as is done by president Kuchma in the Ukraine and others.

As much as it sounds and looks very peaceful and needed to come to realization, but parliamentary road towards socialism is nothing but utopia. The only realistic road to socialism is the unity of all workers and farmers for forcibly taking over the reins from the national and foreign bourgeoisie.

FOURTH CONCLUSION

The masses, more and more, see the utopian dream of parliamentary road to socialism as only a dream, but not realistic. But the people are still not as active as the situation demands. They still do not realize their own realistic might, capable of taking over the reins of government.

The working class still did not fully realize the difference between the so-called "communaki", who are in fact in the camp of pseudodemocracy, and the dedicated Bolsheviks.

The participation in the elections in Russia was very low. The same situation is also prevalent in the Ukraine. In the previous elections to the Supreme Soviet of Ukraine, because of the small turn-out by the people, there were 45 districts that had to cancel the elections. In December of 1995, another attempt was made for these 45 districts to elect their representatives, but out of the 45 vacancies, only 14 were filled, due to the lack of turn-out of voters and non-interest!

People lost faith in pseudo-democrats, therefore, they do not participate in the elections. The people will find their own path to a socialist society, to communism. This is the path of a socialist revolution.

THE SAFETY FUSE IS ALREADY ON FIRE

On February 10, around the monument to V.I. Lenin, on the central square of Lugansk, Ukraine, there took place a meeting of striking coal miners, where they were supported by the Teachers Federation and workers of the city. From February 1, the strike of miners culminated at this meeting. What brought this on? The speakers at this meeting of the activists of the miners, rank and file miners spoke facts which have made these miners come to the end of their rope and they went on strike in order to feed their families. During the period of this "independent Ukraine", the production of coal keeps on going down, although there is enough coal in the Donbass region for another 300 years, while at the same time, there is no other energy source.

Miners did not receive their pay for over 2-3 months, while the prices keep on rising. With a monthly pay of 3 million karbovantsi (can you imagine this sum?), while a pail of potatoes - the main staple of the miners – costs 650-700 thousand, 1 kg of meat costs 600-650 thousand, 1 kg of butter, 650-700 thousand. The rent for apartments rose by 1 1/2 times, while in July it will rise again by two times – thus for a family of 3, it will cost 13 million karbovantsi. This does not take into account the gas, electricity, the prices which are going up and up. Frankly speaking, the miners are forced to practically live on a starvation diet of potatoes!

Because of the terrible safety conditions, due to lack of parts, privatization, there are countless unnecessary accidents taking place. Last year in the Ukrainian coal mines, more than 300 miners were killed – among them, 105 in our district alone!

The miners have demanded not only economic benefits, but tied this to political demands. They blamed the so-called "democrats" and the social-economic policies, the market economy, the reforms which are the cause of the miners' deaths. The miners were very vocal and bitter against the late diktat of L. Kuchma, the president of Ukraine, about the "corporation" of the coal industry, against the proposed plans to close over 100 mines as "unproductive", "unprofitable". But who is it that brought these mines to this crisis? First of all, it was the demolishing of the USSR, which cut off the economic ties with Russia and other former republics, plus privatization.

In case these so-called "unprofitable" mines are closed, stated speakers, there will be absolutely 100% unemployment!

"Our perseverance has come to an end!", stated one coal miner. "We cannot look into the eyes of our wives and children, who are hungry. We have tried all sorts of methods to resolve this problem: picketing, hunger strikes, strikes. There is only one road left to us – give us arms!" The strikers applauded this demand.

Leaflets that were spread to the coal miners said that "Coal is the property of all the people". WE WANT TO WORK, NOT BE SLAVES. WORK WITHOUT PAY IS SLAVE LABOUR!

"For 4 months, the miners did

not get paid. We are afraid to go home to our hungry children. We look today at the pensioners, they are on the verge of starvation ... they do not even get their pensions."

"IN UNITY WE ARE STRONG! WE SHALL NOT ALLOW UKRAINE TO GO INTO POVERTY AND DISAPPEAR!"

"The strikes are the beginning of cleaning Ukraine from the dirt. We shall be united and not allow a famine to overtake the working class."

The most forceful and emotional speech was given by Stanislav Shegoleva. He is a miner, chairman of the strike committee; he just joined the Communist party two years ago. Stanislav was elected as a Secretary of district committee of CPU at the last plenum of the party. He tied in the economic problems with political demands. "It is necessary to put Kuchma and his government out of office." He demanded - "that there be workers' control on production, adoption of a new Ukrainian constitution which would look after the interests of the working class". His speech received a tremendous ovation.

Coming to show their solidarity with the coal miners were the teachers, asking the strikers to fight not only for "small demands, but for political demands". He stated: "We who defended Stalingrad, did we ever think that the Soviet Union will be sold down the river, that to govern the country will come those, who now praise the bandits, the Banderites, that workers will be forced to beg for their pay?"

Kuchma and Marchuk – they decided not to meet the demands of the coal miners but are continuing their "market reforms", which are dictated by the International Monetary Fund. They think that they will break the strike by giving part of their monthly pay, but not

however forsaking the closing of the proposed 100 coal mines. They are following the road of former "Iron Lady" Thatcher of England. This, what was able to be done in well-fed England, will not be allowed to happen in hungry Ukraine. The miners with the proposed closing of those mines, they have no other place to go. This is a cancer in our midst. The present government has no money to pay the miners or the pensioners. There is only one road – either we die, or we rebel!

The workers of Ukraine are receiving only the first lessons about the class struggles. During Soviet times, they never thought of fighting or striking. Their interests were looked after by the CPSU, the state. Therefore, today, the working class is finding itself in the "first grade" of the struggle, getting their lessons and learning fast. They are throwing away the stupidity of anti-communism, with which it was possible in 1991 to start a counter-revolution, the bourgeois coup. The workers are still not aware and decisive in order to break the cooperation with the regime ... as an anti-peoples regime. Although they criticize the government, they are still not fulfilling their demands with action: start collecting signatures to demand the resignation of Kuchma. But they will come to this realization and action soon enough, because the policies of Kuchma do not give the workers a choice of: "Socialism or death!"

A flame has already been lit and is racing along the safety fuse. Look out you Messrs! When the coal miners reach their wits end, the dynamite will certainly explode. The situation today is exactly the same as it was on the eve of 1905, when Maxim Gorky wrote – "Song with Stormy Petrel": "Storm, will burst the storm!"

HOW RED DID THE DUMA BECOME?

In a very indepth article, the Editors of Glasnost analyzed the election results, pre-election prognosis and predictions, plus post-election results. We cannot reprint the whole excellent article, since there are in this issue other observations on this theme, but, we cannot but quote some very interesting, thought-provoking statements by the Editors of Glasnost. We sincerely congratulate them on their observation and conclusions.

"Elections in Russia brought good results to the communists, regardless of the problems during the elections and lack of publicity that other parties had, more than 30% of the voters voted for communists.

This is a direct rebuff to Yeltsin and his across-the-ocean masters and the statement that communism in Russia is done away with, or his hysterical pre-election call to the people not to admit communists to the government.

The Government parties and their candidates spent over 12 billion rubles in order to defeat the left movement. USSR was short .47%, this was not a loss but a victory, since they were absolutely ignored and did not have the TV, radio or press time as others did (not to mention finances – editors).

Now, it is evident as to why Zyuganov and the CPRF did not want to join any election block – they wanted to test the waters as to their popularity with the upcoming presidential elections in mind.

If the communists-patriotic forces had a common front in these Duma elections, they could have received over 40-45%. Now, the CPRF has to look around for partners, alliances with people that would make strange bed-fellows.

I'm just stating a fact, that in my district, where the CPRF went at it alone for the "Governor" of the district without consulting or trying to form an election block with other left-wing parties, their candidate lost.

From the lips of Zyuganov himself in pre-election speeches and attacks, he certainly used

unparliamentary language when he attacked his communist opponents, with words such as "madmen communists", "cavemen communists", "orthodox communists" and other not printable epitaphs. But these communists collected over 120,000,000 rubles in order to win the elections!

If the CPRF does not soon set up an election block with the "Communists-Workers Russia-For USSR", then Zyuganov stands no chance of winning the presidential election in June.

Besides all this, the elections to the Duma were still on people's minds, when the heated campaign started for the top job – the presidential election. Already, there are known candidates: Zyuganov, Romanov, Tuleev, Zhirinovsky, Yanvlinskij, Fedorov, Rutskoi, Zavidia and coming on the scene again is Gorbachev.

According to the Central Election Commission, they expect close to 50 candidates overall for the presidency.

This is absurd and dangerous for our Motherland.

One more disillusionment for the people to live through, and they will not forgive!

ALL UNION COMMUNIST PARTY OF BOLSHEVIKS LENINGRAD

On February 24-25, 1996, there took place in Leningrad the Second Congress of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks.

There were 149 delegates at the Congress with full voting rights, plus 52 delegates with voice but no vote. The delegates represented 38 provinces of Russian Federation, from Petropavlovsk to Kaliningrad and from Murmansk to Sochi, 10 Autonomous Republics of the Russian Federation, plus 15 provinces of Ukraine, Crimea, all provinces of Byelorussia, Kazakhstan, Tadjikistan, Turkmenia, Uzbekistan, Georgia, Moldavia, Predniester, Moldavian Republic, plus the Baltic Republics.

This Second Congress of AUCPB greeted all left and communist parties existing on the territory of Soviet Union. Greetings to the Second Congress were sent by 21 communist, workers parties and movements of the world.

Congress heard the reports of the Secretariat of CC AUCP plus the

main report by Nina Andreeva, General Secretary. The Congress adopted the new Constitution of AUCPB, other documents and reports, among them:

- About the position of AUCPB in the forthcoming presidential campaign in June of 1996;
- About informational-analytical survey by the Secretariat of CC AUCPB;
- About the situation in the Chechen Republic.

The Congress elected a Central Committee of AUCPB from 15 comrades, plus candidate members to CC. At the Plenum of CC AUCPB held on February 25th, the Plenum elected Nina Andreeva as the General Secretary.

The Congress also expelled from the ranks of AUCP G.P. Kaspiev and S.G. Sologubov for organizing a campaign to derail the Congress.

U.S., CUBA, CANADA – WHO IS THE REAL DICTATOR IN THE CARIBBEAN?

Considering the turbulent events of the past weeks involving the downing of two planes of "Brothers to the Rescue" by the Cuban authorities in waters adjacent to that island, we need to ask a few simple questions:

- What is the source of the crisis? There is no doubt that there has been clear provocation, often repeated, by the "Brothers" and, it would appear, with the tacit acceptance (even support?) of American authorities, who, by their vindictive policies and actions (including a blockade which has caused the utmost suffering to the people of the island) demonstrate the same kind of paranoia long since shown towards the "aggression" of Vietnam and with as little justification.
- What is the concern for human rights? Are the "Brothers" really concerned about the rights of the people of Cuba? Are they people who truly love their fellow citizens and wish above all for their welfare? Or are they people who above all love "property"? Some apparently want a return to a regime like that of the dictator Batista, under whom corruption and poverty ran rampant, and where "freedom" resembled the freedom of the lion in the jungle. (It was this regime that Fidel Castro, as a young man, in company with other university students, rose to crush - and he succeeded only because the people supported him. He has succeeded in continuing to live also, despite the determined efforts of the CIA to end his life). We have become acquainted with many such regimes in Latin and South America in recent years, and a number have had the often silent and always secret support of the U.S. Under such systems, poor people normally live in terror and, if they wish to champion their country's right to self-determination, risk and often forfeit their own lives, or remain silent in order not to endanger their families.
- What is the real motivation of the US? May we be so bold as to suggest that, in this case, the motives of the US authorities are

not quite pure? May we even say that their recent statements and actions are political in the uncomplimentary sense? When we hear Senator Jesse Helms waxing moralistic on this issue, do we not smell something fishy, or even ratty? What the Senator - and, we regret to say, President Clinton and some other leading people who are reputed to have some judgment – are concerned about is that, despite their most extreme and punitive efforts to crush their society, the people of a small country in the vicinity of "the greatest power on earth" have had the audacity to choose and to stick with Socialism!

So the world's "greatest power" is not respecting Cuba's, or Canada's, or any country's right to freedom, to determine their own policy. In fact, the present leaders in the US are violating the very principles on which their great nation is founded – and in the recent piece of punitive legislation that aims to penalize any other country that has trade relations with Cuba (almost certainly violating international law), they are in fact seeking to dictate policy to other countries, for reasons that are highly discreditable.

So let us in Canada make our own Declaration of Independence, and, for once, refuse to kowtow to the Great Dictator! Let us encourage our representatives to "speak truth to power" (as the Quakers, members of a historic peace church, say). Jesse Helms has said that Canadians "are condoning Fidel Castro. I suggest that they be ashamed of themselves". We suggest that the shoe is on the other foot! Let us, as individuals and as a nation, stand up for what is right, for ourselves, for other countries, and for the World - because here, Uncle Sam is clearly wrong!

The youth has been demoralized, taken off the path of socialism and dedication from the time of perestroika, if not before, by the "cleansing of the brains" of the people by powers that be, agents of influence. This was accomplished through the medium of mass information of the liberal-democratic values, adopting the standard of a bourgeois society. Another factor has its influence – very sluggish

Last week, the State Department spokesman, Nicholas Burns, cautioned that the program would not proceed until Iranian and other fighters imported during the four-year war against rebel Serbs were expelled.
